

From modelling dreams to trap: Suspected int'l sex racket bared

Probe gathered momentum this week with arrest of 3 women allegedly linked to operation

WHAT began as promises of glamorous modelling careers has allegedly ended in drugging, blackmail, and sexual exploitation for several young women from Kerala. Those are the details emerging from a Kochi City police probe into a suspected international sex trafficking racket operating under the cover of the modelling industry.

The investigation gathered momentum this week with the arrest of three women allegedly linked to the operation. The latest arrest is that of Manjima, 24, a native of Ponnani, who was taken into custody by the Maradu police from Ponnani on Tuesday. Earlier, investigators had arrested Aleena, aged between 25 and 28, native of Thiruvananthapuram, and Stoye C Sindhu, Perumbavoor native, believed to be the alleged kingpin behind the racket. Sources said Aleena also has links to criminal rackets operating in the city.

Sindhu, reportedly in her 50s and originally from Thiruvananthapuram, was tracked down and arrested from Mum-

bai on Monday. Officials said she is being brought to Kochi for extensive questioning, which investigators expect will reveal crucial details about the network, its financial operations and possible international links.

The probe began around two weeks ago after Maradu police received a complaint from a young woman who alleged that she had been trapped in a sex racket after being approached with offers connected to the modelling industry. According to investigators, the complaint soon pointed towards an organised network that may have been functioning for more than a year.

Sources said the investigation team later received a second complaint from another woman after she came to know about the case. Police believe more victims may gradually come forward as details of the racket emerge.

Investigators said Aleena

and Manjima allegedly used their modelling careers as a cover to identify and recruit potential victims, luring them with promises of high-paying modelling or beautician jobs abroad. Sources said investigators are now examining how the duo came into contact with Sindhu and how long they had allegedly been operating together.

According to police, once the women agreed, the gang allegedly arranged visiting visas and coordinated their travel to Gulf nations.

"When they reached Gulf countries, they were allegedly given luxurious accommodation and treated well initially. Later, they were drugged, abused, and blackmailed using private videos," a senior police officer associated with the investigation said.

Sources close to the probe said several women were allegedly kept under constant surveillance and treated "like slaves" until their visiting vi-

sas expired, after which they were sent back home.

Kochi City Police Commissioner Kaliraj Mahesh Kumar said, "We formed a special investigation team headed by Deputy Commissioner of Police Aswathy Jiji. So far, we have identified around five people linked to this racket, of whom three have been arrested. One of the accused was apprehended at Mumbai airport while attempting to flee the country. Efforts are under way to trace the remaining two suspects. We request victims to come forward, and we assure them complete confidentiality."

Police suspect the racket may have operated through multiple handlers across states and abroad, with links possibly extending beyond Gulf countries. Officials acknowledged that fear of social stigma and the alleged existence of compromising videos may be preventing survivors from approaching the police. Senior officers said efforts are under way to recover digital evidence and prevent the circulation of any private videos allegedly used by the racket.

Strays: Kerala struggles to implement SC order

NEARLY eight months after the Supreme Court directed the removal of stray dogs from public places, Kerala continues to struggle with its implementation. Barring two local bodies — Thiruvananthapuram corporation and Tripunithura municipality — none of the local bodies in the state have been able to comply with the SC order to clear and shelter stray dogs from schools, hospitals, bus depots, railway stations, and other sensitive public spaces.

On Tuesday, the SC refused to dilute its landmark 2025 directions on stray dog management. It issued strict orders to all states to euthanise violent and aggressive strays and to shelter dogs captured from public spaces. The SC also rejected all pleas and petitions filed by NGOs and animal welfare activists against the institutional sheltering of stray dogs.

Meanwhile, local bodies across Kerala continue to cite a lack of shelters, insufficient animal birth control (ABC) centres, inadequate funds, and the absence of a clear legal framework to permanently house dogs removed from public spaces.

According to local self-government department (LSGD) offi-



cials, the state has already begun strengthening its infrastructure to manage the crisis, which includes setting up shelters and expanding ABC centres. "Thiruvananthapuram corporation has set up a shelter for around 50 dogs in collaboration with an NGO, while the Tripunithura municipality has developed its own facility with a capacity to house 50 to 100 dogs," said Dr A Sasi Kumar, State Public Health and Environment Officer, LSGD.

Public protest is also becoming a huge challenge for local bodies. Thiruvananthapuram corporation's move to shelter stray dogs at a private shelter was stalled following local protest. The state currently has 20 functional ABC centres, with 17 new centres under construction. Of these, work has been completed on nine centres and three have already become operational.

Pooram tragedy: HC initiates suo motu case

KOCHI: The Kerala High Court has initiated a suo motu case in connection with the Thrissur Pooram fireworks tragedy at Mundathikode on April 21, which resulted in 16 deaths, multiple injuries, and significant property damage.

Chief Justice Soumen Sen directed the initiation of suo motu Public Interest Litigation (PIL) proceedings to regulate activities involving massive fireworks, examine issues arising from the incident, and consider issuing appropriate directions to ensure strict compliance with statutory provisions and safety norms relating to fireworks activities in the state. The proceedings also aim to educate the public about the adverse effects of large-scale fireworks displays and adopt measures to prevent such accidents in the future. The court noted that the incident reportedly occurred at a fireworks manufacturing unit on the outskirts of Thrissur where fireworks of the Thiruvambady Devaswom were being prepared.



EXPRESS READ 26k pharmacies across K'taka to shut today

Bengaluru: Over 26,000 retail medical outlets across Karnataka will be shut down for 24 hours starting at midnight on Wednesday, as part of a nationwide bandh protesting against online medicine sales and steep discounts offered by e-pharmacy platforms. Pharmacies operating within hospitals and nursing homes will remain open. The association said most chemists across the state are expected to participate in the protest.

Jumbo Marthanda dies of injuries, intestine was ruptured

MARTHANDA (53), the tuskleless bull elephant (makhana) succumbed to its injuries around 11am on Tuesday. It had suffered serious injuries when attacked by Kanjan, the 26-year-old tusker, on Monday morning at Dubare Elephant Camp in Madikeri.

Deputy Conservator of Forests, Madikeri, Abhishek V said Marthanda stopped responding to treatment on Tuesday morning. It had seven injuries, five of

which were severe. The post-mortem concluded around 5pm, and the report showed that the primary cause of death was the rupturing of its large intestine, apart from other injuries.

According to the mahouts, Marthanda was resting in the water near Kanjan. The movement when Marthanda tried to get up, agitated Kanjan. The initial push by Marthanda led to a deadly fight between the two bulls, in which Chennai tourist Junesha S lost her life. Since Kanjan is a tusker and was

standing, he overpowered Marthanda, grievously injured him and also chased him for some

distance. During the fight, Kanjan's kawadi Kiran was mounted on him and trying to control him, while its mahout Vijay was shouting commands. Marthanda's kawadi Naveen and mahout Gous were also shouting commands from the side, but to no avail.

According to the forest department, Kanjan was captured in 2014 from Yesalur in Hassan, while Marthanda was captured in 2023 from Alur in Hassan. The two have been staying at the camp since. "Despite Kanjan's

history of past aggression, he was not separated from the others. Now he has been isolated and is under constant observation," said veterinarians.

After the situation was brought under control, Marthanda was treated at the camp by department veterinarians Dr Mujeeb and Dr Chittiappa. After post-mortem examination, he was buried on the camp premises. Dr Mujeeb said the two bulls were not in musth. The accident was due to behavioural changes and need for space, which was

disturbed. Department heads reached Dubare on Tuesday to take stock of the situation. Multiple rounds of meetings were held to draw up SOPs (standard operating procedures) on the management of camp elephants.

"Work has started and SOPs should be ready by 10 days. They will then be sent to the state government for approval. Work has started on the ground to distance tourists from elephants. Tourists will no longer be allowed to bathe the elephants," said the officials.

Closure of liquor shops halted in TN

THE TAMIL Nadu State Marketing Corporation (Tasmac) has temporarily halted the closure of 717 liquor shops due to confusion over their exact distance from the restricted areas. Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay's TVK government ordered the shutdown of Tasmac outlets operating within 500 metres of schools, places of worship, and bus depots immediately after assuming office. While authorities successfully closed around 150 shops under the directive, official sources said that the remaining closures have been put on hold until the precise locations and distances of these shops are verified.

A senior Tasmac official told TNIE that several outlets identified for closure were found to have no proper field-level assessment regarding whether they actually fall within the prescribed 500-metre radius. "Proper measurements and verification will be carried out before taking further action," the official said.

TNIE visited several parts of Chennai, including Velachery, Medavakkam, Thiruvanniyur and Triplicane, and found a number of Tasmac outlets continuing to function near temples, bus depots, and educational institutions. However, officials did not provide any clear response on whether these shops would eventually be closed or allowed to continue operations.

Actor Ismail among 2 killed in car accident

TWO people, including actor Ismail, were killed after a car reportedly lost control and rammed into them while they were walking along the roadside on Tuesday evening. The other deceased man is Sajeesh.

The incident occurred near Kannavam ration shop. According to reports, the car was travelling from the Kannavam side towards Koothuparamba when the accident occurred. Though local residents took the injured victims to the hospital, their lives could not be saved. Following the incident, Kannavam police registered a case and began an investigation into the accident. An official with the police said the accident is suspected to have occurred after the driver allegedly dozed off while driving.

In the impact, the front portion of the car, belonging to a Manathana native, was damaged. Ismail has acted in the movie Albhutha Dweep, directed by Vinyan. Sajeesh owns a tyre puncture repair shop in Kannavam. Both were residents of Kannavam.
