Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India organises a Workshop on “Committee of Creditors: An Institution of Public Trust”

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) jointly with the State Bank of India organised a one-day workshop on “Committee of Creditors: An Institution of Public Trust” on 22nd April, 2019 at Kolkata.
