Sole owner of 400 acres of UoH land: T'gana govt

Says survey in July 19, 2024 with varsity officials demarcated boundary

AMID the claim that some part of the 400 acres of land at Kancha Gachibowli, which is proposed to be auctioned by the Telangana Industrial Infrastructure Corporation (TGIIC), is owned by the University of Hyderabad (UoH), the state government reiterated that it was the sole owner of the property and that even a survey was conducted on July 19, 2024 in the presence of university officials for boundary demarcation.

In a press statement, the government stated: "On alienation of the above land in favour of TGIIC, zonal manager, Cyberabad, the corporation on July 4, 2024 requested the registrar, UoH to entrust their officials concerned to conduct the survey work to fix up the common boundary points on the ground. TGIIC officials had contacted the registrar, UoH personally along with their team on July 11, 2024 and explained in detail about the proposed project. The zonal manager also made a request through email to registrar@uohyd.ac.in on July 18, 2024 for conducting the survey. Accordingly with the consent of the registrar, UoH, survey work was conducted on July 19, 2024 in the presence of the UoH officials i.e. dy registrar, university engineer, and executive engineer and revenue au-

thorities i.e., RI and mandal surveyor and the boundaries were fixed." "The Buffalo lake and the Peacock lake are not part of the 400 acres land parcel being developed by TGIIC," it added.

The state government also clarified that TGIIC neither encroached upon the university land nor disturbed the existing water bodies and rock formations (Mushroom Rock) in the land.

According to the release, the then Andhra Pradesh government allotted 400 acres of land to IMG Academies Bharata Pvt Ltd on January 13, 2004 in the Survey no 25 of Kancha Gachibowli for the development of sports facilities.

As the project of the IMG Academies Bharata Pvt Ltd did not take off, the then government on November 21, 2006 re-

voked the above allotment. Following, IMG Academies Bharata Pvt Ltd filed a petition before the high court that went into a prolonged legal battle and finally the court passed orders on March 24, 2024 in favour of the government. Aggrieved by the order, IMG Academies Bharata Pvt Ltd appealed in the Supreme Court of India and it was dismissed in May 2024.

At the request of TGIIC, the deputy collector & tahsildar, Serilingampally mandal confirmed that as per revenue records the land in Sy No 25 of Kancha Gachibowli village is recorded as "Kancha Asthabal Poramboke Sarkari" i.e., government land and an extent of 400 acres is available free from encroachments and under the possession of the government for further development.

CPM glorifying killers of our worker in temple fest: BJP

A celebration by CPM workers with flags featuring photographs of those convicted in the 2005 murder of BJP member Elambilayi Sooraj, during a temple festival recently has sparked a controversy. The BJP Kannur leadership has condemned the act.

The flags displaying the pictures of all the convicts were used at the Kuttichathan Madom festival in Parambayi during the kalasha procession on Sunday night. The event,

which included DJ performances and other programmes as part of the 'kalasham varavu' ritual, saw party workers waving the flags while dancing and chanting slogans.

Visuals of the procession, later circulated on social media, signal a striking departure from the usual festival celebrations in Kannur featuring party flags and other party symbols. Meanwhile, BJP Kannur South district president Biju Elakuzhi alleged that raising slogans while displaying im-

ages of murder convicts during the kalasha procession was done with the full knowledge of the CPM leadership.

"Traditionally, temple processions feature devotional songs. However, in contrast, the CPM dominated areas are promoting slogans and songs that glorify murderers. This deliberate attempt by the CPM leadership aims to undermine temple customs," he said. Biju further accused the CPM of misusing Hindu temples for po-

litical motives. "Glorifying murderers on temple premises is an attack on religious traditions and a tactic to alienate devotees. Such incidents are not isolated. Just days ago, widespread violence erupted at the Manolikkavu temple festival in Thalassery under CPM's leadership," he added.

The Thalassery District Sessions Court in Kannur had on March 8 sentenced eight CPM workers to life imprisonment for the murder of Sooraj of Muzhappilangad on August 7, 2005.

Man kills girlfriend, attempts to project murder as suicide

In a gruesome incident, a 19-year-old girl was killed by her boyfriend for asking him to marry her; he took the body nearly 150 km on a motorcycle, and tried to project it as a suicide by hanging her from a tree.

District ASP Ankita Surana told mediapersons here on Monday that Perumalla Rambabu of Dattivalasa, a married person, was in love with a woman of Nadimivalasa. When she insisted him to marry her repeatedly, he strangled her, and shifted her to a private hospital, where she was declared brought dead.

Then he took the body on his bike to Gadepallevalasa village in Salur mandal with the help of his friend, and another accomplice had helped them in a refill of petrol. Then they tried to project it as a suicide by hanging her from a tree.

Petitioner approached HC after centre revoked citizenship

RAMYA approached the court after Union government authorities concerned had initiated action to revoke her citizenship.

According to the petitioner, her grandfather hailed from Pudukkottai district in Tamil Nadu and later moved to Sri Lanka. After the ethnic violence in the island nation intensified in 1983, Ramya's parents Saravanamuthu and Tamilselvi returned to India by air and stayed in Coimbatore, where she was born on December 24, 1987.

As she was born in India, she

was given a birth certificate by the Coimbatore Municipal Corporation and was treated as an Indian citizen. Ramya studied at a local school and later completed her graduation from a college in the district. She was issued a passport and other identity documents, including voter ID, by the respective authorities.

When her parents applied for extension of their registration to continue their stay in India, the officials, during scrutiny, found that Ramya was born after July 1, 1987, and took action to revoke her citizenship.

"The authorities noticed that

according to the Citizenship Act, any person born in India after July 1, 1987, cannot claim Indian citizenship solely by virtue of birth; at least one of the parents must be a citizen of India at the time of birth. Therefore, suddenly, realising the mistake, the authorities have begun taking action," the judge noted in the order.

When she was ordered to surrender her passport, Ramya approached the authorities in the MHA and the Ministry of External Affairs with an application on February 10, 2025, for citizenship, as the online portal was not ac-

cepting her application due to the peculiar facts involved in her case.

Ramya said that she should be given the citizenship under Section 5 (1) (c) of the Citizenship Act, as she was married to an Indian citizen and has lived for seven years after marriage in the country. But it was rejected by the authorities, who said they would consider her application on these grounds only if she went to Sri Lanka and came back as a legal entrant with a valid Indian visa to avoid being termed an illegal immigrant. 'Bose attacked cops with machete, inspector shot him in self-defence'

AFTER the encounter, Bose was rushed with a gunshot wound in the chest to a private hospital nearby where doctors declared him dead. The body was shifted to Government Rajaji Hospital for post mortem. Head constable Karnan and constable Saravanankumar, who both sustained injuries in their shoulders, are undergoing treatment in the hospital. Commissioner of Police (Madurai city) Loganathan, who inspected the crime scene, said the inspector Boominathan, along with the two other policemen, attempted to arrest Bose.

However, he allegedly attacked both constables with a machete. Though the inspector warned him to surrender, Bose fired at him with an illegal pistol, Loganathan said, adding that the bullet missed and entered the suspect's used car instead. In an act of self-defence, the inspector fired at Bose, he said. "Although he aimed at his leg, Bose moved and received the fatal shot in his chest," the commissioner said. Police sources said there were 21 cases pending against Bose, including three for murder. Police said a team had caught a group with ganja, which claimed that Bose had supplied the drug.

Man dies, grandson injured as police vehicle rams bike

A 57-year-old man died and his 10-year-old grandson sustained grievous injuries after a vehicle carrying police personnel collided head-on with their two-wheeler near Manimuthar on Sunday evening.

Sources said the deceased A Nagarajan of Anna Nagar in Manimuthar was planning on going to Kallidaikurichi to purchase food, when his grandson M Christinson (10) insisted on accompanying him. While they were nearing Perunkal canal bridge on their two-wheeler, a truck carrying IX Battalion personnel approached from the opposite direction and rammed into them. Nagarajan and Christinson were thrown off the vehicle and severely injured, sources added.

Sources further said passersby alerted the Kallidaikurichi police, who transported the victims to the Ambasamudram Government Hospital. However, Nagarajan succumbed to his injuries en route and Christinson, who suffered critical injuries, was later referred to the Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital. The police have registered a case against the vehicle driver Ganesan of Pungampatti and began an inquiry, sources added.

Govt reopened 40 temples closed for various issues, says Sekarbabu

CONTINUED FROM PAGE 1: Minister Sekarbabu said the incumbent government has reopened around 40 temples across the state that had remained closed due to various issues. "Similarly, the Draupadi Amman temple will also be opened for devotees to offer worship." On April 7, 2023, members of the Vanniyan community barred the Dalits in the village entry to the temple and did not allow them to offer worship. After seven rounds of peace talks between the two communities failed, the revenue divisional officer of Villupuram on June 7, 2023, sealed the temple. In March 2024, the HC passed interim orders, directing the authorities to keep the temple open only for the priest to enter and perform poojas. Last month, the court ordered the temple to be reopened for public worship and asked authorities to take action if anyone caused law and order problems. Revenue officials in the district said efforts, including the installation of CCTV cameras, are under way, so that the temple can be reopened soon.
