

Class-10 Board exams begin with Hindi paper

In Bhopal, the Class 10 examinations of the Board of Secondary Education began on Wednesday morning with Hindi paper. Starting at 103 centres, Anita Ahirwar, a 28-year-old student of the city's Model School, appeared for her Class 10 exams. Anita told that in the year 2009, her studies were missed due to marriage. Then we had to teach children also, so there was no time for further studies. I have two children, my daughter is in seventh standard. Whereas, the son is in fifth. I study myself. I also teach children. There is no shame in this. I believe that there is no age to study.

Strictness was seen to stop copying

This time more strictness was also observed to prevent copying.



Mainly in order to bring transparency in the examination, this time the board also changed many

rules including answer book, paper set. For the first time, the seating arrangement of the students at the

centers was also changed. Under this, now the students of the same school could not sit in a row i.e. in front of each other in the examination hall. There was a difference of some students between them. Let us inform that 9 lakh 65 thousand students of class 10 appeared in 3852 examination centers across the state. Out of this, 3099 government and 753 private schools are included.

Many students who reached the spot were not aware about the supplementary copy, that they would not be given extra supplementary copy today. Most of the private students were involved in this. Sunita, a resident of the old city, said that she had no idea that she would not get the supplementary copy. Apart from this, many other children were also here who did not know about this.

Blue bull: 52 lakhs spent, problem remains same

Five years ago, 52 lakh rupees were spent under the Boma project to get rid of the menace of Nilgai (Blue bull). Even after this, the farmers could not get relief from Nilgai.

At that time only 27 Nilgai could be caught. Once again working on this project, a plan is being prepared to release Nilgai in Gandhi Sagar Sanctuary. In this matter, SDO Forest Department, Gandhi Sagar Wildlife Area says that once again the Nilgai of the district will be caught and conserved in the Gandhi Sagar Wildlife Sanctuary, this time by the Boma method. This time the support of team that came from South Africa to leave Cheetah will also be taken. During the Boma method adopted in the past, the work plan remained incomplete due to excess budget. The food chain there has also been affected by the loss of forests. Due to decrease in the number of carnivorous animals including tiger, leopard, hyena, the number of nilgai has increased. Due to the de-

crease in the forest area, blue bulls have turned towards the fields, which have become a headache for the farmers. Here the forest department also did not make any effort to get rid of the blue bulls. However, lakhs of rupees were spent on the Boma method in between. But got zero result. Here once again, using the Boma method, claims are being made to get rid of Nilgai.

Permission of hunting not given

According to the circular that came in the Forest Department in the year 2001, permission can be given to kill any wild animal under special circumstances. After this, the Forest Department had called for village panchayat wise proposals. In this, the problems caused to the crops by the wild boar along with the Nilgai were told more. The forest department sent a proposal to the government to give permission for killing of both the animals. But killing was not allowed.

IISER researchers use facet engineering

Produce high-efficiency lasers

Bhopal: Indian Institute of Science Education and Research Bhopal researchers have made a breakthrough in the field of low threshold gain lasers. They have developed a process by which tiny crystals of cesium lead bromide may be manipulated to produce high-intensity lasers with very low energy output.

This development has recently been published in the journal Nano Letters. The research has been led by Prof. K.V. Adarsh, Department of Physics, IISER Bhopal, and co-authored by his Ph.D. scholars Mr. Santu K. Bera and Dr. Megha Shrivastava from IISER Bhopal and Prof. Narayan Pradhan and his student Dr. Suman Bera from Indian Association for the Cultivation of Science, Kolkata.

Lasers are extensively used in many applications today, including telecommunications, lighting,

displays, medical diagnostics and therapeutics, biosensing, and neuroscience.

IISER Bhopal team has been working with nanocrystals of a material called cesium lead bromide. Although this material has a high photoluminescence quantum yield, meaning it emits a lot of light for the energy put in, it suffers from a problem called Auger recombination. This is a phenomenon in which, part of the energy is released as heat instead of converting into light.

Explaining the work, Prof. K.V. Adarsh, IISER Bhopal, said, "By changing the shape of the nanocrystals from a cube (6 faces) to a rhombicuboctahedron (26 faces), we were able to achieve a five-fold reduction in the gain threshold, which could make these nanocrystals much more useful in practical applications."

In today's workshop, the issues of children's education, child labor and identifying children begging and motivating them to study, giving advice to the parents of such children, etc. were discussed. Apart from this, providing all possible help to the children who do not have parents should be the main topic of discussion.
