‘CMs of other states keen on implementing TN schemes’

“WHEN I visit other states for INDIA alliance meetings, the CMs of other states inquire about TN schemes as they intend to implement them in their states. When I took part in the G20 summit, even some union ministers enquired about our schemes,” he said. Stalin said the DMK government was not able to implement the scheme after coming to power due to poor financial condition of the state. “Now, we are rolling out the scheme after setting right the economy to a certain extent,” he added. Stalin recalled that after renaming the state as Tamil Nadu, former CM Anna had said that as long as the name of the state remains Tamil Nadu it would mean that Annadurai was ruling the state. “Similarly, launching this women’s honorarium scheme, I say that until women continue to receive this honorarium, it would mean that Stalin is ruling the state,” the CM said. The CM also referred to a host of schemes for girl children and youth, including free bus ride for women, Pudhumai Penn scheme for girls to pursue higher studies, and Naan Mudhalvan scheme for providing employment opportunities for youth. Stalin garlanded the statue of Annadurai on his 115th birth anniversary before launching the scheme on Friday.

SC’s no to list plea for action against Udhaya

THE Supreme Court on Friday refused to urgently list a plea seeking to register an FIR against DMK leader Udhayanidhi Stalin for his Sanatana Dharma remark. While equating Sanatana Dharma to “dengue and malaria”, Stalin had called for its eradication during a conference in Chennai. Remark that Sanatana Dharma enslaved women and did not allow them to step out of their homes, Stalin had said, “We can’t oppose dengue, mosquitoes, malaria, or corona, we have to eradicate them. In the same way, we have to eradicate the Sanatana Dharma.” The plea was filed through Advocate G Balaji and sought for registration of FIRs against the organisers of the September 2 meeting titled ‘Sanatana Dharma Eradication conference’ and Hindu Religious Charitable Endowment Minister PK Sekar Babu and Chairman of State Minorities Commission, Peter Alphonse. The plea was mentioned before a bench of CJI DY Chandrachud, Justices PS Narasimha and Manoj Mishra, by Senior Advocate Dama Sheshadhari Naidu. The CJI said, “There is a procedure that everyone has to follow.” The petition was filed by Madras High Court lawyer B Jagannath, who sought for a CBI probe and declared the meeting unconstitutional. “One can understand if the conference was to eradicate casteism, but the manner in which the same was conducted was to spread hatred and make derogatory statements against Hindus, since they practice Sanatana Dharma,” the plea read.



Two Lankan fishermen arrested for crossing IMBL

TWO Sri Lankan nationals were arrested on Friday near Point Calimere for allegedly crossing the IMBL and trespassing into Indian territory. The duo alleged that they landed due to a boat snag.

The Coastal Security Group (CSG) on Friday morning received information from locals about two persons roaming suspiciously near the pump house of a private salt manufacturer near the Kodiyaikarai fish landing centre. The CSG personnel visited the area, found the suspects and interrogated them. The two identified themselves as D Kayuz Subathran (36) and J Nixon Telex (37) from Talaimannar in Mannar district in Sri Lanka. Inspector K Jothimuthuramalingam led the investigation. The fishers alleged that they left Talaimannar on September 12, and that their boat developed a snag while fishing near Katchatheevu, as a result of which they landed near Kodiyaikarai. The CSG personnel went to an area named Chellakanni Channel and found a motorised FRP boat belonging to the fishers’ alleged employer, Anthony Ammal. They found equipment in the boat. A case was registered.

Drought-hit K’taka to cut costs for Dasara

Bengaluru: With Karnataka reeling under severe drought in most taluks, the government has cut down unnecessary expenditure for Mysuru Dasara. As per a release, 195 of 237 taluks are drought-hit, which include 161 severely drought-hit taluks. In 2022, the government had spent over ₹26 crore on the celebrations, events, lighting and other expenditure, since it was the first celebration after the pandemic. “We will cut down expenses wherever we can. I will discuss it with the CM,” said Social Welfare Minister HC Mahadevappa. ENS

Jr NTR silent on arrest of Chandrababu Naidu

Vijayawada: Amid the lack of reaction by actor and Nandamuri family member Jr NTR over the arrest of former Chief Minister and TDP chief N Chandrababu Naidu, the TDP on Friday said it is not requesting anyone to react. When asked about the same, TDP State unit president K Atchannaidu said, “We are not requesting people to respond and people are voluntarily coming forward condemning the arrest.” Meanwhile, the ACB Special Court adjourned the hearing on the bail petitions Naidu to September 19. ENS

T’gana CM announces breakfast scheme

Hyderabad: Taking a leaf out of the breakfast scheme launched in Tamil Nadu, the State government on Friday decided to launch the ‘Chief Minister’s Breakfast Scheme’ for students from Class I to Class X from October 24, Dasara day. The annual additional burden on the exchequer will be around ₹400 crore for implementing the scheme. Chief Minister K Chandrasekhar Rao announced the new scheme just before the coming Assembly elections and at a time the Congress is poised to announce its six guarantees for Telangana on Sunday. ENS

Medicos returned from Ukraine duped of ₹43L

Bhubaneswar: Swadhin Mohapatra, an ex-director of an education consultancy firm in Bhubaneswar, has been arrested for duping around 65 medicos, who had returned from war-torn Ukraine, of ₹43 lakh on the pretext of helping them obtain transcript certificates (TCs) from Ukrainian universities to continue their studies in India. He had allegedly collected the money from the students between November and December last year with promise to obtain the TCs from Ukrainian universities. ENS

‘Zero-balance accounts only suitable for elderly’

BANK officials told TNIE that due to the transaction restrictions in Jan Dhan accounts that offer zero-balance facility, most of the applicants have opted for regular accounts. A branch manager said, zero-balance accounts have a monthly transaction cap of ₹10,000 and annual transaction limit of ₹1 lakh. “Also, balance cannot exceed ₹49,000, and account holders will not be eligible for jewel loans or other loans.” Jan Dhan accounts can only be used for 24 months after which they must be upgraded into regular accounts.

Such zero-balance accounts are suitable only for elderly who solely receive credit through pensions, the bank manger said. “Since the minimum age of beneficiaries under the ‘Umi-mai thogai’ scheme is 21, several young women with potential to carry out larger monetary transactions have opted for regular bank accounts. Those who have deposited the minimum balance at the time of opening the account can withdraw the ₹1,000 immediately.” The minimum balance for the savings account in central cooperative bank is ₹500 without cheque book facility.

NIPAH IN KL: MAN TESTS +VE, TOLL RISES TO 4

KOZHIKODE: A 39-year-old man tested positive for Nipah virus, which was transmitted to him through direct contact with an infected person who died on August 30, State Health Minister Veena George said on Friday. With the number of active cases rising to four, the state government has decided to test everyone who is on the high-risk contact list of the infected persons. George said the man tested positive, taking the total of infected in the state to six, of which two had died earlier. The infected person had sought treatment at a private hospital where Nipah-infected persons were treated for other ailments earlier. PTI



We aren’t begging, Cauvery water is our right: Duraimurugan

WHEN Tamil Nadu asks Karnataka to release Cauvery water, it is not begging, it’s the state’s right granted by the Supreme Court, Water Resources Minister Duraimurugan said on Friday. He was talking to reporters after inaugurating the ₹1,000 honorarium scheme for women and distributing ATM cards to around 2,000 beneficiaries. Duraimurugan said, “Tamil Nadu is only seeking its rights. The Supreme Court has said that if there is enough water in the Cauvery, it must be shared with Tamil Nadu. We are waiting for Karnataka to honour the Supreme Court’s decision in this regard.” Duraimurugan acknowledged that people are very firm about this issue and also respect Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah for his political experience. “However, I am disappointed that Siddaramaiah said he could not release water to Tamil Nadu without fully understanding the current situation. Karnataka’s refusal goes against the Supreme Court’s ruling and the Cauvery River Water Regulatory Commission, which is not acceptable,” he said.

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Sathankulam case: Cop’s bail plea rejected

MADURAI: The Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court on Friday dismissed the bail petition filed by suspended police inspector S Sridhar, who was arrested in the Sathankulam custodial death case in 2020. Sridhar, who was working as the station house officer of Sathankulam police station in Thoothukudi, was arrested in July 2020 for the brutal assault of two traders- P Jeyaraj and his son Beniks in police custody. Nine other policemen from the station were also arrested in the case but one of them died due to Covid-19, a month later. The trial is underway in Additional District and Sessions Court-I, Madurai. However, Sridhar denied the allegations and claimed he was not even present at the spot.
