ANOTHER FIRE BREAKS OUT AT KODUNGAIYUR DUMP

Blaze spread over two acres at site triggered by methane discharge from bio-waste, doused after three-hour operation

A fire broke at the Kodungaiyur dump yard on Sunday afternoon, which spread on about two acres and covered vast areas with dense white smoke.

Firefighters and Greater Chennai Corporation staff brought the blaze under control after more than three hours, using seven excavators to lift portions of the garbage and pour water over them. Owing to lack

of space, fire engines struggled to enter the site. Around 5.20 pm on Sunday, an official said 95% of the fire had been doused.

T K Shanmugam, president of the Federation of North Chennai Residents' Welfare Association, described it as one of the major fires in recent times and urged the civic body to address the repeated incidents.

"Old waste at the dump

yard must be cleared expeditiously through bio-mining. Until then, permanent monitoring systems, fire safety measures and smoke pollution prevention measures must be put in place to prevent further fire incidents. The lives and health of the people of Kodungaiyur must not be risked," he said.

Asked about the repeated fires at the dump yard, a senior SWM official said they were

caused by methane generated from biodegradable waste and claimed that no fire had been reported since July.

In June, at least two fires were reported at the dump yard within a week.

The official alleged that ragpickers had set fire to the garbage to extract metals. However, a Vyasarpadi resident said, "Ragpickers won't do it, as their livelihood depends on this dumpyard."

Three youths killed as bikes collide head-on near Sriperumbudur

THREE youths were killed and another was critically injured after two bikes collided head-on near Sriperumbudur in Kancheepuram district on Sunday. The accident occurred on the service road of the Chengalpattu-Sriperumbudur state highway, near a private hospital.

According to the Oragadam police, the deceased were identified as Durai Pandian (26), Yuvaraj (23) and Darshan. Monish, who sustained critical injuries, is undergoing treatment at the Chengalpattu Government Medical College Hospital.

According to the police, Durai Pandian, a native of Madurai, was working as an HR manager at a private company in Vallam Sipcot. Yuvaraj, from Panruti, worked at the same company. On Sunday, the two

had gone to a theatre in Oragadam to watch a movie. They were returning towards Vallam on a bike when they were involved in the accident.

The police said Monish, a native of Erode, and his friend Darshan were travelling towards them on a bike. The two bikes collided head-on near the private hospital, leaving all four riders seriously injured.

The injured were taken to the Sriperumbudur government hospital in a '108' ambulance. Durai and Yuvaraj died despite treatment. Monish and Darshan, who were in critical condition, were shifted to the Chengalpattu Government Medical College Hospital in separate ambulances. Darshan died on the way, while Monish continues to receive intensive treatment.

The police sent the bodies for post-mortem and have registered a case.

Body in bag on train: Arrested couple brought to city for probe

THE couple accused of murdering a woman whose headless, dismembered body was found in a trolley bag on the Tamil Nadu Express were brought to Chennai from Guwahati on Sunday night.

Manik Uddin Laskar (22), from Assam, and his wife Bhagabati Maji were arrested by special teams of the Tambaram City Police in Manipur and Assam. After being produced before local courts, they were brought to Chennai on transit warrants. The duo arrived at Chennai airport at 9 pm in a flight from Guwahati under security and were taken to the Tambaram City Police Commissioner's office.

The case surfaced on August 5 after passengers noticed a foul smell from a trolley bag in an unreserved coach after the train reached Agra. Railway police opened the bag and found a headless, dismembered woman's body.

Six juveniles among 10 arrested for bike racing on Vadapalani road

A total of 10 people, including six juveniles, were arrested for allegedly racing on bikes and performing stunts along the 100-foot road in Vadapalani in the early hours of Sunday. Five of their motorcycles were also impounded.

According to the Anna Nagar Traffic Investigation Wing (TIW) police, the group was racing towards Koyambedu from Vadapalani when one of them nearly brushed against the bike of a man who was riding with his wife and child. The man stopped the bike and regained composure, the police said. Clips, purportedly of the incident, are doing the rounds online.

Passersby and others confronted the group and thrashed them for racing. They also informed the police who then took the 10 into custody.

The police recorded the statement of the man who was hit by the racers and let go.

A police official said the gang had raced twice or thrice before they nearly hit the man's bike. While racing, some of them fell and sustained minor injuries, the officer added.

The group had created a WhatsApp group to discuss the race. A few of them had monitored the area for police presence before setting out on it, the police said. Following inquiries, the four men in the group were taken for remand while the boys were produced before the Juvenile Justice Board.

Gang kills history-sheeter over past enmity, 4 held

A 24-year-old history-sheeter, who had come out on bail a few days ago, was hacked to death by a

five-member gang near the Kelambakkam crematorium on Saturday night, the police said. While four of the suspects were arrested on Sunday, two special

teams have been formed to trace the fifth accused, who is allegedly absconding.

According to the Kelambakkam police, the body of Sahul Hameed, a resident of Anna Nagar in Kelambakkam, was found dead with cut injuries to the head and face around 7 am on Sunday. A probe revealed that Hameed

had collected ₹1,000 from his family around 9.15 pm on Saturday and left home to consume alcohol. The gang then murdered him over past enmity.

The police sent Hameed's body to the Government Chengalpattu Medical College and Hospital for post-mortem and registered a

Van mows down rider, driver held

CHENNAI: A 32-year-old man was killed after a van allegedly driven by a drunk driver hit his two-wheeler on the Rajiv Gandhi Salai near Kotturpuram on Saturday. The victim, Nagarajan, died at a private hospital a few hours later, the police said. According to the Mylapore Traffic Investigation Wing (TIW) police, Nagarajan of Kodambakkam was riding towards Madhya Kailash when the van hit him from behind. The police apprehended the van driver, Prabhu (30), who was found drunk, and arrested him. The van was seized.



Man with 3 kg ganja in baggage held at airport

Chennai: Customs arrested a 48-year-old passenger after allegedly seizing 2.96 kg of suspected high-grade hydroponic ganja from his baggage at the Chennai airport on Friday. The passenger had arrived from Kuala Lumpur with wheelchair assistance and allegedly attempted to exit without declaring the contents. A check found the contraband in six packets hidden in checked-in baggage.

Farmers allege diversion of silt from Korampallam tank to realtors

FARMERS dependent on the Korampallam tank located near Thoothukudi town alleged silt and karambai (fertile silt) removed from it were not being supplied to farmers, but they were being sold by dredgers to realtors at a huge price.

Farmers say the district administration has permitted the removal of silt deposits from the tank so as to increase its storage capacity. The government has permitted farmers to take them freely as silt and karambai sands are good for agriculture.

A banana farmer, M Rathnapandi of Vadaku Kalangarai village, said that he had applied for taking karambai sand to fill up his agricultural land two months ago.

“Water from the Korampallam tank seeps into my low-lying land, which is close to the

tank, thus spoiling crops as it cannot be drained. However, the operators don't give the sand. They charge more than ₹1,000 per load, and I can not afford it,” he said. “Those who excavate the silt sell it to the realtors,” he claimed.

Excavators supply the sand to fill up private lands in Athi-

marapatti, Sirupadu, and Nallamalai. The karambai sand is dumped on private lands by real estate developers for securing layout approval, said sources.

A senior Mines and Geology department official told *TNIE* that the Korampallam tank has been notified for removing silt

after the tahsildar gave permission.

However, the district administration did not give permission under the G.O 50 which allows taking karambai sand for agricultural purposes. A private contractor who took up the dredging contract supply the silt to realtors, he said.

The Korampallam tank of the aegis of the Water Resources Department (WRD) is one of the largest tanks in the Thamirabarani river basin. It is also the last tank to be fed by the north channel that branches off from the Srivaikuntam anaicut across the Thamirabarani River. It is also fed by other inflow channels including Uppar odai that fetches water from the Kayathar and Otapidaram regions.

The storage capacity of the tank has drastically reduced with the accumulation of silt after repeated floods. The tank extends to over 3,000 acres.

Two behead painter in tiff over kabaddi event venue

A 33-year-old painter was beheaded at Manimutheeswaram village in Tirunelveli on Sunday allegedly for opposing a kabaddi tournament proposed by the villagers. Two people have been arrested after they surrendered before the Thachanallur police along with the weapons used for the gruesome crime.

The murdered man was Baskar, a resident of Manimutheeswaram village, said police.

Those arrested in the case, Manikandan (22) and Ponraj (20) of the same locality, had been in conflict with the Baskar, they added. On Sunday, when Baskar was in an inebriated condition, the duo attacked him with sharp weapons and be-

headed him. The two discarded the head nearly 100 metre from the crime scene, said police.

The Thachanallur collected the head and the decapitated body and sent them to the Tirunelveli medical college hospital for postmortem.

The motive of the crime was the animosity to Baskar. The villagers had identified a place for holding matches for the kabaddi tournament. Baskar allegedly opposed the choice of the site and this did not go down with other villagers. It is also said Baskar had been alerting the police of the developments in the village which had been affecting the youths.

Manikandan and Ponraj were remanded to jail following their arrest. Baskar belonged to the Devendrakula Vellala community, the same as that of the suspects in his murder.

4 Rajasthan lorries seized for plying within state

MEMBERS of the Thoothukudi lorry owners association on Sunday detained four lorries registered in Rajasthan while they were transporting machinery from Kayathar to Otapidaram, alleging violations of motor vehicle regulations. Sources say a Rajasthan-based contractor has taken up a project to install High-Tension (HT) electricity towers in Otapidaram. The lorry owners alleged that the vehicles were being used for transporting goods between two locations, contrary to the provisions governing National Permits. Such permits allow goods vehicles to transport consignments across states, but do not permit them to operate for intra-state transportation in another state, they claimed.

On Sunday, the members, along with e-Vahan service personnel, intercepted and secured the four lorries and their drivers at Madathur. The association has urged officials of the Regional Transport Office (RTO) to trace other out-of-state lorries transporting goods within Tamil Nadu. The contractor who had engaged the vehicles was also called for talks. Further inquiry is under way.

PUTHIYA Tamilagam chief K Krishnasamy on Sunday urged the Tamil Nadu government to prevent the proposed eviction of people living in the Manjulai and Megamalai regions, stating that the move would severely affect their livelihood.

Speaking to reporters, Krishnasamy said several generations of people had been living in the hill regions and questioned the alternative arrangements proposed for them. “Evicting our own people and turning them into refugees is a blatant violation of human rights,” he said.

He urged the government to implement the Forest Rights Act, 2006, effectively to resolve the issue and present strong arguments before the Supreme Court. He also called for the appointment of experienced lawyers to argue the review petition concerning Megamalai.

Krishnasamy said a meeting involving leaders of various political parties would be held in Madurai in September to oppose the eviction of the hill residents. He also alleged that he had been provided police se-

VILLAGERS, DYFI MEMBERS CONTINUE PROTEST MARCH FOR SECOND DAY

THENI: Over 100 members of DYFI along with villagers in and around Varusanadu and Megamalai have continued their protest march for the second consecutive day over the proposed eviction of residents from the limits of the Srivilliputhur-Megamalai Tiger Reserve. The protesters raised slogans demanding that the livelihood of people living in 98 villages in the Varusanadu and Megamalai hill regions be protected and that the Forest Department's proposed eviction measures be stopped. They also urged the Tamil Nadu government to file a review petition before the Supreme Court against its directions to clear the alleged encroachments. The march began on Saturday from Valparai village near Varusanadu. The protesters proceeded through Thummakundu, Manalathu Kudisai, Murukkodai, Uruttimedu, Varusanadu, Singarajapuram, Koraiyuthu and Kumananthozh before heading towards Kadamalaikundu. Villagers have been staging protests at various levels against the proposed eviction. Police personnel have been deployed along the route as a precautionary measure to prevent any law-and-order issues during the protest march organised by the DYFI in support of the hill villagers.

4,000 acres of sugarcane in danger amid water scarcity

LACK of irrigation has threatened nearly 4,000 acres of sugarcane cultivation in Melur, Vadipatti and surrounding rainfed areas of Madurai district, with farmers warning that crops could wither if the region does not receive adequate rainfall soon.

Of the total area under sugarcane, around 1,500 acres are cultivated with green sugarcane, while the remaining area is under purple sugarcane. With irrigation wells drying up, farmers are increasingly dependent on borewells to keep the crops alive. M Satish, a sugarcane farmer from Melur, said he had cultivated purple sugarcane on around five acres and was struggling to sustain the crop after his irrigation wells went dry. “We have two irrigation wells and two borewells. The irrigation wells have recently gone dry, leaving us dependent on borewells. If there is no adequate rainfall in the next three weeks, the crops will dry up,” he said.
