

ISRO chief rejects privatisation concerns, clarifies reforms

PTI, BENGALURU: ISRO Chairman V Narayanan on Monday said the space agency remains a government organisation and dismissed concerns over its privatisation, saying it is working with private companies and startups to expand India's space ecosystem.

His reaction came after nine employee associations at ISRO wrote to the Chairman on September 4, seeking official clarification on the proposed transfer of its manufacturing and operational functions to private entities.

Speaking to reporters after the inaugural ceremony of the ninth edition of the Bengaluru Space Expo (BSX) here, Narayanan said India's space programme is about 64-65 years old, and that at present there are

56 space assets in the sky serving the common man of the country, but the need is huge numbers.

Recalling that since the space sector reforms were rolled out six years ago, he said, "we are supposed to hand-hold the private sector, startup companies, and grow the space ecosystem."

"In fact, whenever a PSLV or a GSLV is lifting off, almost 80 per cent budget is invested in Indian industries. A total of 450 industries are working for us," he said.

On the concerns raised by the employee associations, Narayanan said, "So, surely, my colleagues, whatever they have, is a genuine concern. It is our responsibility to clarify."

He clarified that ISRO is not privatised and remains

US, INDIA MOVING BEYOND COOPERATION IN SPACE SECTOR: SERGIO GOR

PTI, BENGALURU: US Ambassador to India Sergio Gor on Monday said that the United States and India were moving beyond cooperation in the space sector towards "co-creation", with the two countries jointly designing instruments, funding startups and co-authoring the future of human discovery. He was speaking at the inaugural ceremony of the ninth edition of the Bengaluru Space Expo (BSX), being organised by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) in partnership with ISRO, IN-SPaCE and NewSpace India Limited (NSIL), from September 7 to 9 at the Bangalore International Exhibition Centre (BIEC). Referring to the ninth US-India Civil Space Joint Working Group recently held in Bengaluru, the US Ambassador said that those discussions affirmed that their partnership is no longer just about cooperation; it is about co-creation.

now (have) so many activities. The space ecosystem in the country has to grow and the space economy has to grow," he said.

Delhi building collapse most unfortunate; MCD, DU responsible too: Delhi HC

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Delhi High Court on Monday said a building-collapse incident at Satya Niketan here that left seven people dead and several injured was "most unfortunate".

The court said not only the building owners are responsible for the tragedy, but also the Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) and the Delhi University (DU), which has failed to provide adequate housing facilities to outstation students, who are forced to take shelter in private paying guest (PG) accommodation.

A bench of Chief Justice Dvendra Kumar Upadhyaya and Justice Tejas Karia asked authorities to double up the efforts in the rescue operations so that human lives can be saved.

Solicitor General Tushar Mehta, who represented the Centre, the Delhi government, the Delhi Police and the MCD in the matter, assured

the court that all possible steps are being taken to rescue those trapped under the debris.

He said the government is actively monitoring the situation and some time is needed. Mehta assured the court that the authorities will take all decisions in the interest of everyone concerned and that no stone will be left unturned.

The court was hearing a public interest litigation (PIL) matter relating to the building collapse.

It asked the authorities to file their separate replies to the petition within 10 days and listed the matter for further hearing on September 25.

The plea was mentioned for an urgent hearing and the court allowed it to be listed on Monday itself.

The building at Satya Niketan, which housed a boys' paying-guest accommodation near the Delhi University's (DU) South Campus, collapsed on Sunday while repair work was underway.

5 MCD OFFICIALS SUSPENDED OVER COLLAPSE

PTI, NEW DELHI: Chief Minister Rekha Gupta visited the site again on the second day to take stock of the rescue work, and warned of strict action against officials responsible for the tragedy. Within hours of her visit, Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD) deputy commissioner of South zone Rakesh Kumar and four engineers were placed under suspension. According to Gupta, nearly 80 per cent of the debris had been removed from the site where the around 30-year-old five-storey building stood before it came crashing down on Sunday afternoon, and rescuers were clearing rubble from the basement. The chief minister also directed officials to seal all five-storey structures in the city.

India, China armies review LAC situation in Arunachal

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Indian and Chinese armies reviewed the situation along the Line of Actual Control (LAC) in the Arunachal Pradesh sector, days after the two sides held Special Representative talks in Beijing on the festering boundary question.

The focus of the corps commander-level talks at the Wacha-Damai border meeting point in Arunachal Pradesh's Kibithoo region on Sunday was to maintain peace and tranquillity along

the frontier, people familiar with the matter said.

The Indian delegation was headed by Lt General Girish Kalia, the commander of the Army's Dimapur-based 3 Corps. There is no official word yet on the talks.

The meeting also came amid reports of aggressive military posturing by Chinese troops along the LAC in the Upper Subansiri region of Arunachal Pradesh.

In the Special Representative (SR) talks on August 25, India conveyed to China

the importance of maintaining peace and tranquillity along the frontier for overall bilateral ties.
