Hamas says Israeli fire at aid camp kills 27, 90 hurt

Israeli military denies opening fire on civilians, launches a probe

RAFAH

PALESTINIAN health officials and witnesses said Israeli forces fired on people as they headed toward an aid distribution site on Tuesday, killing at least 27, in the third such incident in three days.

The near-daily shootings have come after an Israeli and US-backed foundation established aid distribution points inside Israeli military zones, a system it says is designed to circumvent Hamas.

The Israeli military denied opening fire on civilians or blocking them from reaching the aid sites. The Gaza Humanitarian Foundation, which operates the sites, says there has been no violence in or around them.

There were three children and two women among the dead, according to Mohammed Saqr, head of nursing at Nasser Hospital.

The shootings all occurred at the Flag Roundabout, around a kilometer (1,000 yards) from one of the GHF's distribution sites in the now mostly uninhabited southern city of Rafah.

UN condemns loss of lives at aid site

Gaza: Jeremy Laurence, a spokesman for the Office of the UN High Commissioner for Human Rights, told reporters in Geneva that it is not acceptable that 27 people were killed, including three children and two women, at an aid distribution site.

Yasser Abu Lubda, a 50-year-old displaced from Rafah, said the shooting started around 4 a.m. on Tuesday and that he saw several people killed or wounded.



Russia: No quick breakthrough possible

MOSCOW

RUSSIA on Tuesday said it was wrong to expect a quick breakthrough in Ukraine talks, a day after Moscow rejected Kyiv's call for an unconditional ceasefire at negotiations in Istanbul.

The sides agreed on a large-scale swap of captured soldiers and exchanged their roadmaps to peace, or so-called "memorandums", at the discussions, which lasted under two hours.

More than three years into Russia's offensive - which has killed tens of thousands on both sides and forced millions from their homes in eastern Ukraine - the two sides appear as irreconcilable as ever.

"The settlement issue is extremely complex and involves a large number of nuances," Kremlin spokesman Dmitry Peskov told reporters on Tuesday.

"It would be wrong to expect immediate solutions and break-

throughs," he added. Moscow demanded Ukraine pull its troops out of four eastern and southern regions that Moscow claims to have annexed as a precondition to pausing its offensive, according to the document handed to the Ukrainians

that was published by Russian state media.

Kyiv pressed for a full and unconditional ceasefire. Russia instead offered a partial truce of two to three days in some areas of the frontline, its top negotiator said after the talks.

Elsewhere, a Russian attack targeted the Ukrainian city of Sumy on Tuesday, killing at least three people and leaving many injured, officials said.

On the other side, Russia on Tuesday said Ukraine was behind rail blasts in its western border regions that derailed a passenger train, killing seven people and wounding dozens more at the weekend.

The deadly explosion in Russia's Bryansk region that borders Ukraine caused a road bridge to collapse onto a railway line late Saturday and derail a passenger train, the authorities said.

Dutch govt falls as far-right leader Wilders quits coalition

THE HAGUE

FAR-RIGHT leader Geert Wilders brought down the Dutch government Tuesday by pulling out of a shaky coalition in a row over immigration, sparking a political crisis and likely heralding fresh elections.

The withdrawal came just weeks before a NATO summit in the Netherlands, and ushered in a period of uncertainty for the European Union's fifth-largest economy and major exporter.

After a stormy last-ditch meeting aimed at salvaging the four-party coalition, Wilders emerged to say he had no choice but to pull his ministers out of the cabinet.

UN aid convoy attacked in Sudan's Darfur, 5 dead

MOSCOW

A United Nations convoy delivering aid to the besieged city of El-Fasher in Sudan's famine-stricken western Darfur region was attacked, leading to the death of five aid workers, UNICEF said on Tuesday.

The convoy organised by the World Food Programme and UNICEF came under attack on Monday near Al-Koma village in North Darfur state, the UN agencies said in a joint statement, adding that "multiple trucks were burned and critical humanitarian supplies were damaged".

Since April 2023, Africa's third-largest country has been engulfed by a war between the regular army and the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF).

The attack, which took place in North Darfur where over a million people are on the brink of mass starvation, is the latest assault on aid in a country gripped by what the UN calls the world's worst humanitarian crisis.

The convoy, including trucks from the UN children's agency and World Food Programme, was in Al-Koma, North Darfur, "waiting for approval to proceed to El-Fasher" when it came under attack on Monday, UNICEF spokeswoman Eva Hinds told AFP. She did not specify who was behind the attack. The two warring sides traded blame over Monday's attack which took place in an RSF-held town. AFP

SOUTH KOREA

Exit poll predicts Lee Jae-myung poised to win

MOSCOW

CENTRE-LEFT candidate Lee Jae-myung hailed South Korean voters' "great decision" and vowed not to disappoint them as he was poised Tuesday to win a snap presidential election by a wide margin, capping months of political chaos.

With almost 50% of the

votes counted, Lee of the left-leaning Democratic Party led with 49.01%, followed by challenger Kim Moon-soo of the conservative People Power Party (PPP) with 42.62%.

Speaking outside his home, Lee thanked voters for placing their trust in him. "I will do my utmost to fulfil the great responsibility and mission entrusted to me, so as not to disappoint the expectations of our people," Lee told reporters.

Lee will face a bulging in-tray, including global trade vicissitudes chafing the export-driven economy, low birth rates and an emboldened North Korea expanding its arsenal.
