

'If opposed, Chennai-Salem expressway won't take off'

Work won't start till 90% of land is acquired, says Minister VK Singh

"THE Chennai-Salem eight-lane expressway project will not take off, if people oppose it," Union Minister of State for Road Transport, Highways, and Civil Aviation VK Singh said in Vellore on Monday.

Singh told reporters after chairing a meeting with the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) office bearers, funds have been sanctioned for the project, but work won't be started, until we get 90% land. "But, if people have problems with that, it will not take off," he said. "At the meeting, we reviewed the ongoing works concerning roads, highways, and transport in Tamil Nadu. And also discussed ways to work for the party's growth in the State and welfare of its workers." When asked about Tamil Nadu government's appeal to remove expired toll gates, Singh said there are tolling procedures followed in consonance with the rule. "But the government hopes to remove all toll structures in the next two years, and

replace them with 'electronic tolling', which means vehicles will automatically be logged at entry and exit points while passing through the area, and the amount will be deducted with respect to the number of kilometres travelled by a passenger," he explained.

Regarding the 'green airport' project, Singh said two places were identified, and the State government has been informed to select one of the sites fit for

development. "Accordingly further steps will be initiated such as carrying out field inspections, and preparing detailed reports," he said.

The minister additionally said a new integrated terminal is under construction at the Chennai Airport and it will come into operation soon. When asked about the status of Vellore Airport, the minister said works are being carried out as per plan.

Cops get mobile forensic unit to expedite probes

VELLORE district police received its own mobile forensic unit to speed up the investigation process. Superintendent of Police S Rajesh Kannan flagged off the unit at the district police office on Monday and handed it over to district forensic science lab assistant director James Anthonyraj.

Rajesh Kannan told TNIE, "The unit will be deployed at the crime scene to collect evidence. On-board forensic experts and staff members will carry out the process of collecting evidence from the spot and examine them."

A mobile forensic unit helps faster recovery of crucial evidence, the Superintendent of Police said. The unit has a

crime-scene cordoning off kit, foot and tyre casting kit, UV&IR, torch lights with batteries kit, blood and semen testing kit,

sexual assault kit, explosive detection and identification kit, gun powder particle testing kit, bullet hole testing kit, narcotic

detection kit, evidence packing and collection kit, general investigation kit, magic magnifier with TPT monitor kit, set of magnifiers kit, and DSLR camera.

On July 1, Chief Minister MK Stalin had launched 14 mobile forensic units produced at a cost of ₹32 crore. Then, DGP C Sylendra Babu sent these units to various Commissionerates and districts, including Vellore.

STEPS will be taken to upgrade the Rajiv Gandhi Institute of Veterinary Education and Research (RIVER), and increase the number of seats in the institution from 100 to 150, announced Chief Minister N Rangasamy on Monday.

Participating as the chief guest at the 23rd graduation day on Monday, Rangasamy said, in veterinary sciences new technologies are coming up, and discoveries are being made. "Research should be done to discover new drugs to treat emerging diseases. The government will provide necessary facilities for the same. Steps will be taken to introduce five new Masters courses, and Ph D programmes," he said, adding that appropriate funds will be provided for new equipment. Considering the increase in future student enrollment, the Union Territory will allocate funds for the construction of additional buildings, classrooms and accommodation.

Chief Minister N Rangasamy gave away degrees to 52 students — 16 boys and 36 girls — from Kerala, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Puducherry and other States.

Centre misusing power to subjugate UT govt: DMK

PUDUCHERRY DMK Convener and Leader of the Opposition R Siva charged that the NDA government at the Centre was misusing their power to subjugate the Puducherry government, forcing the UT to meet their demands.

The BJP intends to gain strength by all means and capture posts, without helping Puducherry with welfare and development, expressed Siva at a public meeting on Sunday night.

Siva added, the party which had lost deposit while contesting the 2016 Assembly polls, won six seats in the 2021 assembly polls out of nine seats it contested by poaching candidates from other parties. Further, the Union government appointed three party supporters as nominated MLAs of the Assembly, and grabbed the Rajya Sabha seat and Speaker post from its ally the AIINRC. Now, with an eye on the lone Puducherry Lok Sabha seat, the party is pre-

paring to contest the seat in 2024. Union Ministers are frequently visiting Puducherry with Home Minister Amit Shah visiting Puducherry once in six months, and Prime Minister Narendra Modi visiting during and after the Assembly polls.

During the last election, the Centre promised double-engine growth for Puducherry with the same party gov-

ernment to fill up 10,000 vacant posts, and remove exile mills.

The UT government intends to present a ₹11,000-crore Budget this year, said the DMK leader, asking how it would be possible when the State does not have any revenue. "The Centre has provided even less central assistance than previous year for the Puducherry budget. There is no money in sectors including regional development and tourism," said Siva. Compensation for GST ended last June. "The UT surrendered the money they got in last year's budget without spending it (as they have no funds to provide the Puducherry component for centrally sponsored schemes). In these circumstances, the government will present a bad budget this year, too, dashing the hopes of residents."

The Opposition leader further said, the only hope was to elect a DMK government to power to protect Puducherry bring in industrial units, and generate employment opportunities.

Man held for murdering wife over land dispute

Villupuram: A 70-year-old man was arrested for allegedly murdering his wife, claiming she died by suicide, regarding a dispute over land. Marakanam police said, Chellakannu (70) of M Puthukkuppam village called police on Thursday alleging that his wife Gnanammal (67) had set herself ablaze on Thursday, after a dispute. After the victim's elder brother Pandurangan raised suspicions over her death, police sent the body for autopsy. The report revealed the victim was assaulted, strangled to death, and then burnt with petrol. During inquiry, Chellakannu confessed that he murdered Gnanammal as she refused to register her 1.5 acre in Chellakannu's name. He was held and remanded to judicial custody. ENS

80 CCTV cameras installed in Cuddalore

Cuddalore: In attempts to reduce crimes rates, and ramp up monitoring, district police on Monday installed 80 CCTV cameras at 20 spots in Bhuvanagiri town, taking the total number of cameras in the district to 4,685. According to police, SP S Sakthi Ganesan took several measures to install 520 CCTV in public spots, and 297 in police stations worth 1.3 crore across Cuddalore. Based on this effort, Collector K Balasubramanian recommended utilising funds from the district MLAs' constitution development fund for the same. Meanwhile, police held an awareness programme at Silver Beach here on Sunday evening. Police explained laws protecting women and children from crimes, and measures to be taken to prevent them. ENS

Man arrested for swindling vendor of ₹5 lakh

Cuddalore: The district cyber crime unit on Monday arrested a 44-year-old man from Bengaluru for cheating ₹5 lakh from a tiles vendor. Three mobile phones, three SIM cards, and fake documents were seized from the accused. Police said, R Raja (35) of B Mutlur near Bhuvanagiri, a tiles shop owner said while searching for raw materials, he chanced upon wholesale seller V Sudarsanaraju (44) of Banashankari in Bengaluru. Raja had booked an order for tiles worth ₹5 lakh, and deposited the money to Sudarsanaraju's bank account but the tiles never arrived, said police. Based on his complaint, police tracked down Sudarsanaraju, and arrested him.
