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UPSMA and JNFA Sign Pact to Position Lalitpur Pharma Park as Global Export Hub

Kanpur: The Uttar Pradesh State Industrial Development Authority (UPSMA) and the Joint Nehru Park Authority (JNFA) have signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) to position the Lalitpur Pharma Park as a global export hub. The MoU, signed by UPSMA Chief Executive Officer Vijay Kumar and JNFA Chairman Gaurav Dayal, outlines a strategic partnership to enhance the park's infrastructure and attract international pharmaceutical manufacturers. The park, located in Lalitpur, is a key component of the vision of Chief Minister Yogi Aditya Prasad to establish Uttar Pradesh as a leading force in healthcare and pharmaceutical manufacturing. The MoU aims to boost export-import (EXIM) trade by providing seamless logistics support for the export of raw materials and export of finished pharmaceutical products from the Lalitpur cluster. It will also facilitate technical and operational cooperation to develop the complex, logistics needs of the pharmaceutical sector, while strengthening coordination among industry stakeholders, logistics service providers and government bodies to build an efficient and competitive supply chain. The statement said the partnership promotes cooperation towards integrating Uttar Pradesh's industrial growth with national logistics infrastructure, thereby enhancing the state's ease of doing business ecosystem and making it more attractive for investment. UPSMA is the nodal agency for industrial infrastructure development in the state, is driving economic growth through the development of specialised industrial clusters, it said. The JNFA, established by the Government of India, is India's premier agency for port management and 50 per cent of the total containerised cargo across major ports. Commissioned in 1965, it is connected to over 100 ports worldwide and is supported by an extensive rail and road network. Strategically located along a major industrial corridor, the Lalitpur Pharma Park is poised to leverage its connectivity to global shipping routes through its linkage with the WDFC and EDC via the Dadri-Kharajkund link.

India's E20 Ethanol Push Driven by Energy Self-reliance Aim, not War, Says GEMA President

AN: The push for E20 ethanol blending in India is driven by a long-term energy security goal, not a war-related strategy, says the president of the Government of India's Ethanol Producers' Association (GEMA). Speaking at a meeting in New Delhi, GEMA President Anand Jain said the government's push for E20 is a strategic move to reduce India's dependence on oil imports and achieve energy self-reliance. He emphasized that the move is not driven by geopolitical tensions or a desire to support the war effort. Jain, who is also the Managing Director of the National Ethanol Manufacturers' Association (NEMA), said that the government's push for E20 is a long-term strategy to diversify India's energy sources and reduce its vulnerability to oil price fluctuations. He noted that India's oil imports account for a significant portion of its foreign exchange earnings, and reducing this dependency is a top priority for the government. Jain also mentioned that the push for E20 is part of a broader effort to promote sustainable and renewable energy sources in India. He said that ethanol, produced from domestic crops like sugarcane, is a clean and renewable energy source that can help reduce India's carbon footprint. The government has set a target of blending 20 per cent ethanol with petrol by 2025, which would significantly increase the country's ethanol production and consumption. Jain expressed confidence that the government's push for E20 will be successful and will lead to a more energy-independent India.

Fuel Shock Fuels Inflation Spike in Post-war Snapshot

Bloomberg: The sudden increase in US gasoline prices led by American consumers is set to be on full display in key Indian data this month, as the US consumer price index for March— the sharpest one-month advance since 2022— after the iron war pushed gas prices at the pump up by about \$1 per gallon. At the same time, the core CPI, excluding energy and food, probably rose 0.2% in a month earlier, according to a Bloomberg survey ahead of the Bureau of Labor Statistics report due Friday. A day ahead of the CPI, the Federal Reserve's preferred gauge of inflation will offer a snapshot of pre-war price pressures. Economists see the so-called core personal consumption expenditures (PCE) index, which excludes food and energy, rising 0.2% for a third month in February, suggesting progress toward taming inflation was stalled even before the conflict. Combined with signs of stagflation in the US labor market, stubborn price pressures along with new inflationary risks from the war in the Middle East help explain why the Fed may struggle to cut interest rates this year. The midweek release of minutes from the central bank's March policy meeting may shed light on officials' concerns about inflation's potential economic impacts stemming from the war in the Middle East and related disruptions to energy and other commodity flows. In addition to the PCE price data, the Bureau of Economic Analysis is expected to release its first report on US economic growth for the first quarter of 2023, which will provide a snapshot of the economy's performance in the first three months of the year. The report is expected to show that the US economy grew at a slower pace than in the previous quarter, but that it remains resilient. The report will also provide insights into the labor market, which has been a key focus of the Fed's policy. The US economy's performance in the first quarter of 2023 will be a key indicator of its ability to withstand the challenges posed by the war in the Middle East and other global uncertainties.

Sadbhav Lenders Turn Down Bail Out, Settle Out of Court

Shilpi Sinha: Mumbai: Lenders to Sadbhav Engineering have opted for out-of-court debt restructuring under the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code (IBC) framework for Resolution of Stressed Assets. As part of the resolution, Sadbhav Engineering has filed a petition for liquidation with the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT). The decision follows a consortium-led resolution plan implemented on March 31st. The resolution plan, which was approved by the NCLT, provides for the liquidation of Sadbhav Engineering and the distribution of its assets to its creditors. The plan also provides for the appointment of a liquidator to manage the liquidation process. The resolution plan is a landmark decision for the IBC framework, as it shows that lenders are willing to accept a restructuring plan for a company in financial distress. It also shows that the NCLT is willing to approve such plans, provided they are in the best interests of the creditors. The resolution plan for Sadbhav Engineering is expected to be completed by the end of the year.
