CCMC wants to take over Siruvani water scheme

Commissioner says can supply water at a lower cost than TWAD

THE Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) council on Thursday passed a resolution proposing to take over maintenance of Siruvani Dam, treatment plant and water supply works from the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage (TWAD) Board. This was among the 48 resolutions passed by the council.

CCMC commissioner M Prathap said, "In order to get funds from World Bank, the maintenance and water supply from Siruvani dam was handed over to TWAD Board for a period 20 years in 1984. Although the contract got over in 2004, TWAD board has not yet handed over the maintenance and other works to CCMC."

By taking over the project. Prathap said, the CCMC can treat and supply water to the city a much lesser cost than TWAD. "The TWAD has been charging ₹11.5 for every litre of water purified and supplied to corporation areas. As of May 2023, TWAD board sent a bill of ₹334.10 crore to CCMC, of which around ₹106.94 crore has been paid. By taking over maintenance work from TWAD board, we can save around ₹2 to 3 crore per month in water bill," Prathap explained.

The resolution proposes taking over all assets and properties linked to the Siruvani dam water supply and waiving off charges due to TWAD since CCMC had executed the project using its resources.

Prathap further said CCMC could enter into agreements with local bodies to which Siruvani water is supplied and charge them a fee. However, councillors of the CPI and CPM opposed the resolution saying it would eventually lead to privatisation of the project. Ward 12 councillor Ramamoorthy of

FURORE broke out in the monthly council meeting of the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) on Thursday after a heated exchange broke out between the mayor and the central zone chairperson of DMK.

Central Zone Chairperson Meena Logu asked Mayor Kalpana Anandakumar why she didn't give approval to her proposal to fix the rent for the VOC public ground. She also accused the mayor of being biased and not giving approval to her proposals out of political vendetta.

"Even during the AIADMK period, I was not treated this way. You have been taking revenge against me out of political vendetta. I strongly condemn you for unnecessarily targeting me and I shall stage a walkout of the meeting for your acts," Meena said.

Mayor said, "I'm not saying that I will not approve your request. It's under consideration. I shall consult with the minister about it and will make a final call on the matter. I'm not taking revenge against anyone for anything. There's no need for me to act in such a way."

CPI said, "Just like how the 24x7 water supply project was handed over to Suez Projects, the Corporation would hand over the Siruvani project to private players in future. We strongly oppose the resolution." Despite their opposition, the resolution was passed in

INDIAN textile industry will regain its lost glory soon and Tamil Nadu will be in the forefront of the revival, union minister for Textiles, Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal has said.

Speaking after unveiling the bust of independent India's first finance minister RK Shanmugham Chetty, at the Southern India Mills' Association on Thursday, the minister said "British destroyed the textile industry in Coimbatore region for the growth of Manchester. The Manchester of India, Coim-

Replying to a query on the challenges faced by the textile industry, Goyal said, "The world is going through challenging times. All developed nations, including the USA, are facing economic recession. In this situation, I am proud that our textile industry continues to hold firm, and is doing a good work."
