Now the superstar has shared an official update from the movie as he met the Tamil Nadu governor RN Ravi today. Addressing the press and media after the meeting, Rajinikanth has said that he is not thinking of entering into politics when questioned about his political stand as several reports claimed that he is planning again for a political entry. The expert actor has then

confirmed that ‘the Jailer’ shooting will begin on August 15th or 25th as the film set work is yet to be completed. The set work for ‘Jailer’ is underway in a film city in Hyderabad, and the major portions of the film are expected to be shot on the grand set. Rajinikanth has recently locked his look for the film as he completed the test shoot for ‘Jailer’ with a few stars of the film. 900+ US flights canceled, 6,300 delayed

Chicago, Aug 9: Amid heavy rain and flash flood alerts, another wave of airline cancellations and delays were witnessed across the US. On Sunday according to the flight tracking website, FlightAware, there were 912 flights canceled. A total of 6,378 flights were delayed across the States, a CNN report said. Chicago O’Hare saw the most cancellations and delays on Sunday, with approximately 12 per

cent of flights canceled, and over 40 per cent of flights delayed. Chicago saw heavy rain on Sunday, including a flash flood warning that was in place for parts of the afternoon for portions of Cook County. On Saturday a total of 657 flight were cancelled and 7,267 delayed within, into or out of the US. American Airlines canceled 4 per cent of its flights and 24 per cent of its Saturday flights were

delayed, according to FlightAware. United had 4 per cent of its flights canceled and 23 per cent delayed, followed by Delta with 2 per cent canceled and 22 per cent of its Saturday flights delayed, FlightAware noted. Around 41 per cent of JetBlue’s flights and 36 per cent of Southwest’s flights were also delayed on Saturday, according to the website

SCR completes electrification of Dharmavaram - Pakala section

Hyderabad, Aug 9: South Central Railway (SCR) has achieved one more milestone in the path of electrification of railway lines across its network by completing the electrification work between the entire stretch of Dharmavaram - Pakala section of Andhra Pradesh.



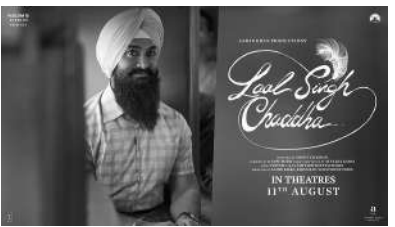
The last stretch of Kalikiri - Tummanamgutta for a distance of 50 Kms in Dharmavaram - Pakala section has now been electrified giving boost to Mission electrification, a SCR statement here said on Monday. This has led to major infrastructure enhancement particularly in the Rayalaseema region in the state of Andhra Pradesh duly facilitating for the introduction of electric traction in the interior sections of the Anantapur, Kurnool and Chittoor Districts of Rayalaseema region. The trains can now be operated with electric traction on end to end basis destined to Tirupati, Katpadi, Chennai and beyond via Dharmavaram, Kadiri, Pakala. The Railway lines of the entire Guntakal Division have now been electrified. The section between Kalikiri - Tummanamgutta for a

distance of 50 Kms has been electrified as part of the Dharmavaram - Pakala electrification project. This project had been sanctioned in the year 2017-18 for a distance of 228 Kms at an estimated cost of Rs 253 crores. The section between Dharmavaram - Kadiri for a distance of 68 Route Kms was completed in March 2021 and the sections between Kadiri - Tummanamgutta for 54 Kms and Pakala - Kalikiri for 56 Kms have been electrified in March 2022. The last stretch in the section between Tummanamgutta - Kalikiri for 50 Kms has now been completed marking the completion of Dharmavaram - Pakala electrification project as well as the electrification of the entire Guntakal Division. SCR General Manager (In-Charge) Arun Kumar

Jain has advised to speed up the electrification works across the Zone so as to complete all works within the year 2023.

New rush to visit Isreal

Jerusalem, Aug 9: Israel recorded 249,900 tourists arrivals in the country in July, the highest monthly record since the COVID-19 pandemic hit the country in early 2020, Israel’s Central Bureau of Statistics said. Israel has logged a total of 1.26 million foreign tourists since the beginning of 2022, about eight times higher than the 156,200 tourists in the January-July period last year. However, the monthly number is

still behind the pre-pandemic level seen in February 2020, when some 343,800 tourists arrived in Israel. Israel reopened international tourists in November 2021, allowing the entry of vaccinated and recovered tourists, and in March, the entry of non-vaccinated ones. The number of Israelis who went abroad in July reached more than one million, compared to 766,700 the month before and only 3,000 in April 2020, the statistics show.

8 exotic animals thrill Meghalaya zoologists

Shillong, Aug 9: Wildlife officials are making efforts to identify the exact species of the eight exotic animals, including birds, which were rescued from a Guwahati-bound vehicle in Meghalaya’s West Jaintia Hills district on Friday night, a wildlife official said on Monday. The exotic animals which include two Hoolock Gibbons, two Grey Langurs, a Great Indian Hornbill, a Phayre’s Leaf monkey, an otter, including birds were

rescued by Meghalaya police at 8th mile near Jowai, the district headquarters of West Jaintia Hills. Two wildlife traffickers - Kormola Bru and Michael Zosangliana - both natives of Mizoram have been booked under the Wildlife (Protection) Act and produced before a local court. These animals are not endemic to India although they look similar to their Indian counterpart and probably were smuggled in from Myanmar or other South East

Asian countries. We are in touch with the Wildlife Institute of India to help us identify the exact species, but these are exotic. Principal Chief Conservator of Forest (wildlife and biodiversity) S.M. Sahai told UNI. He said the rescued animals are being kept at the District Forest Office (Wildlife) in West Jaintia Hills and veterinarians are monitoring the health of the rescued animals.
