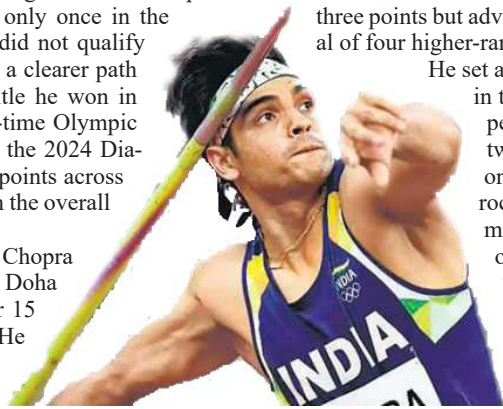


# Neeraj targets Diamond League glory

**BRUSSELS:** India's Olympic champion Neeraj Chopra will be the main attraction at the Brussels Diamond League Final 2024, while his arch-rival and Paris 2024 Olympic gold medallist, Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem, will be missing from the line-up. Nadeem, who competed only once in the Diamond League this year, did not qualify for the final, leaving Chopra a clearer path as he aims to reclaim the title he won in 2022. Neeraj Chopra, a two-time Olympic medallist, earned his spot in the 2024 Diamond League Final with 14 points across two meets, finishing fourth in the overall standings. The javelin event, where Chopra finished second in both the Doha and Lausanne legs, is set for 15 September at 1:52 AM IST. He will face tough competition from Anderson Peters of Grenada, who topped the standings with 29 points, Germany's Julian Webber with 21 points, and Jakob



Vadlejch of Czechia, the defending champion. Joining Chopra is steeplechaser Avinash Sable, who will make his Diamond League Final debut on 14 September at 12:39 AM IST. Sable finished 14th in the standings with three points but advanced due to the withdrawal of four higher-ranked athletes. He set a national record of 8:09.91 in the Paris leg and will compete against top names like two-time Olympic champion Soufiane Bakkali of Morocco and Paris 2024 bronze medallist Abraham Kibiwot of Kenya. This event marks the first time two Indian athletes will compete in a Diamond League Final. Fans in India can catch all the action live on JioCinema or watch the broadcast on Sports18 3 and Sports18 1 HD channels.

# MEN'S 4X100M MEDLEY TN shatters national record

**MANGALURU:** Tamil Nadu's relay team of Nithik Nathella, Danush Suresh, B Benedict Rohit, and Adhithya Dinesh set a new National Meet Record in the Men's 4x100m Medley, clocking 3:45.66 on the third day of the 77th Senior National Aquatic Championships 2024. They shattered the previous record of 3:47.22 set by the Services Sports Control Board (SSCB) in 2022. Karnataka's team, featuring Akash Mani, Vidith S Shankar, Kartikeyan Nair, and Srihari Nataraj, also surpassed the previous record with a time of 3:46.09, securing the second position. The International Aquatic Complex in Yemmekere, Mangaluru, also saw Karnataka's Aneesh S Gowda dominate the Men's 1500m Freestyle, pulling ahead of the competition by the second lap. His teammate Dharshan S followed closely, but Aneesh's strong pace secured him a comfortable victory with a time of 16:06.11, while Dharshan finished second in 16:16.83.

# Gem & Divija win Youth U-11 trophies

**KANGRA:** In a thrilling Youth Boys Under-11 final at the UTT National Ranking Championships held at the Rainbow Khelo India Residential Academy, Gem Mahalanabish of West Bengal emerged victorious with a 3-2 win over his fellow state rival Ariv Dutta. Despite a rocky start, including a tough first game, Gem rallied to clinch the final two games, securing his maiden title in this category. Although Ariv was the favoured competitor, Gem's strategic play in the first and final games proved decisive. In the Youth Girls Under-11 final, Assam's Divija Paul delivered a dominant performance, defeating West Bengal's Akshita Mahato 3-

0. Despite Akshita's earlier strong showings, Divija's superior play ensured a one-sided final. The semifinals were less dramatic compared to the quarterfinals. Ariv Dutta defeated Subham Adhikari in straight games, and Gem Mahalanabish also dispatched Dhruvanku Ghosh with a similar scoreline. However, Dhruvanku made a strong effort, especially in the second game, which Gem clinched on his third game point. In the quarterfinals, Shubham Adhikari faced a tough challenge from Rajasthan's top player, taking the match to the decisive fifth game before emerging triumphant. Dhruvanku Ghosh also overcame Rajasthan's Ishaan Goyal after trailing 1-2, eventually prevailing in the fifth game. Divija Paul showcased her prowess in the Youth Girls category by overcoming Uttarakhnad's Khyati Pande 3-1 in the semifinals. Despite a challenging quarterfinal match where Divija had to rally from behind, she secured victory with crucial late-game points. Akshita Mahato, initially leading 2-0 in her semifinal against Haryana's Avni Janghu, allowed her opponent to level the match before clinching the decisive fifth game with an early lead. Avni had earlier impressed with strong performances against Pehel Gupta of UP and Avyanna Phalasal, but Akshita's resilience proved too much.

## WTT CHAMPIONS

### Wang advances to quarters

**MACAO:** World No 1 Wang Chuqin of China defeated his compatriot Xu Yingbin 11-7, 12-10, 11-9 advancing to the men's singles quarterfinals at the 2024 World Table Tennis (WTT) Champions Macao. Wang said after the match on Thursday that mindset was the key to his win. "He [Xu] didn't put too much pressure on me at the start, so I gradually found a good rhythm in the match," Wang said. The afternoon session saw world No. 7 Lin Gaoyuan of China stunned by Chinese Taipei teenager Kao Cheng-Jui 1-3. Kao said that the result went beyond his expectations, and he will continue to do his best in the next round. China's youngster Lin Shidong went the full distance to upset world No. 8 Tomokazu Harimoto of Japan. On the women's side, China's Chen Xingtong came from behind to defeat Swedish defensive player Linda Bergstrom, advancing to the last eight with a 3-1 victory.

### Ireland announce limited-overs squad

**DUBLIN:** Ireland have named their white-ball squads for the upcoming series against South Africa in the United Arab Emirates. In a prominent move, Andrew Balbirnie wasn't picked in the T20I squad, and was confirmed to open the batting in ODIs, an ICC report said. "One area we will explore on this tour is the top order in our T20 squad," Ireland selector Andrew White said. "We'll be looking at introducing a new dynamic, with Andrew Balbirnie sitting out the T20Is on this occasion. There are only two T20Is in the upcoming series, but they will offer important opportunities as we try to increase our levels of performance again," he said. Paul Stirling will lead the ODI and T20I squads for the matches against South Africa in UAE. The series marks Ireland's return to limited-overs cricket after their ICC Men's T20 World Cup 2024 campaign.

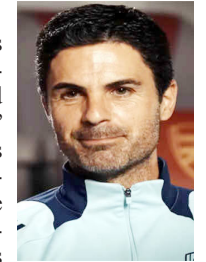
### Axelsen reaches last eight

**HONG KONG:** Denmark's Viktor Axelsen fought off tenacious challenge in the first set to beat Su Li Yang of Chinese Taipei in the second round of the Hong Kong Open badminton championships. Second-seeded Axelsen, playing his first tournament after retaining the Olympic champion in Paris, won 24-22, 21-6 to book a quarterfinal showdown against sixth seed Chou Tien Chen, also of Chinese Taipei. "I did not train enough after the Olympic Games," Axelsen said. "So it is not easy to win two matches in a row. My goal is to find back my form." Defending champion Jonatan Christie of Indonesia defeated Rasmus Gemke of Denmark 21-12, 21-19, and will next play fifth seed Kodai Naraoka, who beat his Japanese compatriot Takuma

Obayashi 19-21, 26-24, 21-11. China's Lei Lanxi dropped the first set but rallied for a 17-21, 21-16, 21-14 victory over Jeon Hyeok-jin of South Korea. He takes on Lee Cheuk Yiu of Hong Kong, China. The other men's quarterfinal will be held between Anthony Sinisuka Ginting of Indonesia and Jason Gunawan of Hong Kong, China. On the women's side, three-time champion and top seed Tai Tzu Ying of Chinese Taipei withdrew due to injury when she led 6-2 over Putri Kusuma Wardani of Indonesia. Third seed Han Yue of China beat Liang Ting Yu of Chinese Taipei 21-14, 21-13. She will next play fifth seed Aya Ohori of Japan, who fought back from one set down to see off Saloni Samirbhai Mehta of Hong Kong, China, 9-21, 21-16, 21-12.

### Arteta extends contract

**LONDON:** Arsenal coach Mikel Arteta has signed a contract extension, the club said in a statement. Arteta has signed what Arsenal described as a "long-term" contract but it is thought to be until the end of June 2027. His previous contract was due to expire at the end of June 2025. The 42-year-old former player, who spent five years at the club between 2011 and 2016, returned to Arsenal in 2019 after leaving his previous post as assistant to Pep Guardiola at Manchester City. Following a slow start, with two eighth-place finishes in the Premier League and fifth place in 2022, he has now cemented Arsenal as the main title challengers to City, with second-place finishes in the last two seasons and with last season's title race only decided on the last day of the campaign. "I feel extremely proud, very excited and am looking forward to what is coming next. I'm proud to be where I am and have the relationships that I have with everyone at the club," Arteta said on the club website on Thursday.
