Upping the Ante

Financiers now back renewable energy projects more, says study

In 2021, No Coal Power Unit Received Money

Nagpur: For the first time, 100% of the value of the project finance loans last year went to renewable energy projects. This is a considerable increase compared to 2020, where renewable energy loans accounted for 74%.

This was revealed in the fifth edition of Coal Vs Renewable Finance Analysis, authored by Climate Trends and Centre for Financial Accountability and was released at CFA's annual energy finance conference hosted in collaboration with IIT Madras recently.

According to the research, over ₹31 crore went to clean energy projects and no new coal power projects received any project finance in 2021. "Of the total ₹3,893 crore that went to renewable energy projects, L&T Finance was noted as the largest financier in 2021 pouring ₹1,214 crore into the sector. Rajasthans followed by Gujarat were the top beneficiaries of renewable energy lending, with ₹22,197 crore and ₹4,025 crore being poured into the states respectively. Collectively

they accounted for 77% of all renewable energy loans," the analysis stated. The total funding for new energy projects last year has been 60% lower compared to 2017 levels. "Finance for renewable energy projects on the other hand has seen a 38% year-on-year increase from 2020. In order to meet its 2030 targets of 450 GW installed capacity, clean energy will need to be deployed at 2.5 times

the current rate," researchers found.

Joe Athilly, executive director of Centre for Financial Accountability said, "The writing is on the wall. After Federal Bank, the first commercial bank to announce a coal exit policy, Suryodaya Small Finance Bank has also announced an end to financing coal projects. This should signal to institutions who have either provided loans or underwriting services, or have shareholdings in coal companies to rethink their lending."

India would need \$10 trillion to transition to Net Zero by 2070. "The sheer scale of climate finance needed to meet the country's mitigation goals will require an all-hands-on-deck approach. The recent announcement of the sovereign green bond framework is encouraging. The green bond issue size is ₹2 billion for the fiscal year 2022-23. While this is dwarfed by the finance India will need ultimately, such signals indicate ambitions to expand renewable energy and reduce our carbon intensity," said Shweta Shah, communications strategist at Climate Trends.

Cos more aware of fin impacts of climate change

Nagpur: With Asia being one of the most vulnerable regions to climate change, companies in India are increasingly becoming aware of the financial impacts of climate change. A 61% of companies have processes in place for identifying, assessing, and managing climate-related risks, reveals the latest survey.

According to a study on state of climate risk in India done by global advisory firm WTV, 64% of companies consider climate change under their sustainability agenda, 48% under corporate strategy, 43% under risk management and 32% under finance. Apart from this, 82% of companies have had some form of board-level discussion on the financial impact of climate change to their business.

Also, more than half of the companies (53%) have active or limited internal disc-

MBBS student takes up farming to fund studies

Bhubaneswar: Ifu Malik always wanted to be a doctor. Son of daily wages, from Bagramila village in Odisha's tribal-dominated Kandhamal district, he would see the problem tribes like him faced to fund medical expenses and wanted to serve them in future. But he didn't realise that money would pose a hurdle in fulfilling his dream.

Undaunted by the challenge, 21-year-old Malik, who has cleared NEET on his second attempt, is working as

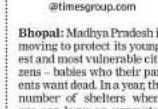
a farm hand and at construction sites to arrange his hostel fees, having already borrowed ₹38,950 from his friend's father to deposit the first-year admission fees at the government-run Salhed Laxman Nayak (SLN) Medical College and Hospital in Koraput.

"I am yet to deposit the annual hostel fees of ₹15,000. Besides, I need ₹4,000 per month as part of hostel mess charges. I am struggling to arrange the money," said Malik, who belongs to the Kondh tribe. Classes will start from December 15, and Malik has time till then to submit his hostel fees. Malik has three brothers and two sisters.

Unwanted babies get caring hands in MP, but not many know of it

Bhopal: Madhya Pradesh is moving to protect its youngest and most vulnerable citizens - babies whose parents want dead. In a year, the number of shelters where one can leave an unwanted baby has shot up nearly 10-fold in the state, from 28 to 305, contributing to a 15% drop in the number of children found abandoned on roadsides and in fields.

Earlier, only 56 infants could be found in these creches in the entire year; but in 2021, 35 newborns were found in these creches instead of being thrown in the

sheer numbers of babies abandoned. Only Maharashtra fares worse, topping the country for six years in the last decade.

At least one newborn is dumped and left to die every second day in Madhya Pradesh. More than 1,352 infants have been dumped in the past 10 years. Very few survived, say officials. Most didn't survive the night out in the elements, and some were horrifically found eaten by strays and wild animals. Officials say the survival rate for even those found alive is very low - the ordeal has already taken its toll by the time protective hands reach them.
