RINKU'S HALF-CENTURY GOES IN VAIN AS EAST RECORDS EASY SIX-WICKET WIN VS CENTRAL

PUDUCHERRY: Bengal bowlers Akash Deep and Shahbaz Ahmed kept a tight leash on Central Zone with three wickets apiece as East Zone catered to a six-wicket victory in a round robin league game of the Dardar Trophy here on Monday. Left-arm spinner Shahbaz (3/30 in 10 overs) and pacer Akash (3/15 in 10 overs) were both parsimonious while getting breakthroughs at regular intervals to bowl out Central for 207 in 50 overs. Only Rinku Singh, who recently earned his maiden call-up to national team for Asian Games, looked in good nick, scoring 54 off 63 balls on a track that wasn't conducive for stroke-play.

In reply, East were never in a tearing hurry as they exacted a sweet revenge for their Duleep Trophy loss, by surpassing the target in 46.1 overs.

Left-handed opener Utkarsh Singh anchored the chase with a well-completed 89 off 104 balls and a 91-run opening stand with the experienced Abhimanyu Easwarar (38 off 55 balls) put them on course for victory. With literally no scoreboard pressure, East batters didn't take much risk even though Utkarsh had 11 fours and three sixes to his credit. But it was the bowlers, who set it up nicely on a track where the ball occasionally stopped while coming or to the bat.

India set West Indies target of 365 runs to win, WI lose two quick wickets (Day 4, Stumps)



PORT OF SPAIN: India set a massive total of 365 runs for West Indies to win the ongoing second Test and Windies lost two wickets in the final session of day four in Port of Spain on Monday.

At the end of the day's play, WI was at 76/2, with Tagenarine Chanderpaul (24*) and Jermaine Blackwood (20*) India started the final session at 118/2, with Shubman Gill (10*) and Ishan Kishan (5*) unbeaten.

In the final session, Kishan and Gill started attacking the Windies bowling line-up with some healthy strike rotation and big blows.

Kishan was the more aggressive of two batters, helping India reach the 150-run mark in 21.1 overs. The duo brought up their fifty-run stand.

Kishan smashed Kumar Roach for two successive sixes in the 24th over, bringing up his maiden half-century in Tests in just 33 balls. India declared their innings at 181/2, with Kishan (52*) and Gill (29*) unbeaten. India had a 364-run lead over the Windies, thus setting a 365-run target for the hosts.

In the chase, WI openers Tagenarine Chanderpaul and skipper Kraigg Brathwaite were cautious.

In their first ten overs, WI could score only 24 runs.

Havichandran Ashwin's spin helped India make inroads into the Windies batting line-up. He first dismissed Brathwaite for 28 after the latter mistimed a sweep shot and was caught by Jaydev Unadkat. Then two overs later, he trapped Kirk McKenzie lbw for a four-ball duck. WI was reduced to 44/2.

WI reached the 50-run mark in 22 overs.

Jermaine Blackwood came to the crease and he carried the chase forward with Chanderpaul. The duo took WI through the remainder of the session without any loss of wicket.

Earlier, rain continued to interrupt play and India ended the second session on the day four of the ongoing second Test against West Indies with a healthy lead on Sunday.

At the end of the second session, India was at 118/2, with Shubman Gill (10*) and Ishan Kishan (5*) unbeaten. India has a 301-run lead over the Windies.

India started the second session at 98/1, with Yashasvi Jaiswal (37*) and Gill (0*) unbeaten.

Jamal Warican struck early for the Windies, sending back a well-set Jaiswal for a quick 38 off 20 balls after the batter mistimed a slog sweep that went straight into the hands of the wicketkeeper Joshua de Silva. India was 102/2 at that point.

Wicketkeeper-batter Ishan Kishan came to bat at number four. Kishan and Gill added a few more runs to India's total before rain interrupted the action again and ended the session prematurely.

Earlier, Muhammad Siraj's five-wicket haul followed by Indian openers Rohit Sharma and Yashasvi Jaiswal's fiery batting, helped India dominate the first session of Day two in the second test match against West Indies in Trinidad. At lunch, India was 98/1, taking a lead of 281 runs. Yashasvi 37* and Shubman Gill 0* were at the crease. Rohit Sharma scored an explosive fifty in 35 balls. Resuming fourth day from 229/5, West Indies batters lost wickets in quick succession.

Mukesh Kumar took the first wicket of the day wicket, dismissing Alark Athanaze at 37. WI was 22/0.

Siraj picked the next wicket of Jason Holder at 13. He bowled an outswinger which got an edge of Holder carrying it to the wicket-keeper Kishan. WI was 23/37.

In the next over, Siraj again got the wicket. This time Alzarri Joseph was dismissed cheaply at 4. West Indies were 24/48.

With his outstanding bowling, Siraj completed his five-wicket haul, dismissing the remaining two batters Kumar Roach at 4 and Shannon Gabriel on a golden duck in consecutive balls.

West Indies managed to score 255 runs in their first innings and were trailing by 183 runs.

Indian openers Rohit Sharma and Yashasvi Jaiswal started with the same fantastic form as they were in the first innings.

They provided India with 50 runs at a fast pace in 5.3 overs, recording the latest team fifty in Test cricket. Indian batters were batting at a run rate of almost 9 an over.

Rohit brought his fifty in just 35 balls with a boundary to Gabriel's bowling. Rohit's explosive knock came to an end when Gabriel bowled a short ball and Rohit failed to smash a pull shot as he found Joseph in fine leg. He scored 57 in 44 balls with five fours and three sixes.

Rain intervened in the game when India were 58/1.

Sindhu Prannoy keen to regain lost touch, buoyant Satwik-Chirag eyeing another title



TOKYO: Fresh from their Korea Open triumph, Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty will look to continue their dream run, even as the focus will be on the struggling PV Sindhu and HS Prannoy in the Japan Open Super 750 badminton tournament, beginning here on Tuesday.

The 2022 Commonwealth Games-winning Indian doubles pair of Satwik-Chirag on Sunday stunned world No. 1 pair of Fajar Alfian and Muhammad Rian Ardianto in a hard-fought final to extend their winning streak to 10 matches.

They have been in the form of their career, winning the Swiss Open, Asian Championships and Indonesia Open this year as the third-seeded Indians face Leo Holly Carnando-Daniel Marthin of Indonesia in the opening round.

Exactly a year before the Paris Olympics, the biggest talking point in the Indian badminton circuit has been that of the wobbly form of Sindhu.

The two-time Olympic medalist and former world champion has been a shadow of her past post her injury rehab and has dropped to world No. 17 following her first round exits in six of the 12 BWF World Tour events this year. The latest was in Korean Open last week where she lost to lower-ranked Pai Yu-Po under the guidance of her high-profile new coach Muhammad Hafiz Hashim, the 2003 All-England champion.

Sindhu has been error-prone and struggling to finish points even against lower-rung players. She will have to work on her fast, attacking game to up the ante against her rivals.

This time, Sindhu's opening round hurdle will be Zhang Yi Man, against whom the Indian won in the Malaysian Open quarters, en route to her semi-final job in May this year. With the lat-

est win, Sindhu has a 2-2 win-loss record against the 20th ranked Chinese, and she would look to make up the lost ground.

But should Sindhu overcome the first round hurdle, she is likely to be up against her nemesis Tai Tzu Ying who has beaten the Indian nine times in a row in recent past in her 19.5 win-loss record.

Prannoy, who won his maiden BWF World Tour title at the Malaysia Masters in May, remained India's top-ranked player but dropped two spots to 10th.

Prannoy, who lost in the second round at the Korea Open last week, is seeded eighth and pitted against unseeded Li Shi Feng of China. Kidambi Srikanth is up against Chou Tien Chen of Chinese Taipei. If they overcome their respective opening round hurdles, Prannoy and Srikanth will clash in the quarterfinals where either of them may face the toughest test, up against top-seeded Viktor Axelsen.

The tournament will also mark the return of ace youngster Lakshya Sen, who took a break and skipped Korea Open after winning the Canada Open earlier this month. Promising youngster Priyanshu Rajawat and Sen are up against each other in an all-Indian opening round clash.

Should Sen get past Rajawat, he may face a tough test in second-seeded Anthony Sinisuka Ginting of Indonesia in the next round.

Malavika Bhanot is pitted against local challenger Aya Ohori, while Aakarshi Kashyap will face top-seeded Akone Yamaguchi in the women's singles opening round. Among other Indians in the fray, M B Arjun and Dhruv Kapila will square up against fourth-seeded Aaron Chia and Soh Wooi Yik of Malaysia in the men's doubles.

Germany players commit some of their Women's World Cup bonuses to grassroots programs



SYDNEY: Money has been a big talking point at this Women's World Cup, from the lack of federation support for some teams and players, to the smaller prize pool FIFA is offering compared with the men's World Cup in 2022, to the players not being paid their World Cup bonuses directly.

Ahead of its opening match Monday versus Morocco in Melbourne, two-time World Cup champion Germany tried to spread some good news about finances in the women's game.

The national team players announced they will donate a percentage of their World Cup bonuses to grassroots girls soccer organizations in Germany.

"It was important for us that if we donate to these projects, that the money actually reaches the grassroots, that was our key aspect," midfielder Svenja Huth said.

The Germany players are partnering with Common Goal to contribute to inclusive girls' and non-binary soccer programs.

"One of the hallmarks of our team (is) that we are aware of social shortages," Huth said. "We want gender equality for everybody."

They will donate 1% of their World Cup bonuses to Football Girls and Girl Power, as they try to help boost their country's investment in opportunities for

girls of all cultural and social backgrounds.

If the Germans win the title, the donation would be USD 62,100 - as each of the 23 players would receive USD 270,000 in prize money. At a minimum, they will donate USD 6,900, or 1% of the USD 20,000 they each will get for playing in the group stage.

Germany is No. 2 in the world rankings behind the United States of America and has been a perennial power on the pitch.

Women's soccer is gaining ground in Germany. Average attendance for Germany's top women's league, Bundesliga Frauen, has grown by 190% in the last five years according to Eurosport, from less than 900 in 2017 to almost 2,500 in 2022.

Twenty players on the World Cup roster play in the Bundesliga Frauen.

The announcement came against the backdrop of FIFA President Gianni Infantino saying that he couldn't guarantee players' World Cup bonuses would go directly to the players, because the funds had to go to national federations to be paid out to individuals. The German players now have something more to play for at the Women's World Cup, with every round the team advances leading to more money for the cause back home.

"Bringing young girls into the game," goalkeeper Merle Frohms said of the team's goals.

Novak Djokovic pulls out of Canadian Open due to fatigue

MONTREAL: Novak Djokovic has withdrawn from the National Bank Open due to fatigue, tournament organisers announced on Sunday.

The Serbian has won the Canadian Open title on four previous occasions, in 2007, 2011 and 2012. The last time he competed in the tournament was in 2015. "I have always enjoyed my time in Canada but after speaking with my team, we believe this is the right decision to take," Djokovic said in a press release as stated by ATP.

He thanked the tournament director, Karl Hale, for understanding his choice and indicated a desire to return to the ATP Masters 1000 event in the future. "I would like to thank Karl Hale, the Tournament Director, for understanding this decision. I really hope I can return to Canada and Toronto in the coming years to play in front of great fans there," the World No. 2 added.

Djokovic last competed at Wimbledon, where he lost in a thrilling match to Carlos Alcaraz in 2023. The 36-year-old is 33-5 and has titles from the Australian Open, French Open, and Adelaide. Karl Hale voiced his disappointment.
