

BAYERN RUN BERSERK AGAINST SCHALKE

The new Bundesliga began in an empty stadium with eight-time defending champion Bayern Munich routing Schalke 8-0 for a record in the league's opening match.

And it should have been more. Germany winger Leroy Sané starred on Friday and scored on his Bayern debut and Jamal Musiala became Bayern's youngest ever goalscorer at 17 years, 205 days, but otherwise it was business as usual as they totally dominated and the visitors tried limiting the damage.

Schalke's winless run stretched to 17 games, while Bayern extended its winning run to 22.

Serge Gnabry scored a hat trick and Sané set up two of the goals. It was 3-0 by halftime and Bayern missed a host of chances.

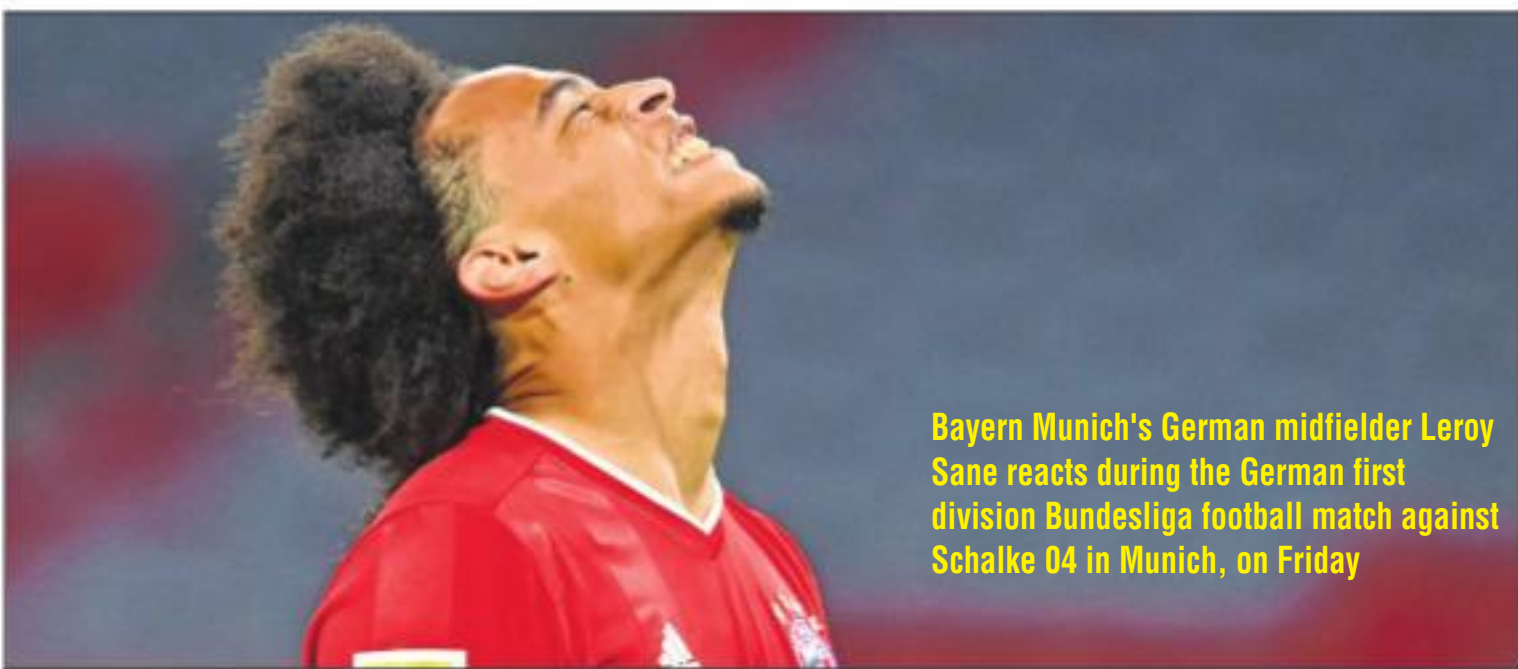
"Everyone was so hungry. We were all looking forward to the new start and we just wanted to attack," said Sané, a former Schalke player who joined Bayern from Manchester City in the offseason.

The game took place without fans despite plans for 7,500 spectators to attend. A spike in local coronavirus infections forced authorities to row back.

"It's a really big blow. We were really looking forward to our fans," Bayern sporting director Hasan Salihamidzic said before kickoff.

The team showed no ill effect from the supporters' absence, nor the short break of 26 days after winning the Champions League final against Paris Saint-Germain.

It was the biggest opening night win since 2016 when Bayern routed Werder Bremen 6-0.

Gnabry got the side off to a flying start in the fourth minute, taking Joshua Kimmich's pass from midfield, switching direction to elude Schalke captain Benjamin Stambouli, then unleashing a fine strike with his left

boot inside the left corner. Robert Lewandowski almost made it 2-0 a minute later after being set up by Sané, but Sebastian Rudy managed to deflect the Poland striker's shot with his outstretched leg.

Schalke managed to hold out until the 19th, when Leon Goretzka scored against his former side with Thomas Müller laying the ball back.

Sané brilliantly set up Lewandowski shortly afterward,

but the Poland striker fired over. Lewandowski finally got off the mark from the penalty spot in the 31st, after he'd been fouled by Ozan Kabak.

Niklas Süle, a central defender, struck the post and Bayern missed other chances before the break, too.

Sané set up Gnabry's second goal in the 47th, his first assist for the club, and repeated the trick to help his Germany teammate complete his hat trick in the 59th.

Lewandowski set up Müller in the 69th by wrapping his right boot behind his left leg, a rabona move, two minutes before Kimminich set up Sané for his first goal.

Sané made way for Musiala to make his second Bundesliga appearance in the 72nd. The 17-year-old English midfielder grabbed his first goal in the 81st. Bayern board member Oliver

Kahn addressed club officials' lack of social distancing during the game. TV images showed at least 10 Bayern officials including Kahn, chairman Karl-Heinz Rummenigge, president Herbert Hainer and his predecessor Uli Hoeneß sitting together without wearing masks.

Kahn told broadcaster ZDF that the officials stuck to "Bavarian regulations, which also permit exactly that."

Lyon still winless against Nimes

Nimes goalkeeper Baptiste Reynet made a fine save in the 90th minute to deny Lyon substitute Tino Kadewere a late winner from Memphis Depay's corner.

AIFF to conduct Intl Virtual Conference

The All India Football Federation (AIFF) is set to organise an International Virtual Conference for coaches from September 28-30.

The three-day conference will feature sessions by several top-level speakers including men's national team head coach Igor Stimac, Phil Brown, Thomas Dennerby (India U-17 women's national team coach), Basir Mohamed (senior manager, FIFA coaching development department), Dawn Scott (high-performance coach, FA UK), among others.

"The conference is based on various aspects, such as youth football, women's football, media, scouting and coach education, where an instructor from the FIFA Coach Education department will be there," AIFF head of coach education Savio Medeira said during a chat with AIFF TV.

"On the last day, we have planned a master class with two of the best coaches - national team head coach Igor Stimac and Phil Brown," Medeira added.

For the first time ever, the attending coaches will be accorded credits as part of the

new revalidation process introduced by Medeira.

"I want to kick off by giving credits to the coaches who are attending the seminar. This conference will be for C, B, A and Pro-license at the moment because these certificates do not have revalidation."

"The revalidation will start



from C, B, A and Pro. Along with my coach educators and department, we would like to start by giving them points and accepting as CPD (Continuing Professional Development), which is needed by coaches for refreshing themselves."

Under the new system, the coaching licenses will fall under a validity period and will need to be renewed periodically.

"Revalidation is very important for us. It's long overdue. To have a stronger coaching convention criteria there has to be revalidation," he explained."

Women's cricketers set to return

Leading players of the world will return to action for the first time since the ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2020, as two high profile series get underway in different parts of the world.

Australia, who retained the title on International Women's Day with a record 86,174 spectators watching the final against India at the iconic Melbourne Cricket Ground, will take on New Zealand in a three-match T20I series, starting from next Saturday.

However, the action kicks off before that, with reigning 50-over World champions England playing former T20 World champions West Indies in a five-match T20I series at home from Monday as the sides try to put behind their disappointments in Australia.

England had failed to make the final as rain washed out their semifinal against India, who advanced due to a better finish in the league phase, while 2016 champions West Indies could only notch a solitary win over first-time entrants Thailand.

The series in Brisbane will see Beth Mooney try to hold on to the top batting spot in the ICC Women's T20I Player



Rankings which she grabbed with a player of the tourna-

ment performance at the T20 World Cup, while former

New Zealand captain Suzie Bates will look to recapture the top position with just 12 rating points separating the two.

New Zealand captain Sophie Devine and the Aussie pair of Alyssa Healy and Meg Lanning occupy the positions from four to six, while West Indian captain Stafanie Taylor (eighth) and England star Natalie Sciver (10th) are the top-ranked players from their sides. Devine also enjoys a healthy lead at the top of the all-rounders' list.

The story is not much different in the bowlers' rankings as England's left-arm spinner Sophie Ecclestone will try to ward off challenge from Australia's Megan Schutt, a formerly top-ranked player who will be doing her best in the other series. Amelia Kerr (fourth) of New Zealand and Hayley Matthews (24th) of the West Indies are the top-ranked players from their sides, again featuring in different series.

The upcoming spell of T20Is could also impact the ICC Women's T20I Team Rankings. Though top-ranked Australia will retain their top spot irrespective of the outcomes of these two series, second-ranked England can be overtaken by New Zealand.

Djokovic, Nadal enter quarter-finals

Top seeds Novak Djokovic and Rafael Nadal have entered the quarterfinals of the Italian Open with straight-set wins in their respective third-round matches.

On Friday, Djokovic defeated his fellow Serb Filip Krajinovic 7-6 (7), 6-3 to enter the last eight of the tournament for the 14th straight year.

"It was definitely one of the longest sets I think I have ever played," said Djokovic as per the ATP Tour website after the match. "Never easy, I think, emotionally to play against someone that is one of my best friends for many years...I think the first set could have gone a different way as well."

"Fortunately for me it went my way and that allowed me to swing through the ball a bit more in the second set. Maybe physically and mentally, he dropped a level and I used my opportunities and capitalised to win in straight sets."

In other Round of 16 match, nine-time champion Nadal cruised past 2019 Monte-Carlo Masters finalist Dusan Lajovic 6-1, 6-3 to reach his 15th Rome quarter-final.

"I played at I think a very positive level of tennis. Of course it needs to keep improving. I need to keep working on a couple of things that are not coming automatically. But I can't ask for more," Nadal said. "(It was) another great evening for me against another good opponent. Can't complain at all. Much better (than) what I expected."

Lorenzo Musetti, 18, who had upset three-time Grand Slam champion Stan Wawrinka and Japan's top player Kei Nishikori in the tournament's opening two rounds, lost to Dominik Koepfer of Germany 6-4, 6-0.

Fourth-seeded Matteo Berrettini defeated Stefano Travaglia 7-6 (5), 7-6 (1) in an all-Italian contest to reach the last eight.

In the women's draw, top-

seed Simona Halep beat Ukraine's Dayana Yastremska 7-5, 6-4. Second seed Karolina Pliskova registered a 6-4, 6-3 win over Russia's Anna Blinkova.

Former world number one Victoria Azarenka advanced to the quarterfinals as her opponent Darya Kasatkina of Russia retired during the first set with the scores at 6-6. Ninth-seeded Garbine Muguruza eased into the final eight as she Johanna Konta of Great Britain 6-4, 6-1.

Birth of a teenage titan. Legspinner Rashid Khan made his ODI debut for Afghanistan at 17, and three years into his career was among the most sought after bowlers in T20 cricket all around the world. Rashid's weapons are quickish delivery, a stump-to-stump line, and an accurate googly, and franchises around the world have lined up to bid for his wares - notably Sunrisers Hyderabad, who bought his services for about US\$ 600,000 in 2017, Guyana Amazon Warriors, and Adelaide Strikers. He has starred in national colours as well, among other things taking 7 for 18 in a win over West Indies in 2017. On his 20th birthday, he became Afghanistan's most prolific ODI bowler, when he followed up a 57 with two wickets in a big win against Bangladesh in the Asia Cup.
