## Cauvery water to irrigate 4.5k ha of crop in Karaikal

Cauvery water reached region through Noolar at Nallambal regulator on Tuesday

THE River Cauvery water released from the Mettur dam that reached Karaikal on Tuesday evening was opened for irrigation on Wednesday. Paddy cultivation on about 4,500 hectares in the region is expected to benefit from the water release.

Cauvery water, which flows through Karaikal as seven distributaries, arrived through River Noolar at the Nallambal regulator near Thirunallar on Tuesday evening. On Wednesday, the water was released for irrigation. Collector D Manikandan, Thirunallar MLA PR Siva, PWD superintendent engineer K Chandrasekaran and executive engineer J Mahesh were present alongside farmer representatives.

Mahesh said, "Noolar is being discharged at 300 cusecs. Water through rivers Nattar, Vanjiyar and Arasalar will arrive in a day, while the release is expected to flow through Thirumalairajan by this week-

end. Water arrival through Nandalur and Piravidayan will follow. They would be distributed for irrigation."

The Tamil Nadu government is directed to release 7 tmcft of Cauvery water to the Puducherry government annually. According to the Puducherry agriculture department, around 4,500 hectares of paddy cultivation would benefit from the release. R Ganesan, the additional director of agriculture, said, "We have according to geography and water availability in Karaikal advised farmers to use medium duration crop variety for cultivation."

As on Wednesday, Cauvery water was being released at a rate of 9,506 cusecs from Grand Anicut.

Meanwhile, P Rajendiran, the president of Karaikal district delta farmers' welfare association, said, "We demand the PWD to start storing Noolar waters at Nallambal lake reservoir so that they can be conserved and utilised during cultivation."

## Abandoned corpn greenhouse to turn shelter for housing seized cattle

THE old greenhouse near Gandhi Market, which not long ago was ridden with weeds and had only a framed piped structure for remnants, will be soon be converted into a shelter for seized stray cattle, announced corporation Commissioner V Saravanan.

Acting on a report headlined, 'Once a corpn greenhouse, now a spot for Tiruchites to dry clothes' which appeared in these columns in the edition dated June 22, 2024, the corporation commissioner along with other officials visited the spot to inspect the sorry state of affairs of the erstwhile greenhouse and directed his team to clear the debris and weeds from the premises.

On Wednesday, corporation workers unloaded the roofing sheets required for setting up a cattle shelter at the spot. "We will soon start work for fixing

the roofing sheets on the pipe frames. After that, we will begin making concrete boxes for storing feed and water for seized cattle," a corporation engineer said. Senior officials said that the corporation is

planning to use the shelter for housing cattle seized from Zones I, II and III.

"As the pipe frames are in good condition, we expect to complete works this week," an official added.

## 2k-litre tanker to combat fires in Tiruchy forest range

THE Tiruchy forest range has procured a 2,000-litre tanker to combat forest fires during summer months and provide water for animals to quench thirst. "The tanker will deliver substantial quantity of water to control and extinguish forest fires, and reduce extensive damage," a senior official said.

Additionally, the tanker will serve as a vital resource for wildlife. During periods of drought or extreme heat, it will supply much-needed water to animals in the forest, thus ensuring their well-being.

"We have identified some fire-prone areas within the forest range in the district. The tanker, a mini truck, can navigate various terrains, allowing it to reach these locations

quickly and extinguish fires at their initial stage. During summer, the tanker will patrol vulnerable areas, ensuring prompt access to high-risk spots," an official said.

The acquisition of the tanker marks a significant step in managing environmental challenges and ensuring the safety and sustainability of the forest ecosystem. Plans are in place to acquire similar tankers for other forest ranges, he added.

## Hero stones dating to 14CE identified at two temples

A group of historians undertaking an explorative study at Thiruvanaikoil in the district recently identified a few sculptures at two temples in the locality as hero stones believed to be at least a few centuries old.

According to the group from the Dr M Rajamanikannan Centre for Historical Research, two of the sculptures were found on either side of the entrance in the outer wall of Ananda Ganapathi temple situated in East Inner Street of Thiruvanaikoil. The sculptures represent two robust male individuals in short attire carrying a curved knife with sheath on the right side of their hip. The feet of the two are turned sideways, with the left hand of the individuals clutching their tuft of hair and their right hand cutting their own head with a sword.

Such sculptures representing individuals who had sacrificed their life by cutting off their heads for a genuine cause are revered as hero stones and worshipped by the locals, they said.

The group led by R Akila, associate professor, Arignar Anna Government Arts College, Musiri, also during the study on Tuesday found another partial-

ly buried hero stone in the wall of Esanya Vinayagar temple on the other end of the same road. The sculpture, however, lacked the curved knife which found on the other two, the group pointed out.

R Kalakkovan, director of the research centre, said the pair of sculptures date to the 14CE or 15 CE and the other one to the Nayak period.
