

### 'Harassed' in school, boy, 16, jumps to death from NCR hostel

**Gurgaon:** A Class XI student of a residential school in Haryana's Rewari allegedly jumped to his death from the balcony of his hostel room on the third floor early on Friday, reports **Ankita Anand**.

The 16-year-old from Mahendergarh left behind a note in his room that accuses the school authorities of "harassing" him. He also complained about the "atmosphere" in the school, saying "teachers don't teach" and "everyone is busy trying to make money illegally". He claimed he had made repeated requests to be moved out of the school, but to no avail.

His family members lodged a complaint at Kund police outpost, following which a case for abetment of suicide was registered against the school. The school's board of administration in Delhi also initiated an internal probe.

The tragedy echoed another involving a boy of almost similar age in Faridabad last year — a Class X student who left a deeply poignant note to his mother in which he wrote "this school has killed me".

## Naidu wiped off evidence after skill scam was unearthed

State Cops May Arrest Former Mantri K Atchannaaidu As Well

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**Hyderabad:** The Andhra Pradesh Crime Investigation Department has alleged that former chief minister N Chandrababu Naidu destroyed evidence after the Directorate-General of GST Intelligence found that funds had been siphoned off from the AP State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC).

The CID also named former minister K Atchannaaidu as accused No. 2 in the case. He is likely to be arrested soon.

On May 14, 2018, a complaint from the DGGSTI office, Pune, was sent to the state anti-corruption bureau. It gave details of APSSDC funds being allegedly routed to various shell companies through fake invoices. The Pune office said DesignTech and other firms provide no services to APSSDC.

Additionally, companies like Skiller Enterprises India Pvt Ltd and DesignTech — central to the scam — have been accused of claiming central VAT without paying ser-

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vice tax. GST officials also identified irregularities allegedly involving money transfers through hawala channels in 2017.

ACB ordered an inquiry, but Naidu was CM and no action was taken, the CID claimed. "Even after knowing

about it, Naidu did not take any criminal action or preventive steps to stop misappropriation of APSSDC funds," the CID alleged.

Whistleblowers had previously reported the scam to ACB and initial investigation had proved to be inconclusive.

# Chandrababu arrested in 3am swoop over 'skill devpt scam'

## Cops Call Him Principal Conspirator

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**Vijayawada:** Former chief minister and Telugu Desam president N Chandrababu Naidu was arrested by the Andhra Pradesh Crime Investigation Department (CID) in a pre-dawn swoop on Saturday.

Naidu, who was touring the state as part of his pre-election campaign, was camping in a bus at Nandyal when a CID special investigation team woke him at 3 am and said he was being arrested in an alleged scam of Rs 371 crore in the AP Skill Development Corporation. The scam is said to have taken place between 2014 and 2019, when Naidu was Andhra Pradesh CM.

Naidu was not produced before a court till late Saturday night. A team of top lawyers, including Sidharth Luthra, were waiting at the ACB court in Vijayawada for the former CM to be presented before a judge. However, the CID was still questioning him at the time of going to print late Saturday night. A state of high alert was sounded all over Andhra Pradesh as a precautionary measure as police officers feared TDP supporters might protest and turn violent.

Although Naidu had faced scores of charges of corruption in the past, this is the first time that a criminal case has led to his arrest. Naidu's name was not mentioned in the skill development scam FIR registered on December 9, 2021, but the CID ad-

ded him as accused No. 37 in the remand report on Saturday. He is now being seen as the principal conspirator and main accused (A-1). If the charges against him are proved in court, he may face a prison term of up to 10 years, the CID said after arresting Naidu.

According to the CID investigation, the skill development corporation in 2015 signed an agreement with Siemens worth Rs 3,300 crore to train people in various skills. Of this amount, 10% was to be provided by the state government as its share. However, Siemens did not contribute its 90% and used government funds instead. The CID also alleged that a part of the money was routed to shell companies.

The CID alleged in the remand report that the end beneficiary of the scam is Telugu Desam Party, Naidu and then minister for labour, youth affairs and skill development K Atchannaaidu.

The arrest was preceded and followed by high drama as thousands of TDP workers gathered at the camping site in Nandyal, and in Vijayawa-

da where he was brought to be produced in court. Party workers attempted to stop the conveyer route.

Naidu was brought to Vijayawada from Nandyal via a circuitous route to avoid TDP workers who had blocked the roads at many places. Jana Sena leader and Tollywood star Pawan Kalyan was stopped at Begumpet airport from flying to Vijayawada after the Krishna district police requested the DGGCA not to permit him to take off.

A team of CID officials led by DIG Kollu Raghuram Reddy, who heads the SIT, arrived at the camp site at Nandyal where Naidu had spent the night in a bus. CID deputy SP M Dhananjayudu served a notice on Naidu under various IPC sections, including those dealing with criminal conspiracy and cheating, and under sections of the Prevention of Corruption Act for misappropriation of public funds.

As the news spread, TDP workers gathered in huge numbers at the camp site. Naidu asked the CID officials the grounds on which he was being arrested. He also asked for

a copy of the FIR. Raghuram Reddy said there were many documents and they would be provided after he reached the CID office.

After three hours of high drama and arguments between police and TDP leaders at the campsite, Naidu was taken into custody. Speaking to reporters, Naidu said he had not done anything wrong. "As I am fighting for the people of the state, a false case has been foisted against me. They did not show any material to suggest any wrongdoing," Naidu said.

"For the past 45 years, I have been selflessly serving the Telugu people. I am prepared to sacrifice my life to safeguard the interests of the Telugu people. No force on earth can stop me from serving the Telugu people, my motherland," Naidu tweeted after his arrest.

Police resorted to a lathi-charge at Markapuram, Podili, Ongole, Pernimitta, Muppavaram, Parthur and Chilakaluripet — en route to Vijayawada — as TDP workers tried to stop the motorcade. Naidu appealed to people and party cadres to maintain peace and calm as "ultimately justice will prevail".

Police stopped Naidu's son, Nara Lokesh, who was on a padyatra. After five hours of high drama, the police finally allowed him to travel to Vijayawada. Naidu's wife, Nara Bhuvaneshwari, offered prayers at the Sri Durga Malleswara Swamy Varla Devasthanam (Kanaka Durga temple). She appealed to people to stand by her husband in support as "he has been fighting for the cause of the people".

## Project okayed with inflated cost: CID

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**Hyderabad:** The Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation scam involving former CM N Chandrababu Naidu revolves around siphoning off public funds in the name of establishing skill development clusters. Now, the CID alleges that officials from Siemens Industry Software (India) Private Ltd (SISW) and DesignTech Systems Private Limited, Pune, conspired with Naidu and then IAS officers of the government of AP to misappropriate funds from the state treasury.

"Siemens representatives gave power-point presentations to then CM Naidu, inflating the cost estimate of the proposed 'Siemens Skill Development Centres' project. They colluded with government officials like G Subba Rao, MD & CEO of APSSDC, and K Lakshminarayana, director, APSSDC, and projected that the project worth Rs 3,300 crore would be executed with Rs 330 crore as contribution from the

government of AP. They claimed that 90% of the project's cost would be covered by 'in-kind grant' from technology partners," alleged CID.

As part of the plan, Suman Bose, then MD of SISW, Gurrugram, and Vikas Khanvelkar, MD of DesignTech, entered into a flawed and incorrect

agreement on June 30, 2015. This agreement contradicted the contents of GO No. 4 (dated June 30, 2015), which allowed the government to sanction Rs 370 crore, including taxes, for the project.

CID said any project should have a detailed project report (DPR) and cost estimates should align with prescribed rates or market survey findings. However, Naidu approved the Siemens proposal based solely on power-point presentations, bypassing these requirements.

With malicious intent, an agreement was drafted without mentioning the estimated project cost or the 90% in-kind grant promised by Siemens and DesignTech. CID alleged that Subba Rao and Lakshminarayana drafted the agreement in the form of a work order for Rs 370 crore, which APSSDC awarded to Siemens and DesignTech. Naidu approved this memorandum of agreement. When the fraud came to light in 2017-18, the relevant records were destroyed, CID alleged.

### Man who raped mom gets RI for life

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**Agartala:** A 24-year-old man from Sepahijala district of Tripura who had raped his mother in an inebriated condition last year was sentenced to rigorous imprisonment for life by the sessions court of Bishalgarh on Friday. This case could potentially mark the first instance in the state's history where a son committed such a vile act on his mother, additional public prosecutor Goutam Giri said.

In the early hours of May 2, 2022, the man returned home from a local festival. After breakfast, he had liquor and then threatened to throttle his mother if she didn't have sex with him. Taking advantage of his father's absence, he raped her and fled. Three days later, his mother filed a rape case. Police arrested him and the court allowed his custodial trial considering the crime among the rarest of rare cases, Giri said.

Additional sessions judge Bishal Gour deemed him guilty of rape and awarded him rigorous life imprisonment.

## 23 years on, son fulfils fallen soldier's dream

Joins Same Regiment His Father Had Served

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**Chandigarh:** Navteshwar Singh of Mohali joined the Army as a lieutenant on Saturday, keeping a promise made in his father's "baby book" 23 years ago. Major Harminder Singh, who lost his life in the line of duty in J&K in April 1999, had expressed the desire to see his son follow in his footsteps.

Born merely three months before his father's death, Lt Navteshwar embarked on this path despite his mother's initial reservations, honouring the legacy of a family dedicated to serving the nation.

The story unfolds through three generations. Lt Navteshwar's grandfather, Captain Harpal Singh, served in the artillery regiment, instilling a sense of duty and valour in the family's DNA. Lt Navteshwar's father, Major Harminder Singh, embodied these virtues during his time in the Army. In recognition of his raw courage in a gunfight with militants in Kashmir, Major Harminder was post-

humously awarded the Shourya Chakra.

Lt Navteshwar was commissioned into the 18 Grenadiers, the same regiment where his father had served with distinction, following his graduation from the Officer Training Academy on Saturday. The piping ceremony, attended by family members, including both paternal and maternal grandmothers, marked a deeply emotional moment for the entire family. His mother

Rupinder Pal Kaur recalled that her husband was just 29 years old when he made the ultimate sacrifice for the nation. Naturally, she had reservations about sending her son into the Army.

However, Lt Navteshwar was determined and motivated. He lived with the echoes of his father's words, inscribed in his "baby book", where Major Harminder expressed his desire to see his son become an officer in the 18 Grenadiers.

## UP: For girl's murder, her brother, mother and neighbour get life term

**Haridwar:** The court of additional district judge Sanjeev Kumar in Haridwar sentenced a woman, her son and a neighbour to life in jail for the murder of her daughter Shivani in 2017, reports **MS Nawaz**.

The court found Shivani's mother, Mithlesh Devi, brother Saurabh and neighbour Sunil guilty under IPC Sections 302 (murder), 34 (acts done by several persons in furtherance of common intention), 120-b (criminal conspiracy), 201 (causing disappearance of evidence, or

giving false information) and 506 (criminal intimidation). The court held their neighbour Sirmour Singh responsible for tampering of evidence and sentenced him to seven years of rigorous imprisonment.

Shivani was in a relationship with Ajay Singh who she intended to marry and this enraged her family. In October 2017, her mother and brother, with the help of neighbours, decided to eliminate her. A police chargesheet mentioned that she was "strangled to death and

cremated soon after".

Additional district government counsel Raj Kumar told TOI on Saturday, "A case was registered against five accused, including the victim's maternal uncle Ashok. Police gave Ashok a clean chit and filed a chargesheet against Mithlesh Devi, Saurabh, Sunil and Sirmour Singh (all residents of Buggawala in Haridwar). There was no independent witness in the case as Shivani was killed at home and cremated in secrecy."
