Not joining politics, no idea about July 18 event: Jr NTR

Actor's office denies links with organisation operating under his name

SPECULATION regarding Jr NTR's entry into active politics intensified across the Telugu States ahead of a proposed event in Tirupati, prompting a swift and categorical denial from the actor's office on Tuesday.

The rumours erupted on social media following the announcement of the 'RAW NTR Ooru Vaada' programme scheduled for July 18. The campaign fuelled discussions that the social service platform was being used to mobilise the actor's fan base as a foundation for a future political launch, drawing comparisons to recent film-to-politics transitions in South Indian cinema. Distancing the actor entirely from the controversy, Jr NTR's office issued an official statement clarifying that he has no association, affiliation, or involvement with the "RAW NTR" organisation or its upcoming programme.

"It has come to our attention that an organisation operating under the name RAW NTR has been carrying out activities that may create an impression of be-

ing associated with NTR. The organisation is neither authorised to represent NTR nor to communicate on his behalf in any capacity," the statement said. It emphasised that any legitimate public welfare activities, charitable initiatives, or official communications involving Jr NTR would only be routed through his office or verified channels.

Describing the press note as their "final communication" on the matter, the office urged the media, digital platforms, and fans to ignore unverified social media reports.

Concurrently, the organisers of the Tirupati event also released a clarification, stating that the July 18 meeting has no political agenda, and is strictly intended to unveil the vision and objectives of their social initiative.

Reinforcing the denial, Krishna Yadav, State convenor of the officially recognised Jr NTR Fans Association, dismissed the political rumours as a false campaign aimed at damaging the actor's image. He clarified that the group operating under the banner of 'RAW NTR' is entirely unauthorised.

Yadav further stated that the official association plans to lodge a formal complaint with the Tirupati police seeking legal action against individuals spreading unauthorised campaign using the actor's name.

Despite periodic speculation stemming from his lineage as the grandson of legendary actor and TDP founder NT Rama Rao, Jr NTR has stayed away from active politics since campaigning for the TDP in the 2009 Assembly elections, remaining focused entirely on his film career.

EC to examine poll campaigns targeting kids

THE Election Commission of India has told the Madras High Court that it would examine permitting campaigns addressed to children who are not voters but may persuade their parents and elders at home. The submission was made in a counter-affidavit filed through the standing counsel for ECI Niranjan Rajagopalan on a petition seeking a probe into Chief Minister C Joseph Vijay calling for the children to influence their parents to vote for TVK.

"In so far as the desirability of permitting campaigns which are addressed towards children, who are not voters, so that they may persuade their parents and elders at home, in the age of social media access, will be examined," ECI stated in the counter-affidavit.

It said if required, suitable guidelines will be put in place.

HC asks TN govt to clarify its stand on bike taxi operations

THE Madurai Bench of the Madras High Court on Tuesday sought a specific response from the state government on whether it is going to permit the operation of two-wheeler aggregators in Tamil Nadu.

A bench of justices CV Karthikeyan and R Sakthivel raised the question while hearing a PIL filed by R Naveen Kumar of Madurai, seeking enactment of a comprehensive regulatory framework governing two-wheeler aggregators to enable lawful operation of bike taxi services in the state.

During the hearing on Tuesday, the additional advocate general informed that a committee has been formed to frame rules for aggregators in the state. The said committee consisted of the joint and deputy transport commissioners, representatives of Chennai Unified Metropolitan Transport Authority (CUMTA), representatives of the finance department,

among others. The committee would need six months to frame the rules, namely the Tamil Nadu Motor Vehicle Aggregator Rules, he added. However, the petitioner's counsel claimed that the two-wheelers operating as bike taxis are being unreasonably fined a sum of ₹10,000 by the government, while the aggregators do not face any action. Following this, the bench posed the above question and adjourned the case to August 3.

Kumar stated that app-based bike taxi services have become an integral part of the transport ecosystem and serve as a primary source of livelihood for students and unemployed youth from economically weaker sections of the community. However, the state government's failure to notify a specific scheme for such use of motorcycles for hire has created a critical regulatory vacuum, affecting the life and safety of passengers as well as the rights and livelihood of bike taxi drivers, Kumar claimed.

SC stays HC's order scrapping appointment of 17 PAs to judges

THE Supreme Court on Monday stayed the Madras High Court's July 1 judgment setting aside the appointment of 17 Personal Assistants to judges, after deeming the entire selection process arbitrary.

A bench of Justices Vikram Nath and Sandeep Mehta passed the interim order while hearing a special leave petition (SLP) filed by 9 affected candidates challenging the High Court's decision.

"Issue notice, returnable within four weeks. In the meantime, the effect and operation of the impugned order passed by the High Court shall remain stayed," the bench said, tagging the matter with connected petitions and posting it for hearing after four weeks.

The Madras HC, in a suo motu writ petition, had quashed the appointments.

It held that the authorities had relaxed the Madras High Court Service Rules to accommodate in-service candidates who did not possess the prescribed qualifications, instead of resorting to direct recruitment.

The HC had found that the selection was made without due consideration of merit and violated the principles of transparency and equality.

History-sheeter wanted in over 30 cases arrested

Chennai: A 37-year-old history-sheeter who had been booked in multiple criminal cases and had absconded was arrested at gunpoint during a pre-dawn operation at Parivakkam near Poonaallee on Tuesday. The accused, Sudhakar alias Thikkuvai Sudhakar of Arumbakkam, has three murder cases and over 30 other criminal cases pending against him. He was out on bail but repeatedly failed to appear in the court in several cases, leading to the issuance of a non-bailable warrant for his arrest. Acting on a tip-off that Sudhakar was hiding in a house at Parivakkam, a police team secured the area, arrested him at gunpoint and handed him over to Arumbakkam police for further legal action.

TVK secretary held for sexually harassing woman

POLICE arrested a Tamilaga Vettiri Kazhagam union secretary from Krishnarayapuram in Karur district on Tuesday for allegedly sexually harassing a 24-year-old married woman. Based on a counter petition, police also registered a case against over 10 unidentified people for allegedly assaulting the accused in support of the woman.

According to police, S Ramesh (30) of Varagur was booked under Sections 296(b) (uttering obscene words in a public place causing annoyance to others) and 74 (assault or use of criminal force against a woman with intent to outrage her modesty) of the BNS. The woman, a native of Kulithalai, works as a salesgirl at a medical shop. In a police complaint, she alleged that she was on her way home from work on a two-wheeler with a minor relative on July 13. Riding a motorcycle, Ramesh quickly intercepted them, leading to a fall. When the minor girl picked up an argument with Ramesh for pushing them down, he allegedly abused them.

Noticing the commotion, passersby roughed up Ramesh and handed him over to the police. He was later admitted to the government hospital in Kulithalai. He was arrested on Tuesday.

75-year-old farmer killed in elephant attack

Coimbatore: A 75-YEAR-OLD farmer was killed in an alleged wild elephant attack at his grove in Pudupathi, along the TN-Kerala border near Madukkarai forest range on Tuesday. Sources said the incident occurred when the farmer — T Nataraj, a non-tribal resident from Pudupathi — went out to attend nature's call along the forest boundary, barely 150 metres from his house. A tusker attacked him, resulting in severe injuries. Nataraj allegedly died in the 108 ambulance while being taken to the Coimbatore MCH. A Madukkarai forest range staff member said the victim had recently undergone eye surgery, which might have affected his ability to notice the elephant. "He had moved close to the animal and due to his age, he could not run away. The elephant was feeding on bamboo growing along the forest boundary," the staff said, adding that the wild animal allegedly knocked him to the ground, resulting in him sustaining head injuries.

Cops arrest bus driver for woman's murder

Chennai: A 29-year-old bus driver was arrested on Tuesday on charges of murdering a 58-year-old woman and robbing her gold jewellery at Pulicat in Tiruvallur on Monday. The accused was arrested within four hours of the crime being reported, police said. The accused, Yugendran alias Abdul Rahman of Kalaingar Nagar near Pulicat, allegedly murdered Vanaja, who sold idli batter from her house. The crime came to light after her domestic help found the house locked.

Sources said the victim and all four suspects, aged 15, were residents of the same town. "Suspects had allegedly repeatedly sexually assaulted the girl at school. The incident came to light when she informed her parents on Monday. They then approached the all-women police," said police sources. ENS

SABARI Varman, owner of a grocery shop, was arrested by the South Thamarakulam police on July 9 for allegedly selling banned tobacco products at his shop at Ethancadu. Police said 15 packets of tobacco products were seized from the shop. He was later remanded to judicial custody by a Nagercoil court and lodged in the district prison.

According to the doctors at the Kanniyakumari GMCH, Varman was brought to the hospital from the prison around 6.05 am on Monday and was declared dead on arrival. Immediately, his relatives staged a protest near the hospital, alleging death due to police torture. They also demanded that a postmortem be conducted by doctors from other government medical colleges.

They also refused to accept

his body till they received the postmortem report and briefly blocked the road near the hospital on Tuesday demanding a government job for the wife of the deceased.

LoP Udhayanidhi Stalin on Tuesday demanded a fair probe into the death and sought an explanation from the government.

In a statement on X, he alleged discriminatory treatment by the police, claiming that while Sabari Varman was remanded to judicial custody after gutka was allegedly seized from his shop, a TVK functionary, Arun, arrested in a similar case, was released on station bail the very same day.

Reacting to the death, the CPI state executive committee and NTK leader Seeman demanded registration of a murder case against the accused and ₹ 25 lakh compensation for the victim's family.
