Police swing into action; illegal loan apps, websites taken down

Serve notice to Google, domain name registrars seeking to remove 72 websites & loan apps

IN the wake of a rise in suicides following threats from unauthorised loan app operators, the state police have launched a major counter operation, taking down 72 websites and removing several apps from Google Play Store.

On Friday, state police Cyber Operations SP Harisankar served notice to Google and domain name registrars seeking to remove 72 websites and apps that endorse or provide online loans, in addition to some trading apps. Sources confirmed that these websites and apps were removed by Saturday. Further, 24 more apps are under the radar of police.

Recently, police launched a WhatsApp number (9497980900) for those who face threats and blackmail from loan app operators. Victims can file complaints in the form of texts, photos, videos, or voice files to this number. The police will contact the affected people and collect details for further action.

"People get loans through these apps without any collateral. So many people fall into these traps and later become victims of online blackmail and threats. People willingly upload their photographs and IDs on these apps. Most of these loan apps are based in Telangana and in north Indian states. Respective

local police are taking action based on complaints. A strong awareness campaign is the need of the hour, and the state police are making efforts in this regard," Manoj Abraham, ADGP (Intelligence) told *TNIE*.

Meanwhile, there are apprehensions that the apps removed would reappear on Play Store and App Store. "Earlier, the Union government removed many such apps. But they keep on re-appearing on Play Store in different identities. So, it is impractical to wipe them out by removing the apps from Google. In fact, a coordinated effort is needed from all the states to curb this menace," said a senior police official on condition of anonymity.

According to the police, steps have been taken to freeze the bank accounts of illegal apps that have transferred money. Complaints received at the state level will be verified and forwarded to the cyber wing's portal for action. In the wake of

reports of suicides following threats from loan app operators, the number of people coming forward to file complaints has increased. According to Cyber police, only two FIRs -- in Ernakulam and Wayanad -- have been registered in loan app cases so far. A total of 300 complaints were received on the WhatsApp number in a single day. Of these, five complaints have been forwarded for further action, the cyber police said in a statement.

As many as 1,427 people filed complaints against fraud loan apps this year. While the police received 1,340 such complaints in 2022, and there were 1,400 complaints in 2021. The police said the apps, bank accounts, and phone numbers mentioned in the complaints have been checked, and further action has been taken.

The Centre also plans to crack down on illegal loan apps on the Google Play Store and Apple App Store. Six months ago, the government took down and blocked around 120 illegal loan apps.

Women's panel files case against Shaji

THE State Women's Commission has filed a case against Muslim League leader K M Shaji for allegedly making derogatory remarks against Health Minister Veena George. Commission chairperson P Sathidevi has requested a report on the speech from the Malappuram district police chief.

"The remarks made against Veena George are anti-women and highly condemnable. K M Shaji has insulted a woman by using highly derogatory words. There should be strong protests against such people who indulge in political obscenity," said Sathidevi.

Drawing a parallel between the derogatory remarks and the once-prevalent practice of 'Smarthavicharam' among the Namboodiri community, Sathidevi suggested that the words used by Shaji to refer to the minister also reflect a feudal mentality.

In response to the remarks, Veena chose not to engage, stating, "I'm not inclined to respond to such matters. I'm too busy

with my work and have a lot to do."

General Education Minister V Sivankutty strongly criticised Shaji, describing his remarks as reflective of his cultural background. "The remarks cannot be termed as a mere slip of tongue or statements made in the heat of a moment. It shows his attitude towards women in general," said Sivankutty.

"His intolerance towards the concept of gender equality is evident through the remarks," said the senior CPM leader adding that the silence of senior Congress and UDF leaders in the matter is surprising.

IUML state general secretary P M A Salam said that what Shaji said at a public meeting cannot be considered as the official stand of the party. It was a public meeting and not a press conference to explain party decisions.

"If there is anything happened in the language during the course of the meeting, that cannot be construed as party stand. Anyway, the party will examine in which situation the language was used," he said



Nipah: Edu institutions to reopen tomorrow

ALL educational institutions in the district that were closed following the Nipah outbreak will be reopened on Monday. However, educational institutions in the containment zones will continue with online classes until further notice. District Collector A Geetha issued an order in this regard on Saturday in the wake of diminishing concerns over the spread of Nipah virus in the district.

Students, teachers, and non-teaching staff at the educational institutions are required to wear masks and use hand sanitisers within the school premises. The institutions have also been directed to keep sanitisers at their entrances. Educational institutions in the district were shifted to online learning mode following an order issued on September 16 by the district

authority. Minister Veena George told reporters that community surveillance will continue in the district. A committee with district collector as chairperson will be formed in Kozhikode for the implementation of the One Health programme. Officials from the animal husbandry, fisheries and other departments will be members of the committee, said Veena. One Health is a programme that takes into consideration the welfare of not just human beings, but other creatures in the nature, including animals.

The minister added that it is a positive sign that there are no positive Nipah results in the last eight consecutive days. All the virus-infected persons are fast recovering. The results of seven samples received on Saturday are negative. There are a total of 915 persons in the contact list, said the minister.

Amid her travails, Antony's wife turns to god, wishes best for Anil

IN HER first public remarks on Anil Antony shifting his allegiance from the Congress to the BJP, Elizabeth Antony has defended her son's move. Speaking before members of a private prayer group, Congress leader A K Antony's wife stressed that it was a resolution passed by the AICC at its Raipur 'chintan shivir' against dynasty politics that sealed the political future of her two sons. "This forced Anil to cosy up to the BJP," she adds.

Elizabeth said that Anil is happy and content since joining the BJP and exuded confidence that he will scale greater heights. Elizabeth, who runs the NGO Navoothan Charitable Foundation, was supposedly speaking at the Kreupasanam religio-socio cultural centre,



run by Fr V P Joseph Valiyaveetil under the Alleppey diocese. The 18-minute-44-second video uploaded on YouTube on Friday shows her speaking in detail about how the couple had overcome the side effects of Covid.

In the video, Elizabeth notes that her husband lost confidence as his feet give away and he was losing strength. This forced him to seek retirement from active politics and relocate to Thiruvananthapuram, she adds.

"I couldn't see my husband sitting idle. When nothing happened for eight months, I renewed my agreement with god in February. Much to my relief, my husband was again chosen to the Congress Working Committee in August. He regained his self-confidence, which saw him travel to Hyderabad alone," she says, sobbing.

Elizabeth, who is also a lawyer, recounts how 39-year-old Anil returned to India hoping to enter active politics after his higher studies at Stanford University. "His hopes were dashed when the Raipur party meet passed a resolution against dynasty politics," she says.

"My husband never helped them [our sons] get a foothold in politics. Then I put a prayer request before god. To my utter dismay, the row over the BBC documentary cropped up. I pleaded before god, as I was helpless. I was keen to see my son making strides in politics. One day he called me to say that he had got a call from the PMO. After four days, TV channel headlines screamed that he had joined the BJP. I again pleaded with god to ensure peace and harmony at home," says Elizabeth.

She adds her husband suggested against talking politics at home.

Anchor-berating video goes viral, CM cries foul

PINARAYI Vijayan was at it again, this time berating a master of ceremonies who failed to wait for the chief minister to conclude his speech before making an announcement.

The incident took place on Saturday in Bedadka, in Kasaragod, during the inauguration of the new building of the local farmers' service cooperative bank head office. Irked by what he deemed an intrusion, Pinarayi left the venue in a huff.

"This is not right. I have not concluded my speech," Vijayan cut in, as the anchor started announcing the next event on the schedule. Even after the CM made clear his displeasure, the announcement continued. "It



seems he is deaf," CM is heard saying in a video that went viral immediately after the episode. "He should have announced the next programme only after I conclude my speech," Pinarayi said, before walking off the stage.

The CM tried to clear the air at his next programme, in Periyattadukkam, stressing that he did not leave the venue in annoyance. He said the TV news channels made it appear so. "I was not angry with anyone. I felt that what had happened was not right. It is my responsibility to point out when someone does something wrong," he added. "What do TV channels gain from spreading false news? They are trying to create a bad impression through such depiction of the incident," he said.
