India climate action fourth strongest

Top two emitters, US and China, were rated poor

Dubai, December 8

INDIA'S CLIMATE ACTIONS were rated the fourth strongest in an annual performance index released by Germanwatch, a non-government organisation based in Bonn, Friday, marking an improvement of one place from the previous year.

The Climate Change Performance Index ranks 59 countries and the European Union every year on their performance on climate actions. None of these countries have been able to achieve a "very high" rating over the last few years, because of which the first three ranks are left vacant.

Like last year, Denmark's performance was rated the best and was ranked fourth. India was the country in the top five to have moved up this year. The two other countries with better performance than India this year are Estonia and the Philippines.

The index assesses performance on four indicators — country's total emissions, renewable energy deployment, energy use and climate policy.

India received a high ranking on the greenhouse gas emissions and energy use indicators, and a medium rating on climate policy and renewable energy deployment. "While India is the

world's most populous country, it has relatively low per capita emissions. Our data shows that in the per capita GHG category, the country is on track to meet a benchmark of well below 2 degrees Celsius. While it shows a slightly positive trend in the share of renewable energy, this trend is advancing too slowly," the Germanwatch report said.

Interestingly, host UAE is among the bottom three with Iran and Saudi Arabia. The

report said UAE's per capita emissions were among the highest in the world, and its national climate targets were inadequate. Besides, UAE continued to develop and finance new oil and gas projects domestically as well as abroad.

Climate actions of China and the United States, the top two emitters of the world, were also rated poor. China was ranked 51 and the US 57.

The Germanwatch report noted that India needed to agree to a faster phase-out of coal, reduce reliance on gas, and further expand its renewable energy capacity. Also, it needed to advance its 2070 net-zero target.

UN Security Council of yesterday is 'always late today': India

IN A SCATHING criticism, India's Permanent Representative to the UN Ambassador Ruchira Kamboj has said the UN Security Council of yesterday is "always late today" and questioned whether 1945's "security plumbing" will work in the year 2023.

"If the trillion dollar question is to ensure peace, do we have a peace infrastructure representative of the current times and contemporary realities?" Kamboj asked.

Speaking at the Security Council open debate on

"Threats to International Peace and Security: Transnational Organised Crime, Growing Challenges, and New Threats" on Thursday, Kamboj questioned whether 2023 is the new 1945, referring to the year when the powerful UN body came into existence.

"Will 1945's security

plumbing work today? The UNSC of yesterday is always late today!" she said.

India, the world's most populous country, has been at the forefront of the years-long efforts to reform the Security Council, saying it rightly deserves a place as a permanent member at the UN high table, which in its current form does not represent the geo-political realities of the 21st Century.

Back to the drawing board

Mumbai Indians, Delhi Capitals retain core; Gujarat Giants, UP Warriorz, RCB face crucial decisions at the auctions today

New Delhi, December 8

THE THREE TEAMS that featured in the play-offs of the inaugural edition Women's Premier League — champions Mumbai Indians, finalists Delhi Capitals, and third-placed UP Warriorz — have all opted to trust the core group of players that delivered for them. A measure of that lies in the fact that MI and DC's playing XIs in the final have been fully retained, while UPW have released just one player from their starting group. These three teams can walk into the auction in Mumbai on Saturday safe in the knowledge that they need just minor reinforcements for the next season.

And so the attention will be on Gujarat Giants and Royal Challengers Bangalore as the franchises go to the auction tables to get their teams in shape for the second edition. RCB struggled for most of the season but eventually finished above the Giants on the points table on net run rate. Both teams just managed two wins out of the eight matches they played.

A total of 165 cricketers — 104 Indians and 61 overseas — are in contention to be picked up for the 30 slots available (9 overseas) across the board. The teams have an additional Rs 1.50 crore added to their purse for this auction from the Rs 12 crore that was available last time.

The Giants had an interesting strategy in the 2023 auction as they went heavy on overseas players at the start and trusted their knowledge of domestic talent (with Mithali Raj and Nooshin Al Khadeer in their decision-making group). While the logic made sense, they were eventually left short on Indian firepower, which ended up costing them. With very few high-end capped Indian players in the auction mix this time, that will be an area they wouldn't be able to fix immediately. But with Mooney, Wolvaardt, Gardner, Deol, Hemalatha and Rana, the Giants have a good batting core and will be focussed on building their bowling options. With three overseas slots available, it wouldn't be a surprise to see the Giants go big for a pacer like Shabnim Ismail and one among the Aussie wrist-spinners in King and Jade-Wellington. They

are also likely to get their pick in the India A or U19 talent that is available.

On more than one occasion during the season, Healy said that while winning matches was important, her team was keen to give a platform to young Indian talent. In Parshavi, Shweta and Yashasri, three U19 World Cup winners got their chances. Expect them to look for a few more such Indian talents as they have just one overseas slot left and a good purse to work with. One of the concern areas for UPW was the options with Indian batting talent as they were inconsistent. They could look at bringing in S Meghana to complement Healy. They have released Ismail who they had to bench because of their overseas combinations, so could look for a cheaper foreign backup.
