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PM inaugurates volleyball championship virtually in Kashi

Prime Minister Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated the 72nd Senior National Volleyball Championship in Varanasi on Sunday. Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath attended the event at Dr. Sampurnanand Sports Stadium in Siga, Varanasi, where he addressed players and spectators.

"Under the guidance of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, a 'New Sports Culture' has emerged, strengthening discipline, fitness and team spirit among the youth. Sports are no longer limited to recreation; they have become a powerful tool for personality development and nation-building," the Chief

Minister said.

"With modern infrastructure, transparent selection systems and mission-mode implementation of schemes, opportunities for young athletes have expanded significantly. Competitions now extend from village panchayats to the national level, resulting in a sharp rise in the participation and medal wins of UP athletes at international events."

During the ceremony, an MoU was exchanged between the Sports Authority of India (SAI) and the Uttar Pradesh Sports Directorate for the operation of NCOE. The chief minister warmly welcomed all 58 participating teams, 30 men's and 28 women's, along with

their coaches and officials, who had arrived in Kashi.

"Over the last 11–11.5 years, every Indian has witnessed the rise of a new sports culture. Through the Khelo India initiative launched in 2014, Prime Minister Modi revived respect for sports and promoted the idea of holistic development through physical fitness."

He emphasised that true success in life is possible only with a healthy body. Initiatives such as Khelo India, the Fit India Movement, MP Sports Competitions and the development of sports infrastructure in every district have transformed the national sporting ecosystem. In Uttar Pradesh, sports have been further promoted through



MP-MLA Sports Competitions and rural-level tournaments.

The CM noted that the Senior National Volleyball Championship is being held in Uttar Pradesh after 43 years, organised by the Varanasi Municipal Corporation. He described the event as a result of Prime Minister Modi's inspiration, guidance and leadership. Modern sports infrastructure developed across the state and country reflects this vision with the state-of-the-art facilities at Sampurnanand Sports Stadium developed under the Smart City project.

Following the MoU between the UP government and SAI, athletes will now receive advanced training under expert guidance at the National Centre of

Excellence. The CM said, "Over the past 8–8.5 years, focused efforts have been made to promote sports across Uttar Pradesh. Playgrounds are being built in every village, stadiums in every district and mini-stadiums at the block level. Open gyms have been prioritised by urban local bodies and gram panchayats, ensuring access to sports facilities at every level. As a result, UP athletes are now competing and excelling at national, Olympic, Commonwealth, and international championships, winning significantly more medals than in the past."

Mayor Ashok Tiwari welcomed the guests at the ceremony. Deputy Chief Minister Brajesh Pathak, Rajya Sabha MP Amarpal Maurya, Minister of State

(Independent Charge) Ravindra Jaiswal, Dayashankar Mishra 'Dayalu', Sports Minister Girish Chandra Yadav, District Panchayat Chairperson Poonam Maurya, MLAs Neelkanth Tiwari, Saurabh Srivastava, Dr Sunil Patel, Tribhuvan Ram, Dr Awadhesh Singh, and MLCS Hansraj Vishwakarma, Dharmendra Singh, along with other dignitaries, were present.

CM also inspected the stadium premises, reviewing the gym and its equipment. He interacted with a young shooting athlete, inquired about his training, and watched a live demonstration of his skills. CM Yogi encouraged athletes practicing various sports, boosting their morale and motivation.

Canadian Hindu Chambers delegation meets CM Yogi

Canadian entrepreneurs will invest in MSMEs, religious tourism and hospitality sector in UP. A delegation from the Canadian Hindu Chambers of Commerce meets Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath here on Sunday.

The CM assured them of all possible support from the state government. He also invited the members to visit Ram Lalla in Ayodhya, Kashi Vishwanath Dham in Kashi, and Prayagraj.

Yogi Adityanath emphasised the need to promote new initiatives in trade, technology and tourism in line with the Prime Minister's vision. He said that eight-nine years ago, markets



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during festivals were flooded with Chinese products, but in 2018 the state promoted traditional enterprises through the One District-One Product initiative. These products were provided with design support, technology and platform forms and are showcased at the UP International Trade

Show held in the last week of September.

The CM said that Chinese products have now disappeared from UP markets. The government is supporting all 9.6 million MSME units in the state and ensuring social security for them, benefiting the livelihoods of around 25

million families. Through One District-One Product, these products have been branded and are now being presented as official gifts on major platforms. He informed the delegation that India is now the world's fourth-largest economy and also the fastest-growing major economy.

RETIRED HOME GUARD SHOTS SELF

A 65-year-old retired home guard allegedly shot himself dead with his licensed firearm in the Krishna Nagar area on Sunday morning.

The deceased, identified as Madan Gopal Verma, was reportedly battling chronic health issues and mental distress. On receiving information about the incident around 9 am from Kanosi village, the Krishna Nagar police reached the spot and found Verma's body with a fatal gunshot wound.

Preliminary investigations suggest that he used his licensed 12-bore rifle to take the extreme step.

UP govt speeds up land acquisition in religious cities

The Uttar Pradesh government has expedited the process of acquiring land in prominent religious cities, including Ayodhya, Varanasi and Mathura, to build residential townships to meet the rising housing demand.

UP and Housing Development Board Commissioner Balkar Singh said the state government had sanctioned Rs 6,000 crore in August this year to build greenfield township projects across the state. He, however, stated that the state government is giving emphasis on the development of towns that are important from ancient, religious and tourism perspectives.

"Owing to the rapid development of these areas, there is a growing awareness about Ayodhya, Mathura and Kashi among the people of the country. This is fuelling their aspirations to settle in these sacred regions," Singh said.

To meet this growing demand, the UP Housing and Development Board is expediting work on its Greenfield

Ayodhya Township, while the land acquisition proceedings are underway in Mathura, Kashi, Chitrakoot etc.

Construction work of Metro's E-W corridor likely to begin in April

The construction of the East-West corridor of the Lucknow Metro is likely to begin in April.

LDA Vice-Chairman Prathamesh Kumar held a meeting with Metro officials to review proposals related to the transfer of Authority and Nazul land for the project. Kumar stated that six hectares of land in Sector-K of the Basantkunj Scheme and 6.5 acres of land identified as temporary parking developed in the Prabandh Nagar Scheme for the inauguration programme of the Rashtriya Prerna Sthal have been earmarked.

Subject to mutual agreement, this land will be transferred for use as the Metro's temporary casting yard. In

addition, approximately 18 hectares of land have been identified in the southern part of Sector-A of the Basantkunj Scheme for the construction of a Metro depot. This includes land belonging to the Dubagga fish market. In exchange, an equivalent area of land will be provided for the fish market in the proposed Varun Vihar Scheme on the Agra Expressway.

During the meeting, Metro officials also requested the availability of land at Chowk, Charbagh, Gautam Buddha Marg, and some other locations. In response, the vice-chairman directed that surveys of the proposed sites be conducted at the earliest and that the no-objection certificates for land transfer be issued promptly.

Cold conditions intensified across Uttar Pradesh over the past 24 hours following a sharp fall in minimum temperatures, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said on Sunday.

The significant drop in night temperatures has been attributed to the passage of an active western disturbance affecting western India, after which cold and dry north-westerly winds from hill regions swept across the state.

As a result, minimum temperatures in the central parts of Uttar Pradesh fell by 3-6 degrees Celsius, leading to a marked increase in cold conditions.

The IMD said minimum

temperatures may fall slightly further in other parts of the state during the next 24-48 hours, after which the decline is expected to halt and a gradual rise may begin under the influence of the next western disturbance.

Daytime conditions also remained harsh in several areas due to strong cold winds blowing at speeds of 15-20 kmph, persistent fog and lack of clear skies, leading to cold day conditions at isolated places. Dense to very dense fog is likely at a few places over eastern Uttar Pradesh, while dense fog is expected at isolated locations in western parts of the state.

Temperatures are expected to remain below normal for the next few days due to fog and cold winds.

UP's first Braille library inaugurated at DSMNRU

Uttar Pradesh's first Braille library was inaugurated at Dr Shaktuntala Misra National Rehabilitation University on Sunday. DSMNRU Vice-Chancellor Acharya Sanjay Singh inaugurated it at a programme organised in the university.

Prior to this, on the birth anniversary of Louis Braille, the father of the Braille script, which falls on January 4, he paid floral tributes to his statue at the university's Braille Press.

Vice-Chancellor Acharya Sanjay Singh said that the university aims to achieve a



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good NAAC grade and a strong NIRF ranking and continuous efforts are being made in this direction.

"Academic sessions are being completed on time, hostel repairs have been finished and hostels have been handed over to students, and further work will be undertaken on academic buildings and infrastructure," he said.

Earlier, the Vice-Chancellor inaugurated the programme by lighting the ceremonial lamp with the assistance of visually-impaired students,

holding their hands. He motivated students with visual disabilities to become capable and self-reliant. He directed the University administration to provide computer training to persons with visual disabilities. He stated that the Braille script is the primary medium of reading, writing and education for visually-impaired persons, making them self-reliant and integrating them into the mainstream of society.

This library houses more than 4,000 academic Braille books based on the NEP for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes of 54 courses, published by the

university's own Braille Press. Notably, this is the first State University in Uttar Pradesh to open such a large Braille section. The entire first floor of the Central Library has been dedicated to the Braille Library Section. The section also includes a reading room with seating capacity for more than 150 students.

University spokesperson and Library in-charge Prof Yashwant Viroaday said that the target is to increase the number of Braille books from 4,000 to 10,000 within this year. In addition to academic course material, the Braille section also has Braille books of novels, dramas, and biographies of great personalities.

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
