New Delhi: External affairs minister raised the issue of Pakistan's support to the perpetrators of the Pahalgam terrorist attack, while highlighting the challenge that the UN faces from terrorism. Speaking on the UN Day, Jaishankar also said all is not well with the UN as its decision-making neither the membership nor addresses global priorities. Without naming Pakistan, the minister said that a sitting member of the Security Council (UNSC) which twice protected the group that claimed responsibility for the April 22 attack.

**Will maintain high military operational readiness along China frontier: Rajnath**

New Delhi: India will continue to maintain high military operational readiness along the frontier with China while the reset in bilateral ties takes place, defence minister Rajnath Singh said on Friday, asking the armed forces to remain "alert and ready always" on both the western and eastern fronts and "never underestimate the adversary". The ongoing talks with China and de-escalation steps have demonstrated India's "balanced and firm" foreign policy. "Our policy is clear that there will be dialogue and our readiness on the border will remain intact," Singh said, addressing the Army commanders' conference being held in Jaisalmer. While Indian and Chinese troops disengaged from the two remaining face-off sites at Depsang and Demchok in eastern Ladakh a year ago, actual de-escalation is still some distance away, with both sides still maintaining a large number of forward deployed troops and heavy weapon systems. **TNN**

"When a sitting security council member openly protects the very organisation that claims responsibility for the barbaric terrorist attack such as Pahalgam, what does it do to the credibility of multilateralism," asked Jaishankar, addressing an event on the UN Day. The minister also

slammed efforts to draw an equivalence between India and Pakistan after India's Op Sindoor that targeted terrorist headquarters and camps in Pakistan and PoK. "Similarly, if victims and perpetrators of terrorism are equated in the name of global strategy, how much more cynical can the world get. When self-proclaimed terrorists are shielded from the sanctioning process, what does it say for the sincerity of those involved?" he said. The minister said the UN debates had become increasingly polarised and any meaningful reform obstructed by the reform process itself. However, he also stressed that commitment to multilateralism must remain strong as the world cannot abandon hope. "However flawed, the United Nations must be supported in this time of crisis. Our faith in international cooperation must be reiterated and indeed renewed. It is in that spirit that we all meet to mark this occasion and seek to build a better world," said Jaishankar.

## Navy gets first sub-hunting craft from Cochin Shipyard

New Delhi: The Navy got delivery of the first submarine-hunting shallow watercraft of the eight being built by the Cochin Shipyard, in another step towards enhancing maritime security in the littorals. The 78-metre-long specialised warship named 'Mahe', with a displacement of around 1,100 tonnes, packs a punch in anti-submarine warfare (ASW) with advanced radars, sonars and communication systems as well as torpedoes and multifunctional anti-submarine rockets among other weapons. The Cochin Shipyard and the Kolkata-based GRSE are each building eight of these ASW shallow watercrafts, at an overall cost of ₹2,622 crore, under contracts inked in April 2019. All the warships are supposed to be delivered by 2028. Two of them built by GRSE were commissioned recently as INS Arnavid and INS Androm. Mahe, named after the historic port town in Pudukkottai, is the first to roll out of the Cochin shipyard and is equipped for underwater surveillance, low-intensity maritime operations (LIMO) and ASW in coastal waters.
