

Veteran filmmaker K. Viswanath dead

Hyderabad, Feb 3: Dadasaheb Phalke awardee and renowned filmmaker Kasinadhuni Viswanath died at a private hospital. He was 92.

Viswanath was unwell for some time and was suffering from age-related issues, sources said. He passed away at the hospital around midnight Thursday.

Viswanath, popularly known as ‘Kalatapasvi’, was born in February 1930 in Andhra Pradesh.

A prominent name not just in Telugu cinema but also in Tamil and Hindi films, he became the 48th recipient of the Dadasaheb Phalke award, the highest recognition in



Indian cinema. He was conferred with the award for the year 2016.

Telangana Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao expressed his condolences over the death of Viswanath, a release from the Chief Minister’s Office said.

Viswanath, who started his journey as a sound artiste, directed award-

winning films such as “Sankarabharanam”, “Sagara Sangamam”, “Swati Mutyam”, “Saptapadi”, “Kaamchor”, “Sanjog” and “Jaag Utha Insaan” in his long career that included an equally successful stint in front of the camera.

His other honours include Padma Shri in 1992, five National Awards, 20 Nandi Awards (given by the Andhra Pradesh government) and 10 Filmfare trophies including the Lifetime Achievement award.

Viswanath, who made 50 movies since 1965, was a celebrated filmmaker in the Telugu film industry. He had also been active in Tamil and

Hindi cinema.

He debuted as a director with “Aatma Gowravam”, which starred Akkineni Nageswara Rao and won the Nandi Award for the best feature film.

The filmmaker followed it with “Chelleli Kapuram”, “O Seeta Katha”, “Jeevana Jyoti” and “Sarada”.

Viswanath also ventured into mainstream acting, working in movies like “Swarabhishekam” (which he directed as well), “Pandurangadu”, “Narasimha Naidu”, “Lakshmi Narasimha” and “Seemasimham”, “Kuruthipunal”, “Kakkai Siraginilae” and “Bagavathi”, among others.

SriLankan Airlines to attract Indian Tourists



New Delhi, Feb 3- To attract more Indian customers, SriLankan Airlines said it will start operations from additional three cities in India, including Ahmedabad. At present, it flies out of nine Indian cities. The state-owned airline entity has also launched a new marketing campaign specific to the Indian market, so Indians can start coming back to the politically-battered country.

The company has launched its new marketing campaign ‘Dil Full of Sri Lanka’ where it’s bundling one plus one tickets for flyers along with four and five star hotel stays at lower costs. For this, it has tied up with select travel agents to retail these. In a week, the airline does about 60-75 flights to and from India.

For SriLankan Airlines,

the business started to finally pick up after the covid-19 pandemic in December 2021. But the country ran out of fuel and then had a change in regime which also led to running out of aviation fuel. When it did not have any aviation fuel for two months, the company stopped over in India to take fuel stops to buy jet fuel from vendors in Chennai and started to tanker fuel from here. The company is currently using its own operational cash flows as interest rates don’t allow companies to borrow too much from institutions. Outbound trips from India are expected to account for \$42 billion by 2024 with approximately 80 million passport holders and a growing population being major contributors to the increase, as per a report titled, Outbound Travel and Tourism: An

Opportunity Untapped by Sector Advisory, Nangia Government and Public Andersen LLP and FICCI.

Kullu’s online bookings for tourism-related services soon

Kullu, Feb 3- Tourists visiting the city of Kullu will soon be able to book various tourism-related services online through a web portal being developed by the state government.

The visitors will be able to book hotels, trekking, rafting, paragliding and other tourism-related activities and pay for these online. The portal will also prevent fleecing by service providers.

The portal is expected to boost tourism industry of the region. Besides, it will ensure safety of tourists as only authenticated operators and service providers will be listed on the portal.

The Tourism Department held a meeting under the chairmanship of Kullu Deputy Commissioner (DC) Ashutosh Garg. District Tourism Development Officer (DTDO) Sunayna Sharma and presidents of all organisations related to the tourism industry of the region attended the meeting.

Natish Kumar and Harish Shandilya from Map My India company, selected by the state government for making the web portal, gave details about loading information, login and booking of adventure sports and hotels on the web portal.

They said that district-wise information of the entire state would be available on the portal. The portal would also display photographs of activities, sites and heritage of districts.

The Kullu DC said QR codes of all paragliding operators, rafters, trekking operators, hotels and other adventure activities would also be available on the web portal so that tourists could book tourism-related activities at their own convenience.

The DC said officials would meet again to discuss changes required on the portal that were to be made by the Tourism Department.
