'Specs differ for roads laid under different schemes'

CCMC chief says in response to complaints about quality of roads

WITH people expressing concern about the quality of roads, the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) commissioner explained that different specifications are followed in roads laid under different funding schemes.

Most roads in the city are damaged within days of construction. People alleged that UGD pipeline works coupled with rains are causing the roads to cave in.

Most roads in the city are in a bad state due to the ongoing work such as installation of pipelines for the 24x7 drinking water project, Pillur scheme 3 and Underground Drainage (UGD) project among others.

Following several complaints, the government allotted funds under schemes including Tamil Nadu Urban Roads Infrastructure Development Programme (TURIP), Nagarpura Salaigal Membattu Thittam (NSMT) and State Finance Committee (SFC) to repair the roads.

However, the quality of newly paved roads have left people worried as dents have developed in the new roads. Currently, officials are digging the newly paved road laid from Puliakulam to Sowripalayam.

B Kasinathan, a resident of Meena Estate, said, "There is no milling and roads are not laid as per specifications, which causes potholes almost immediately. The civic officials are

digging up newly paved roads citing one reason or the other. They should have completed all works and then paved the road."

Further, the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage (TWAD) Board has been carrying out the UGD works in the Kurichi-Kuniyamuthur areas for the past few years. The majority of roads in these areas are damaged and left unattended.

To make matters worse, portions of the roads near the Perur Bypass Road and Sugunapuram in Kuniyamuthur caved in recently after the heavy rains.

When inquired about it, CCMC Commissioner M Prathap told TNIE, "There are no quality issues in paving the roads. As the roads are laid un-

der different schemes and have different thicknesses and methods of paving, people get confused. Milling is done only for roads paved under the TURIP scheme and not for roads under the NSMT. Also, the TURIP roads will have 10 mm of WM (Wet Mix) extra when compared to the NSMT which will have 5 cm of BC (Bituminous Concrete Mixes) and 2 cm of BM (Bituminous Macadam Mixes)."

"A couple of roads caved in due to a burst in old UGD lines. As Kuniyamuthur is filled with clay soil, the surface tends to become loose very soon and the roads got damaged. I've instructed the TWAD board officials to take necessary precautionary measures before carrying out any works on the roads in future," he added.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES RISING IN TIRUPPUR DIST, JOB LOSS AMONG REASONS

THE number of domestic violence cases is on the rise in Tiruppur district. Officers at One Stop Centres (OSC), which were created across the state to handle and support women affected by violence in private and public spaces, within the family, community and at work places, said emotional and financial problems are the main reasons for the violence.

As per data shared by the Tiruppur district social welfare department, 32 cases were reported at OSC in 2019. This jumped to 173 in 2020, 182 cases in 2021, and 236 cases in 2022. Sixty-one cases have been reported in the first four months (till April) this year.

Secretary of National Federation of Indian Women (Tiruppur) P Nathiya said, "Garment industry in Tiruppur is labour intensive. But when the units do not have enough orders, families of workers are affected. My

friend's husband lost his job and she was forced to get a loan. Over a period of time, the outstanding amount swelled. She had to repay ₹19,000 a month to six self-help groups (SHG). This created domestic disputes quarrelled with her husband almost every night. After some time, she started demanding divorce. More importantly, alcohol addiction of men is a big factor in increase in domestic violence"

Social activist Vichitra Senthil Kumar said, "Pre-marriage counselling is missing in Tiruppur district. I know of a bright girl who found life very difficult after marriage and got separated from her husband. We thought her in-laws were bad. Later, we found out that she was not able to adapt to her new life and had

been quarrelling for silly reasons with her husband and in-laws. We must educate both girls and boys on the importance of patience in nurturing and sustaining relationship."

An official from the Social Welfare Department said, "Changes in emotional and financial status in society are causing problems. We organised 453 counselling sessions in 2022, and 318 counselling sessions in 2021 through OSC. Police assistance was also offered to 98 victims in 2022 and 71 victims in 2021. The posts of legal advisers and family counsellors in OSC have been vacant since 2022. Once the vacancies are filled, we will be able to address the issues more effectively."

As per sources, OSC handles issues related to women's mental health whereas serious cases including physical injuries caused by abuse or torture are handled by All Women Police stations. As regards dowry-related harassment, if police have doubts regarding the victim's complaint and want more evidence on both sides, they request OSC to take over. A team headed by District Social Welfare officer checks with family members. In POCOS cases, particularly child marriage, OSC offers counselling. But the District Child Protection Officer monitors the schedule. Helpline 181 provides 24-hour immediate and emergency response to women affected by violence.

DIET lecturers asked to inspect teaching methods in govt schools

THE State Council for Educational Research and Training (SCERT) has directed senior lecturers in District Institute of Teacher Education (DIET) to inspect teaching methods in government schools and students learning ability every month, following complaints that inspections do not take place regularly.

As per sources, in 2019,

SCERT directed lectures to inspect schools. If teaching methods are found to be unsatisfactory, lecturers should organize workshop for teachers. However, in practice, lectures do not inspect at the schools. Some teachers lodged complaints against this, following which SCERT directed them to inspect schools, sources added. R Ramakumar, president of Tamil Nadu Teachers and School Protection Association has welcomed the decision.

Coimbatore: District administration sent a proposal to the state government to construct a five-storey building on the collectorate premises at ₹64 crore. Forest staff have been deployed in front of the waterfall to prevent tourists from entering the waters. Likewise, Covai Courtallam has also been closed for visitors following heavy rain in the western ghats.

Transport staff gets 7-year jail term after 32 yrs

He was booked for misappropriating funds while auctioning buses of Cheran transport corp

A former official of the erstwhile Cheran Transport Corporation (CTC) was sentenced to seven years of imprisonment on Friday and fined ₹3.32 crore 32 years after he was booked for misappropriating funds while auctioning condemned buses.

Judge PK Sivakumar of first additional subordinate court sentenced P Kothandapani (82), who worked as Assistant, Transport Department of CTC. According to sources, Kothandapani and seven others were booked by RS Puram police in 1990 for causing ₹28 lakh loss in the auction of condemned buses of CTC between November 1986 and November

9, 1988. It came to light during an audit, following which the general manager of CTC lodged a complaint.

According to the FIR, the accused gave off 14 buses to people who had won in the auction without receiving the full payment and 44 buses by receiving partial payment. CB-CID investigated the case and filed a charge sheet against eight persons in December 1990. During the trial period, four persons died.

The court also imposed fine of ₹3.32 crore on Kothandapani, which is to be paid to the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation (TNSTC). The court acquitted three persons in the case. Assistant public prosecutor P Krishnamoorthy appeared for the government.



Two booked for sexually abusing two minors

IN separate cases, two men were booked under POCSO Act on Thursday. According to the police, K Muthukumar (38), sexually abused two minor girls near Arapalayam.

Following one of the girl's complaints, police registered the case. Similarly, Anand (48) was arrested on charges of raping a 19-year-old girl near Periyar. Police said the girl's parents were working in the flower shop of the accused. Anand made threats that he will post their intimate photos online, which were taken in 2016, they added.

Min can't be sacked unless sentenced to two-year jail term, TN govt tells HC

THE state government has told the Madras High Court a minister can't be sacked from the position unless they are convicted with two years of imprisonment.

The submission was made by Advocate General (AG) R Shunmugasundaram during hearing of petitions seeking to remove TN minister V Senthil Balaji, currently jailed in Central prison in Puzhal, after being arrested by the enforcement directorate (ED) on money laundering



charges, from the Cabinet.

There is no bar on the minister to continue to hold on to the position. He can't be removed from the Cabinet unless convicted with two years of imprisonment, the AG said.

Referring to the petitions contending on Governor's powers to sack the minister, he said either the President or the Governor cannot exercise the powers independently but only on the advice of the council of ministers. Quoting several judgments of the courts, including the Supreme Court, he recalled the apex court had

held that when the electorate do not have the powers to recall the representative they had elected, the court too can't do so by issuing orders.

Responding to the contention that Senthil Balaji has been drawing the salary due for a minister without even discharging the duties, the AG said a minister in the state is getting a salary of ₹76,000 per month while an MLA is getting much higher salary of ₹1.05 lakh. Senior counsel V Ravagachari and advocate K Sakthivel argued on behalf of the petitioners who including AIADMK ex-MP J Jayavardhan and advocate ML Ravi.

41-yr-old woman killed in house, jewels missing

A 41-year-old woman was strangled to death at her house in Coimbatore city. Her jewels were also allegedly stolen, said police.

The deceased was identified as Jagadeeshwari (41) from Balaji Nagar at Cheran Maa Nagar near Peelamedu in the city. Her husband took a painting contract and went to Annur on Friday. Police said, the deceased used to go to the school to pick up her daughter, a Class 12 student, everyday around 4.30 pm.

On Friday as she did not go to school, her daughter was waiting at the school till 5.30 pm and reached the house by walking. That is when she found her mother murdered, said police.

Around four sovereigns of the gold chain and one sovereign of ear studs were stolen from the house, police added.

On being alerted Peelamedu police came to the spot and sent the body for autopsy and an investigation is underway.

'Forest department has a lot of catching up to do'

LOCAL activists, however, said it was a failure on the part of the forest department. "The snare was laid in Kothamangalam area which was just 150 m from the forest boundary. The tiger carcass was found 1.5 km inside the forest. It's not too deep to go undetected for 20 days. The department must intensify its efforts in preventing such unfortunate deaths."

As per the Status of Tigers 2022 report, only 824 unique tigers were recorded in the Western Ghats against the estimated population of 981 in 2018 indicating a decline in some regions. The state-wise data will be released by NTCA on Saturday. The Nilgiri cluster is home to the world's largest tiger population, but recent data show a decrease in tiger occupancy

throughout the Western Ghats, except in a few areas like Kali (Anshi Dandeli). While tiger populations within protected areas have either remained stable or increased, tiger occupancy outside of these regions has significantly decreased, sources said. For example, beyond the protected area of Anamalai-Parambikulam complex, a decrease in tiger occupancy was observed. However, the state government is confident that tiger numbers in Tamil Nadu are healthy considering the fact that five tiger reserves have scored well in Management Effectiveness Evaluation (MEE).

The Anamalai Tiger Reserve (ATR) and Mudumalai Tiger Reserve (MTR) are in fact rated "excellent" and are among the top 12 best managed reserves in the country. However, activists allege that forest department

has a lot of catching up to do. Poaching, staff vacancies, habitat degradation, and disturbance in important corridors continue to be key concerns, they said.

Over the past 10 years, the state lost 70 tigers and it ranks sixth in the country in tiger mortality rate. MTR alone lost 22 big cats during the period. As per the details available with NTCA, of the total 70 deaths, 44 occurred inside the core tiger reserve areas and the rest outside the reserve. The cause of deaths includes natural reasons, poaching and other factors. The recent arrest of six members of the notorious Bawaria poaching gang in Sathyamangalam, who confessed to have killed a young tiger deep inside Avalanche area in Nilgiris, indicates there is a need for strengthening the anti-poaching force.

NLC as bad as Sterlite, says Anbumani Ramadoss

EARLIER, speaking at the protest spot, Anbumani Ramadoss slammed both the central and state governments for supporting the NLC. He demanded immediate halt of land acquisition and lamented the absence of farmer associations in the protest, despite their involvement in demonstrations in Delhi.

Ramadoss also said that PMK previously protested for additional compensation for land due to electricity need at that time. However, with the current surplus power situation in TN, NLC is not needed anymore. If NLC continues to acquire land, PMK cadres must block roads indefinitely, he said. Anbumani Ramadoss called upon youth to organise protests, comparing the danger

posed by NLC to that of Sterlite. He also accused the CM of having a tacit understanding with the Union government on the NLC issue while opposing it on all other matters.

Nearly 2,000 police personnel were deployed across Cuddalore district under the supervision of North Zone IG Kanman and Villupuram Range DIG Ziaul Haque. As a precautionary measure, traffic on Chen-

nai-Kumbakonam road was halted, and vehicles were rerouted through alternative roads. Shops in Neyveli and nearby villages remained closed. According to police sources, PMK workers staged protest at 127 places across the state, including five places in Chennai, condemning Anbumani's arrest.
