IBBI organises Seminar on the occasion of International Women's Day.

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) organised a Seminar today on the occasion of International Women's Day at the India Habitat Centre, New Delhi, and the theme of the seminar was "Gender equality today for a sustainable tomorrow".

In her inaugural address, Mrs. Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary, Department of Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of India, observed that women are making mark in every field, including the Insolvency Profession. Despite hurdles and biases, women have contributing immensely even during these unprecedented Covid times. She shared several anecdotes from her rich experience of over three decades, as a civil servant.
