Six officers were selected for the prestigious Good Governance Awards, which include a cash prize of Rs. 2 lakh each. The recipients are IAS officers J. Innocent Divya, Managing Director of the Tamil Nadu Skill Development Corporation; S. Divyadarshini, Managing Director of the Tamil Nadu Women Development Corporation; V.P. Jeyaseelan, Collector of Virudhunagar; K. Elambahavath,

Director of Public Libraries; N. Gopalakrishnan, Member Secretary of the Transplant Authority of Tamil Nadu; and D. Vanitha, Chief Technical Officer of the Mudhalvarin Mugavari Department.

The Home Department's official release also named 10 police officers to receive the Chief Minister's Police Medal for Excellence in Investigation. Maiden I-Day fete sans Mahatma

Can anyone imagine that Mahatma Gandhi, the architect of Indian freedom struggle, who was instrumental in gaining Independence from the colonial rulers, wasn't part of the first Independence Day celebrations. Strange to infer, Gandhiji was fasting in protest against the Hindu-Muslim riots that were taking place in Bengal then and hence couldn't attend the fete. Flipping through the pages of Indian Independence history revealed some unknown info. No gainsaying the fact that thousands of freedom fighters spread across the country sacrificed their life for the cause of freedom movement. Sadly, large number of Tyagis died at the hands of Britishers while many of them experienced capital punishment including Bhagat Singh, Sukhdev and Shivaram Rajguru.

It is learnt that Lord Mountbatten who served as the last Viceroy of India and briefly as the first Governor-General of the Dominion of India was forced to attend the Independence Day of both India and Pakistan, which is why he brought forward Pakistan's Independence Day to 14th August. Yet another interesting info is that free India didn't have the national anthem during the first Independence Day celebrations. The Bengali

version of 'Jana Gana Mana' was written in 1911, but was adopted as India's national anthem in 1950.

Lord Mountbatten chose 15th August as India's Independence Day because it honoured the second anniversary of Japan's surrender to the Allied forces. Mountbatten, who became the first Governor-General of independent India on 15 August 1947 on the request of India's first Prime Minister Jawaharlal Nehru. The Life magazine noted on his reception in India that, "The people gathered in the streets to cheer Mountbatten as no European had ever been cheered before." During his reign as governor-general until 21 June 1948, he played a significant role in the political integration of India and persuaded many princely states to join India.

Further, Hindi wasn't the national language of India. It got the official language status in 1949. Moreover, after Independence, 560 princely States became a part of the Indian union. Hyderabad was the last State to become a part of the Indian union. Meanwhile, it is inferred that the border between India and Pakistan was drawn by British lawyer Sir Cyril Radcliffe.

Not many aware that Mahatma Gandhi wanted Congress Party to be disbanded as its

objective to attain freedom was achieved. A day before Gandhi's assassination, he had written a 'Draft Constitution of Congress'. Goa known as 'The Miami of India' was a Portuguese State when India became independent and was brought under Indian Union only in 1961. The first Union territory got its State-hood in 1987.

It is believed that astrology played a role in determining the timing of India's independence. Hardeo ji and Surya Narain Vyas of Ujjain advised Babu Rajendra Prasad, who would later become India's first President, that August 15, 1947, was considered inauspicious according to astrological calculations. Upon learning that the British would only allow India to select a specific hour on that date, Hardeo strongly recommended that the declaration be made at midnight.

Dadabhai Naoroji who was an activist during the independence movement was the first Indian member in the UK's House of Commons while Sucheta Kripalani, a noted freedom fighter was India's first female chief minister who led the government in Uttar Pradesh from 1963 to 1967. There are umpteen such unknown and undisclosed facts about the Indian freedom struggle and the tyagis.
