Voting begins in Israel amid political crisis

JERUSALEM

FOR the fifth time since 2019, Israelis were voting in national elections on Tuesday, hoping to break the political deadlock that has paralysed the country for the past 3.5 years.

Again, the vote centres around former premier Benjamin Netanyahu's fitness to lead while he faces corruption charges. And while polls predict another stalemate, Netanyahu is looking to the surging power of far-right lawmaker Itamar Ben-Gvir to propel him back to power.

Election officials said that by 2 p.m. local time, turnout stood at 38.9%, the highest at that time since 1999. But there was no breakdown of the vote that might show who was benefiting.

Netanyahu's main rival is the man who helped out him last year, the centrist caretaker PM Yair Lapid, who has warned against the nationalist and religious alliance that would emerge should Netanyahu return to power. "Vote for the state of Israel, and for the future of our children," Lapid said after casting his ballot.

Ben-Gvir, who has been convicted of incitement for his anti-Arab rhetoric and has promised to deport Arab lawmakers, has seen his clout rise in the polls ahead of the vote and has demanded a key portfolio should Netanyahu be tapped to form a government.

With former allies refusing to sit under him while he is on trial, Netanyahu has been unable to form a viable majority government in the 120-seat Knesset, or parliament. "I'm a little worried," Netanyahu said after the voting. "I hope we end the day with a smile." Netanyahu's opponents, are equally hamstrung in cobbling together the 61 seats needed to rule.

In Israel's fragmented politics, no single party has ever won a parliamentary majority. Netanyahu's most likely path to the premiership requires an alliance with extreme nationalists and religious ultra-Orthodox parties. **AP**

South Korean officials admit responsibility in Halloween tragedy

SEOUL

SOUTH Korean officials admitted responsibility and apologised on Tuesday for failures in preventing and responding to a Halloween crowd surge that killed more than 150 people and left citizens shocked and angry.

The government is facing growing public scrutiny over whether the crush on Saturday night, could have been prevented and who should take responsibility for the country's worst disaster in years.

National police chief Yoon Hye Keun said an initial investigation found there were many urgent calls from citizens notifying authorities about the potential danger of the crowd gathering in Itaewon. He said police officers who received the calls failed to handle them effectively.

"I feel a heavy responsibility (for the disaster) as the head of one of the related government offices," Yoon said in a televised news conference. "Police will do their best to prevent a tragedy like this from happening again." Yoon said police have

launched an intense internal probe into the officers' handling of the emergency calls and other issues, such as the on-the-spot response to the crowd surge in Itaewon that night. Separately, South Korea's interior minister, emergency office chief, Seoul mayor and the head of a ward office that includes the Itaewon neighbourhood all offered public apologies.

Brazil protests spiral for second day as Bolsonaro mum on poll loss

RIO DE JANEIRO

SUPPORTERS of Brazilian President Jair Bolsonaro blocked major highways for a second day as tensions mounted over his silence after losing re-election to bitter rival Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva.

36 hours after official results showed he had lost presidential run-off with only 1.8 percentage points, Bolsonaro has yet to concede defeat, fanning concerns he may try and challenge the result after months of attacking the electoral system as fraudulent. Federal Highway Police on Tuesday reported more than 250 total or partial road blockages in at least 23 states by Bolsonaro supporters, while local media said protests outside the country's main international airport in Sao Paulo delayed passengers and led to several flights being cancelled.

Protesters wearing the yellow and green of the Brazilian flag—which the outgoing president has adopted as his own—said they would not accept the outcome of the election. Antoni Almeida, 45, said at a protest in Barra Mansa, Rio de Janeiro. On Monday night, Judge Alexander de Moraes of the Supreme Court ordered police to disperse the blockades immediately. He was acting in response to a request by a transport federation that complained it was losing business.

With a massive to-do list, Lula leaped into action, meeting Argentine President Alberto Fernandez in Sao Paulo and holding a series of phone calls with US President Joe Biden, France's Emmanuel Macron, Germany's Olaf Scholz, UN Secretary-General Antonio Guterres and others.

However Bolsonaro's silence after months of alleging fraud in the electoral system and a conspiracy against him had the country on a knife-edge.

There are fears Bolsonaro, 67, could attempt a Brazilian version of the US Capitol riots which rocked that country after his political role model, former US president Donald Trump, refused to accept his election defeat in 2020.

Some key Bolsonaro allies have publicly recognised his loss, including the powerful speaker of the lower house of Congress, Arthur Lira. **AFP**

The certificates are not legally binding but allow same-sex partners to apply for public housing like married couples, give them access to medical data and allow them to be beneficiaries in life insurance.

The two sides will review the all-weather strategic cooperation partnership and exchange views on regional and global developments.
