Man hacked to death, kin attack house of suspects

A 34-year-old food delivery executive was hacked to death in Kuruthudaiyarpuram area in the late hours of Wednesday. Police detained two people in connection with the murder. Claiming that Mukesh, who resides in Keezha Veeraragavapuram, was killed by residents of the area due to enmity, his relatives attacked the house of the suspects. "Mukesh was returning home in his two-wheeler. While he was passing through Kuruthudaiyarpuram area, a gang waylaid him and hacked him to death with a sickle before fleeing. He is survived by his wife and two children," said sources.

A 55-year-old farmer, Kombaiiah, was allegedly hacked to death by his neighbour in the rural police limit. "Kombaiiah had an enmity with his neighbour Karuthapandi after the latter's dog bit his daughter. He had also filed a complaint in the Suthamalli police station. Enraged by the complaint, Karuthapandi hacked Kombaiiah," said sources.
