Trial run of Pillur 3 project postponed

TRIAL run of the Pillur Scheme 3 project has been postponed by the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) and the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage (TWAD) Board to November as few works, including the pipeline installations are not yet completed. According to sources, the areas in Kurichi, Kuniyamuthur and Kavunadampalayam municipalities, seven town panchayats and one village panchayat were added to the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) area about a decade ago. In order to cater to the water needs of the added areas of the CCMC and by analysing the city's population in 2040, the project was kick-started by the state government at a cost of ₹779.86 crore in 2018.

The project, with the Bhavani River water as its source, will be able to supply 178.30 MLD of water to the added areas of the CCMC once completed. The project is being carried out in three stages, which include the

construction treatment plant, pumping station, tunnel, storage tanks, and installation of water pipelines.

Sources said that the construction of the treatment plant with a capacity of treating 178.30 MLD of water was completed at ₹104.90 crore. Of this, ₹77 crore is spent on the construction and the remaining amount is used for Operation and Maintenance (O&M). Similarly, the construction of the water pumping station has been finished at a cost of ₹134 crore. Out of the 84.44 km of pipelines, including 30 km of the main lines of raw water and clear water, officials have finished the majority of the installation works and have been currently indulged in the finishing stage of works.

In this situation, CCMC's new Commissioner M Sivaguru Prabhakaran along with the CCMC and TWAD Board officials inspected the ongoing Pillur Scheme 3 project works in Mettupalayam on Saturday. The commissioner has ordered the officials to complete the works on a war foot basis.

Assn tells state govt to revoke power tariff hike and build MSME clusters

SEVERAL important resolutions, including four charter of demands were passed in the executive committee meeting of the Tamil Nadu Association of Cottage and Micro/Tiny Entrepreneurs (TACT) held in Coimbatore on Saturday.

The industries across the state, especially the MSMEs, have been at loggerheads with the state government since the electricity tariff was hiked last year and they have been demanding the government to revoke the revised tariff.

TACT Coimbatore district president J James presided over the meeting along with General Secretary G Prathap Sekar and Treasurer M Leelakrishnan. According to sources, despite the government providing a nominal electricity tariff under the 12 kW electricity connection for micro industries under the LT-3A1 type, the electricity department officials in the district refuse to accept the applications from the industries that apply for a change in the electricity connection from LT-3B tariff type to LT-3A1 tariff type. So, TACT has urged the EB of

officials to make the necessary change. Similarly, the industry association also passed a resolution demanding the government to revoke the hike in the fixed demand charges and newly introduced peak hour charges for the industries.

Apart from the electricity tariff, TACT has reiterated its demand towards the government to create MSME clusters and a multi-storey industrial centre in Coimbatore. Also, a resolution was passed demanding the government to solve the issues which are delaying investment subsidies to industrialists and hand over the benefits soon.

'Allocate more funds for Kalai Thiruvizha'

THE Tamil Nadu Art Teachers Association on Thursday submitted a petition to the school education department (SED) urging it to allocate more funds for 'Kalai Thiruvizha' events for its efficient conduct at the block level. Association president SA Rajkumar told *TNIE* that currently, the SED allocates only ₹30,000 to each block for the talent shows. "Recently, competitions were held at 15 blocks in Coimbatore, with 700 to 800 students participating across 64 categories. Except for a few blocks, the school education department did not serve lunch. Instead, tea and snacks (biscuits) were given to students. As a result, some students, especially girls, could not perform well," he said.

"Headmasters and teachers, who also serve as competition

coordinators, are forced to depend on sponsorships from private educational institutions. Some even have had to spend from their pockets to arrange for students' transport to reach the venue. As a result, competitions are not held efficiently," he said. Rajkumar added that the SED should consider allocating at least ₹1 lakh to each block.

When contacted, one of the coordinators of Kalai Thiruvizha events under the Samagra Shiksha programme told *TNIE* that the funds allocated are not enough and are mostly used up as honorarium for judges, and to pay for tea and snacks. "It was difficult for us to conduct the competitions solely from the sponsorships we got from private institutions," the coordinator said. She added that the SED did not allocate funds for prize money for winners of the block-level competitions, which will encourage students.

2.5 kg gold seized from two passengers at Kovai airport

COIMBATORE: OFFICIALS attached to the Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) arrested two passengers from Coimbatore International Airport on Friday for allegedly smuggling 2.5 kg of gold worth ₹1.57 crore from Sharjah. Based on intelligence that two passengers had allegedly bought gold from Sharjah to Coimbatore by Air Arabia flight, which was concealed in their dress, the officials intercepted them.

The gold, brought by the passengers, was in the form of crude bars. It was recovered during the frisking at the airport premises. The passengers, S Deepa (28) from Thiruvur district and A Manikandan (28) from Cuddalore district, were remanded to prison.
