Video shows officers pummeling & leaving him on footpath propped against squad car

AUTHORITIES released video footage on Friday showing Tyre Nichols being beaten by five Memphis police officers...

In Washington, protestors gathered in Lafayette Park, across the street from the White House and

near the Black Lives Matter Plaza.

The lengthy video footage from police body cameras shows a group of officers detaining Nichols, attempting to take him down with the use of a Taser...

Two officers hold Nichols to the ground as he moves about, and then the third appears to kick him in the head...

The fourth officer then walks

over, draws a baton and holds it up at shoulder level as two officers hold Nichols upright, as if he were sitting.

The video raised questions about the role and possible culpability of the other officers at the scene, in addition to the five who were charged.

The footage shows a number of other officers standing around after the beating.

Memphis Police Director Ceryn "CJ" Davis has said other officers are under investigation for their part in the arrest.

During the traffic stop, the video shows the officers were "already ramped," she said. The officers were "aggressive, loud, using profane language and probably scared Mr. Nichols from the very beginning."

Second time in 3 years, UK airline Flybe collapses

LONDON

STRUGGLING United Kingdom regional airline Flybe collapsed for the second time in three years on Saturday, putting jobs on the line and leaving passengers stranded.

However, it relaunched in April last year, flying many of the same routes out of Belfast, Birmingham and London Heathrow.

The UK's Civil Aviation Authority said passengers should "make their own alternative travel arrangements via other airlines, rail or coach operators."

CAA consumer director Paul Smith said, "It is always sad to see an airline enter administration and we know that Flybe's decision to stop trading will be distressing for all of its employees and customers."

The UK government said that its immediate priority would be to support anyone trying to get home and those who have lost their jobs.

"This remains a challenging environment for airlines, both old and new, as they recover from the pandemic, and we understand the impact this will have on Flybe's passengers and staff," it said.
