

BISHKEK: After registering a comprehensive victory over the hosts in the first game of the AFC Women's Olympic Qualifiers Round 1, India hopes to carry on the momentum into the second leg to be played on Friday. After a long drought without a win, the Blue Tigresses opened their account for the year with a 5-0 win against the Kyrgyz Republic in the opening game at the Dolen Omurzakov Stadium on Tuesday, April 4. With four different goalscorers

finding the net, it seemed like the pressure had been released off their shoulders. Even inside the Blue Tigresses training after the game, the mood seemed to have lifted, jokes were more easily cracked and a free-flowing energy that had previously seemed contained. At the last training session before the second game, Thomas Dennerby encouraged the players to keep their smiles up but also set a new target for the encounter.



Bangladesh win one-off Test against Ireland by 7 wickets

Bangladesh wrapped up its one-off cricket Test against Ireland with a seven-wicket win just after lunch on the fourth day on Friday.

Bangladesh scored 369 and 138-3 while Ireland was 214 and 292 in its innings.

Mushfiquur Rahim, who scored 126 in the first innings, completed the match for Bangladesh with 51 not out, joined by Mominul Hague's unbeaten 20.

Liton Das gave Bangladesh a fluent start before he was bowled by pacer Mark Adair for 23. Offspinner Andy McBrine, who registered best figures by an Irish bowler with 6-118 in the first innings, then had Najmul Hossain caught by skipper Andrew Balbirnie for 4, with Bangladesh at 43-2.

But Tamim and Mushfiquur ensured the team would be on course of a victory, sharing 46 runs for third wicket.

Bangladesh earlier took 36 minutes to wrap up Ireland's second innings for 292 after the visitors resumed on 286-6.

Pace bowler Ebadot Hossain rattled the stumps of McBrine in the fifth over of the day after he added just one run to his overnight 71 to be out on his career-best 72. Ebadot then dismissed Graham Hume for 14, caught by Das to finish with 3-37.

After falling to 51-5 on the third morning and facing an innings defeat against the much-vaunted spin attack of Bangladesh, the Irish team dug in and grittily batted out the third day to give themselves faint hope.

Lorcan Tucker hit a century, complemented by career-best half-centuries by Harry Tector and Andy McBrine, to help Ireland survive day three and reach stumps on 286-8, leading Bangladesh by 131 runs.

On Friday, the visitors added just six runs to their overnight total. Tucker, who made 108 off 162 balls with 14 fours and one six, became the second Irishman to hit a century on debut after Kevin O'Brien. Tector followed his 50 in the first innings with 56.

Left-arm spinner Taijul Islam was the best bowler for Bangladesh with 4-90, following his 5-58 in the first innings. Skipper Shakib Al Hasan, who bowled only 13 overs, took 2-20.

Earlier, Bangladesh took a 155-run lead in the first innings.

Appreciating Sanju Samson for the brilliant captaincy of Rajasthan Royals and his cool composure, former South Africa captain AB de Villiers said that if the right-handed batter continues to put up some good shows for Team India in the coming years, he will not be surprised to see him as the captain of Playing eleven in the next one or two years.

Samson has recently become the leading run-scorer for Rajasthan Royals in all T20s.

In the ongoing game against Punjab Kings, Samson, chasing a total of 198, amassed 42(25), smashing five fours and a solitary six. Samson is the only second captain to lead Rajasthan Royals to the finale in the

last season.

Complimenting Sanju Samson's brilliant captaincy, former South Africa captain AB de Villiers said Sanju Samson is an incredible player, but as a captaincy, it is his it is cool composure that always stands out. He never seems to be fussed by anything, and as a captain, that is a good sign.

AB de Villiers said on JioCinema, "But I think he's got all the credentials to be a wonderful captain. Who knows, possibly even one day in a year or two or three's time, in one of the formats in the India team, he could very easily be the

captain there, and I think it will do his cricket the world of good. If he can stay as captain for long periods, I think he's going to go places with it." According to de Villiers, if the right-handed batter continues to put up some good shows for Team India in the coming years, he will not be surprised to see him as the captain of Team 11 in the next one or two years.

Suffice to say, Sanju has completely blended into his role as a captain proving himself as one of the best 'Young Captains' India has ever seen.

In 118 matches for Rajasthan Royals, Samson has

scored 3,138 runs at an average of 30.46 making him the leading run-scorer for his franchise. He has scored two centuries and 18 fifties for his side, with the best score of 119. His runs have come at a strike rate of 137.99.

Samson has overtaken Ajinkya Rahane, another India middle-order batter who has played for RR. In 106 matches for RR, he has scored 3,098 runs at an average of 35.60. He scored two centuries and 21 fifties for the side with the best score of 105*.

Other notable run-scorers for RR include Shane Watson (2,474 runs in 84 matches with two tons and 14 fifties), Jos Buttler (2,377 runs in 60 matches with five tons and 15 fifties) and Rahul Dravid (1,324 runs in 52 matches with seven fifties).

Pak appoint Nida Dar as skipper of women's cricket team

ISLAMABAD: Pakistan have decided to replace Bismah Maroof who stepped down from the captaincy role after the ICC Women's T20 World Cup 2023. Bismah has been replaced by veteran all-rounder Nida Dar. Along with this Mark Coles has also been confirmed as the new head coach, a role he had occupied previously between 2017 and 2019. In another change, former Test cricketer Saleem Jaffar was named as the chair of the Women's Selection Committee. Having played 130 T20Is and 99 ODIs, Nida is one of the most experienced players in Pakistan's camp and is the leading wicket-taker in women's T20Is.

Churchill Brothers seal their place in Super Cup Group Stage

MANJERI: The last spot in the Group Stages of the Super Cup was snatched away in style by Goa giants Churchill Brothers as they earned a dominant 6-0 victory over Real Kashmir at the Payyanad Stadium here on Thursday. Liberian striker Ansumana Kromah was the star performer with four goals against his name. After their engaging highly spirited rivalry in the I-League only a few months ago, Thursday's knock-out encounter was a complete contradiction, as Churchill Bothers enjoyed total control over the proceedings. The competitive edge of the match was completely wiped off in the first half when the winners raced to a 3-0 lead before the referee blew for a breather. The scenario hardly changed in the second half, either, as the men from Srinagar could hardly put up a fightback to end their miseries.

Olympic champion sprinter Holub-Kowalik suspends career

WARSAW: Two-time Olympic medalist, Polish sprinter Malgorzata Holub-Kowalik announced that she is pregnant and will suspend her career. She also revealed that she does not know whether she will return to the track. The 30-year-old earned two medals for Poland during the 2020 Tokyo Olympic Games, as she stood on the highest podium in the women's 4x400m relay and secured a bronze in a mixed relay. "I'm really happy. I'm preparing for the most important moment in my life. I was dreaming about being a mother. I always repeated that family is the top value for me. I know my body very well so I thought that something was going to happen. I went to the doctor, who confirmed that I'm pregnant. That's why I have to suspend my career," she explained in an interview with Polish media.

Rhett to join Indian men's hockey team as analytical coach

NEW DELHI: Hockey India on Friday announced that Rhett Halkett and Alan Tan will join the support staff of the Indian men's hockey team in their new roles as analytical coach and scientific advisor respectively.
