Rajasthan: Five employees affected as gas leaks at Rawatbhata Heavy Water Plant

JAIPUR : A hydrogen sulfide (H₂S) gas leak at the Rawatbhata Heavy Water Plant on Saturday left five employees affected, including one departmental employee and four contract workers.

Of them, two have been referred to Kota for advanced medical treatment, while three are receiving care at the Nuclear Power Plant Hospital.

According to General Manager P. Satish, the incident occurred while employees were working in the field. All affected workers were immediately shifted to the hospital.

Contract worker Dharmendra Lohar, son of Mohan Lohar from Bhainsrodgarh, is reported to be in critical condition and has been referred to Kota Hospital. Upon learning of the incident, DSP Kamal Prasad



Meena, Tehsildar Vivek Garasiya, Police Station Officer Raisal Singh, and other officials reached the site.

Authorities confirmed that the situation is now under control, though the exact

cause of the gas leak is still under investigation. SDM Kriti Vyas stated, "I spoke with the General

Manager, who informed me that two people were injured and are undergoing treatment." Meanwhile, a soldier posted at Tower No. 11 reportedly suffered eye irritation and swelling due to exposure. Hydrogen sulfide is a highly toxic and flammable gas. Even at low concentrations, it can cause eye irritation, respiratory distress, nausea, and vomiting. Prolonged or high-level exposure can lead to unconsciousness or death.

Following the incident, the local residents and plant employees have demanded a thorough investigation and accountability for those responsible. As of now, no official statement has been issued by the plant administration or district authorities.

Further investigations were in progress till the time of filing of this report.

Karnataka: Lover arrested for forcing girl to convert to Islam for marriage

BENGALURU : Karnataka Police on Saturday arrested a man for allegedly forcing a girl to convert to Islam in order to marry her.

The accused, Mohammad Ishaq, has been arrested in Amrutalli police station limits in Bengaluru.

The case came to light after the victim filed a complaint against her lover and his family, alleging that they were pressuring her to convert to Islam for marriage. The complaint was registered at HSR Layout police station in Bengaluru on Thursday.

According to police, the victim and Mohammad Ishaq were introduced via Instagram on October 17, 2024. After some interaction, they began a relationship. On October 30, 2024, they met at a mall in the Thanisandra locality of Bengaluru, where the accused allegedly promised to speak to her parents and marry her.

Later that day, he booked a room in Dasarahalli and reportedly sexually exploited her. The victim claimed that he repeatedly abused her physically under the pretext of marriage. Over time, she became suspicious of his behaviour and discovered that he had multiple affairs with other girls. When she insisted on marriage, he allegedly kept postponing it with excuses. It was further revealed that the accused had gotten engaged to a Muslim girl on September 14, 2025. When confronted about this, he allegedly threatened the victim, warn-



ing that she would be killed if she contacted him again, and told her to move on. The victim also stated that she was verbally abused in vulgar language.

Police said the victim attempted suicide, after which Mohammad Ishaq's family contacted her family, suggesting that the matter could be resolved amicably. However, Ishaq's elder brother and brother-in-law reportedly told the girl that she must convert to Islam if she wanted to marry him. They allegedly instructed her to learn to perform namaz (prayers) within 40 days and stated that marriage discussions would only proceed after her conversion. The case has taken a controversial turn, with Hindu organizations approaching the victim's family, claiming it as a case of "love jihad" and demanding justice. The police are treating the matter seriously and continue to investigate. It may be recalled that the BJP has alleged that

cases of "love jihad" are on the rise in Karnataka due to the appeasement policies of the Congress-led government. Former minister and BJP MLC C.T. Ravi had urged Chief Minister Siddaramaiah to form a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to comprehensively investigate all cases of love jihad, land jihad, and vote jihad. BJP State President and MLA B.Y. Vijayendra also stated that love jihad cases are increasing in the state, which he claimed is following a "Kerala model" due to the minority appeasement politics of Siddaramaiah. "Those who commit crimes against women and other anti-social activities believe that the state government will support them because it hesitates to arrest accused individuals, even in cases such as raising 'Pakistan Zindabad' slogans at Vidhana Soudha. This policy is destabilizing law and order and creating fear among Hindu families and women," Vijayendra said.



Kumaraswamy criticises K'taka govt, says RSS row is to hide failures

BENGALURU : Union Minister for Heavy Industries and Steel H.D. Kumaraswamy on Saturday sharply criticised the Congress-led Karnataka government, stating that the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) issue is being highlighted by the state government to cover its own failures.

Speaking to the media in Bengaluru, he said that the RSS cannot be banned, and questioned why the government constantly talks about the organisation. "What have they achieved? Why waste time discussing RSS?" he asked.

Referring to past controversies, Kumaraswamy noted that the government delayed action on the Dharmasthala SIT case. "Now, Mahesh Shetty (activist against temple authorities) has received relief in one case. During this government, nothing reaches a logical conclusion. They waste time and mislead people," he said. He emphasized that instead of focusing on the RSS, the government should prioritize development and resolving the state's pressing issues. Mere criticism is of no use, he added. Responding to a question on Yathindra Siddaramaiah projecting



he have the eligibility to hold an open debate? I never engaged in corruption like him. Before talking about me, understand my work as CM, my departments, and my initiatives. I have taken steps such as introducing 4,500 electric buses in Bengaluru and other development projects across the state," he said. Kumaraswamy also questioned the claims of past ministers regarding industrial development in Bengaluru, implying that many projects were mismanaged or swallowed by private interests. Reacting to Siddaramaiah's remark that he would not ask PM Narendra Modi for funds, Kumaraswamy said, "Why should I ask for funds? People gave 136 seats for the Congress. When floods came, I built 1,000 houses in Kodagu without waiting for central aid. They lack such capability and initiative," he said. Among those present at the press meet were Legislative Party Leader Suresh Babu, former Minister Venkatarao Nadagouda, Legislative Council members T.A. Sharavan, S.L. Bhojogowda, Javarayigowda, Vivekananda, JD(S) Bengaluru City unit President and former MLA H.M. Ramesh Gowda, and Choudareddy Thoopalli.

Satish Jarkiholi as the next Chief Minister, Kumaraswamy said: "Anyone can become CM in this country under the Constitution drafted by Ambedkar. It's the party's decision to choose the CM. No one is inevitable. What I think doesn't matter."

He further criticized the state government for neglecting farmers' issues. "I don't know if reports were submitted to the central government. Banning RSS is not the priority. First, solve people's problems," he said.

When asked about Dy CM D.K. Shivakumar's challenge to him to bring industries to

the state and he would ensure land acquisitions, Kumaraswamy reminded that during his tenure as CM, he initiated numerous reforms. He highlighted the "Compete with China" plan, industrial clusters, employment schemes, and proposed Rs 25,000 crore subsidies for the industrial sector - initiatives that were scrapped by the current government. "They lacked the capability to continue these projects," he said. On the challenge for an open discussion from Shivakumar, Kumaraswamy retorted that Shivakumar lacks the competence. "Does

Kerala BJP says state now aligns with National Education Policy

COZHIOKE : Former state unit BJP president K. Surendran on Saturday said that Kerala has finally adopted the correct stance on the National Education Policy (NEP), a position the BJP has long advocated. Surendran noted that both the state government and a few Congress-ruled states have acknowledged that the BJP's position was right, even as implementation lagged over the past four years. He criticised the delay in rolling out NEP initiatives, pointing out that hundreds of thousands of students missed the benefits of the policy's modern educational programs. Surendran urged the government to implement the NEP this academic year itself without further delays, stressing that children should not be inconvenienced.

He added that the Left Front, by creating unnecessary controversies, had misled the public and is largely responsible for the current debates surrounding education reforms. Welcoming the Education Minister's admission that there was no flaw in the NEP and that he had revised his earlier stance, Surendran called for an apology to the public for the prolonged inaction. He described the CPI(M)'s claim that the PM-SHRI program is merely a tool to "earn cash" and that policies would not be implemented as "laughable," emphasizing that directives from the Central Government would be implemented in Kerala as in other states. Surendran further highlighted that curriculum reform falls under concurrent subjects, allowing both the Centre and the state to intervene. He said that Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led government would correct the historical narratives neglected by Congress, encouraging students to learn about figures such as Veer Savarkar, Dr. Hedgewar, and Pandit Deendayal Upadhyaya. He also took pot shots at the CPI, noting that "the CPI may bark, but it won't bite," Surendran.

One killed, three injured in Bengaluru blast; Union Minister seeks probe

BENGALURU : One person was killed and three others from the same family were injured in an explosion in Bengaluru on Saturday. The impact of the blast was so severe that the house sustained significant damage.

The explosion has been reported from Triveninagar in the K.R. Puram locality.

Union Minister Shobha Karandlaje visited and inspected the spot. She has also demanded a comprehensive probe into the incident. The deceased has been identified as 80-year-old Akkayamma. Besides, 25-year-old Kiran, 52-year-old Shekar, and 22-year-old Chandana are the injured persons. Chandana has suffered more than 50 per cent burn injuries.

East Division Joint Commissioner of Police Ramesh Banoth also visited the spot and gathered information from the officials.

He said: "The incident occurred at around 7.30 a.m. An elderly woman, who was sleeping, died after the roof slab collapsed on her. Three others have sustained injuries.

"A woman living in the house behind was also injured. Shekhar's daughter too was hurt. We obtained information from them. They said the explosion occurred when the gas stove was turned on. Chandana has sustained serious injuries. The house where the incident occurred has been completely damaged. Three shed houses behind the main house have also suffered damage. A woman residing in one of those sheds has also been injured. "At first glance, it appears to be a cylinder blast. A clear picture will emerge after expert examination." Local resident Rajalakshmi stated: "Between 7 and 7.10 a.m., we heard a very loud sound. Since it was Diwali, we thought someone might be bursting crackers. When we came out, we saw that the entire house was damaged.

"The injured were immediately taken to the hospital with the help of neighbours. Window panes of nearby houses were shattered. Four people were living in the same house. A woman living in the house behind was also injured. The sound was heard up to four to five kilometres away."

Shekhar's relative Sindhu stated: "My brother-in-law, his children, and their mother were in the house. In the morning, we received a call informing us about the incident. All of them have suffered injuries." Union Minister Shobha Karandlaje has demanded a thorough investigation into the large-scale explosion that occurred in Triveninagar of the K.R. Puram Assembly constituency in Bengaluru city. Speaking to the media after inspecting the explosion site, she said that an explosion occurred this morning in Triveninagar, resulting in the death of a woman and causing severe damage to the entire house. Expressing concern, she said that a detailed forensic report must be obtained to bring out the truth. "Incidents like this create fear among the public," she added.

"There must be a reason behind the collapse of such a

large and sturdy house. An investigation should determine whether the explosion was caused by a gas leak or by some other explosive material," the Union Minister emphasised. She urged the government to immediately provide compensation to the deceased's family and ensure free medical treatment for the injured. She noted that nearby houses were also affected by the blast and that some neighbours have been hospitalized. "Glass panes have shattered up to a considerable height," she remarked with concern. She appreciated the efforts of police officers, fire personnel, and local residents who rushed to help.

The Minister also appealed to the government to compensate those whose houses were damaged due to the incident. She mentioned that the cylinder involved reportedly belonged to Bharat Petroleum and urged the company to conduct its own investigation as well. Former Minister and BJP MLA Byrathi Basavaraj, representing the K.R. Puram Assembly constituency, said he was shocked after visiting the site of the massive explosion that occurred in Triveninagar in Bengaluru.

According to preliminary investigations, the building is owned by a person named Ramesh. Shekhar was residing in the house. Shekhar's family had moved into the house on rent about nine months ago. He was living there with his two children, Chandana and Kiran Kumar, and the elderly woman Akkayamma.

Rajasthan: Five employees affected as gas leaks at Rawatbhata Heavy Water Plant

JAIPUR : A hydrogen sulfide (H₂S) gas leak at the Rawatbhata Heavy Water Plant on Saturday left five employees affected, including one departmental employee and four contract workers.

Of them, two have been referred to Kota for advanced medical treatment, while three are receiving care at the Nuclear Power Plant Hospital.

According to General Manager P. Satish, the incident occurred while employees were working in the field. All affected workers were immediately shifted to the hospital.

Contract worker Dharmendra Lohar, son of Mohan Lohar from Bhainsrodgarh, is reported to be in critical condition and has been referred to Kota Hospital. Upon learning of the incident, DSP Kamal Prasad



Meena, Tehsildar Vivek Garasiya, Police Station Officer Raisal Singh, and other officials reached the site.

Authorities confirmed that the situation is now under control, though the exact

cause of the gas leak is still under investigation. SDM Kriti Vyas stated, "I spoke with the General

Manager, who informed me that two people were injured and are undergoing treatment." Meanwhile, a soldier posted at Tower No. 11 reportedly suffered eye irritation and swelling due to exposure. Hydrogen sulfide is a highly toxic and flammable gas. Even at low concentrations, it can cause eye irritation, respiratory distress, nausea, and vomiting. Prolonged or high-level exposure can lead to unconsciousness or death.

Following the incident, the local residents and plant employees have demanded a thorough investigation and accountability for those responsible. As of now, no official statement has been issued by the plant administration or district authorities.

Further investigations were in progress till the time of filing of this report.

Karnataka: Lover arrested for forcing girl to convert to Islam for marriage

BENGALURU : Karnataka Police on Saturday arrested a man for allegedly forcing a girl to convert to Islam in order to marry her.

The accused, Mohammad Ishaq, has been arrested in Amrutalli police station limits in Bengaluru.

The case came to light after the victim filed a complaint against her lover and his family, alleging that they were pressuring her to convert to Islam for marriage. The complaint was registered at HSR Layout police station in Bengaluru on Thursday.

According to police, the victim and Mohammad Ishaq were introduced via Instagram on October 17, 2024. After some interaction, they began a relationship. On October 30, 2024, they met at a mall in the Thanisandra locality of Bengaluru, where the accused allegedly promised to speak to her parents and marry her.

Later that day, he booked a room in Dasarahalli and reportedly sexually exploited her. The victim claimed that he repeatedly abused her physically under the pretext of marriage. Over time, she became suspicious of his behaviour and discovered that he had multiple affairs with other girls. When she insisted on marriage, he allegedly kept postponing it with excuses. It was further revealed that the accused had gotten engaged to a Muslim girl on September 14, 2025. When confronted about this, he allegedly threatened the victim, warn-



ing that she would be killed if she contacted him again, and told her to move on. The victim also stated that she was verbally abused in vulgar language.

Police said the victim attempted suicide, after which Mohammad Ishaq's family contacted her family, suggesting that the matter could be resolved amicably. However, Ishaq's elder brother and brother-in-law reportedly told the girl that she must convert to Islam if she wanted to marry him. They allegedly instructed her to learn to perform namaz (prayers) within 40 days and stated that marriage discussions would only proceed after her conversion. The case has taken a controversial turn, with Hindu organizations approaching the victim's family, claiming it as a case of "love jihad" and demanding justice. The police are treating the matter seriously and continue to investigate. It may be recalled that the BJP has alleged that

cases of "love jihad" are on the rise in Karnataka due to the appeasement policies of the Congress-led government. Former minister and BJP MLC C.T. Ravi had urged Chief Minister Siddaramaiah to form a Special Investigation Team (SIT) to comprehensively investigate all cases of love jihad, land jihad, and vote jihad. BJP State President and MLA B.Y. Vijayendra also stated that love jihad cases are increasing in the state, which he claimed is following a "Kerala model" due to the minority appeasement politics of Siddaramaiah. "Those who commit crimes against women and other anti-social activities believe that the state government will support them because it hesitates to arrest accused individuals, even in cases such as raising 'Pakistan Zindabad' slogans at Vidhana Soudha. This policy is destabilizing law and order and creating fear among Hindu families and women," Vijayendra said.



Kumaraswamy criticises K'taka govt, says RSS row is to hide failures

BENGALURU : Union Minister for Heavy Industries and Steel H.D. Kumaraswamy on Saturday sharply criticised the Congress-led Karnataka government, stating that the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS) issue is being highlighted by the state government to cover its own failures.

Speaking to the media in Bengaluru, he said that the RSS cannot be banned, and questioned why the government constantly talks about the organisation. "What have they achieved? Why waste time discussing RSS?" he asked.

Referring to past controversies, Kumaraswamy noted that the government delayed action on the Dharmasthala SIT case. "Now, Mahesh Shetty (activist against temple authorities) has received relief in one case. During this government, nothing reaches a logical conclusion. They waste time and mislead people," he said. He emphasized that instead of focusing on the RSS, the government should prioritize development and resolving the state's pressing issues. Mere criticism is of no use, he added. Responding to a question on Yathindra Siddaramaiah projecting



Satish Jarkiholi as the next Chief Minister, Kumaraswamy said: "Anyone can become CM in this country under the Constitution drafted by Ambedkar. It's the party's decision to choose the CM. No one is inevitable. What I think doesn't matter."

He further criticized the state government for neglecting farmers' issues. "I don't know if reports were submitted to the central government. Banning RSS is not the priority. First, solve people's problems," he said.

When asked about Dy CM D.K. Shivakumar's challenge to him to bring industries to

the state and he would ensure land acquisitions, Kumaraswamy reminded that during his tenure as CM, he initiated numerous reforms. He highlighted the "Compete with China" plan, industrial clusters, employment schemes, and proposed Rs 25,000 crore subsidies for the industrial sector - initiatives that were scrapped by the current government. "They lacked the capability to continue these projects," he said. On the challenge for an open discussion from Shivakumar, Kumaraswamy retorted that Shivakumar lacks the competence. "Does

he have the eligibility to hold an open debate? I never engaged in corruption like him. Before talking about me, understand my work as CM, my departments, and my initiatives. I have taken steps such as introducing 4,500 electric buses in Bengaluru and other development projects across the state," he said. Kumaraswamy also questioned the claims of past ministers regarding industrial development in Bengaluru, implying that many projects were mismanaged or swallowed by private interests. Reacting to Siddaramaiah's remark that he would not ask PM Narendra Modi for funds, Kumaraswamy said, "Why should I ask for funds? People gave 136 seats for the Congress. When floods came, I built 1,000 houses in Kodagu without waiting for central aid. They lack such capability and initiative," he said. Among those present at the press meet were Legislative Party Leader Suresh Babu, former Minister Venkatarao Nadagouda, Legislative Council members T.A. Sharavan, S.L. Bhojgowda, Javarayigowda, Vivekananda, JD(S) Bengaluru City unit President and former MLA H.M. Ramesh Gowda, and Choudareddy Thoopalli.

Kerala BJP says state now aligns with National Education Policy

KOZHIKODE : Former state unit BJP president K. Surendran on Saturday said that Kerala has finally adopted the correct stance on the National Education Policy (NEP), a position the BJP has long advocated.

Surendran noted that both the state government and a few Congress-ruled states have acknowledged that the BJP's position was right, even as implementation lagged over the past four years. He criticised the delay in rolling out NEP initiatives, pointing out that hundreds of thousands of students missed the benefits of the policy's modern educational programs. Surendran urged the government to implement the NEP this academic year itself without further.

One killed, three injured in Bengaluru blast; Union Minister seeks probe

BENGALURU : One person was killed and three others from the same family were injured in an explosion in Bengaluru on Saturday. The impact of the blast was so severe that the house sustained significant damage.

The explosion has been reported from Triveninagar in the K.R. Puram locality.

Union Minister Shobha Karandlaje visited and inspected the spot. She has also demanded a comprehensive probe into the incident.

The deceased has been identified as 80-year-old Akkayamma. Besides, 25-year-old Kiran, 52-year-old Shekar, and 22-year-old Chandana are the injured persons. Chandana has suffered more than 50 per cent burn injuries.

East Division Joint Commissioner of Police Ramesh Banoth also visited the spot and gathered information from the officials.

He said: "The incident occurred at around 7.30 a.m. An elderly woman, who was sleeping, died after the roof slab collapsed on her. Three others have sustained injuries.

"A woman living in the house behind was also injured. Shekhar's daughter too was hurt. We obtained information from them. They said the explosion occurred when the gas stove was turned on. The young woman gave this statement. However, an investigation is being carried out to determine the exact cause," he stated.

Whitefield Division DCP Parashuram stated, "Among the injured, a woman named



Chandana has sustained serious injuries. The house where the incident occurred has been completely damaged. Three shed houses behind the main house have also suffered damage. A woman residing in one of those sheds has also been injured. "At first glance, it appears to be a cylinder blast. A clear picture will emerge after expert examination." Local resident Rajalakshmi stated: "Between 7 and 7.10 a.m., we heard a very loud sound. Since it was Diwali, we thought someone might be bursting crackers. When we came out, we saw that the entire house was damaged.

"The injured were immediately taken to the hospital with the help of neighbours. Window panes of nearby houses were shattered. Four people were living in the same house. A woman living in the house behind was also injured. The sound was heard up to four to five kilo-

metres away." Shekhar's relative Sindhu stated: "My brother-in-law, his children, and their mother were in the house. In the morning, we received a call informing us about the incident. All of them have suffered injuries."

Union Minister Shobha Karandlaje has demanded a thorough investigation into the large-scale explosion that occurred in Triveninagar of the K.R. Puram Assembly constituency in Bengaluru city. Speaking to the media after inspecting the explosion site, she said that an explosion occurred this morning in Triveninagar, resulting in the death of a woman and causing severe damage to the entire house. Expressing concern, she said that a detailed forensic report must be obtained to bring out the truth. "Incidents like this create fear among the public," she added.

"There must be a reason behind the collapse of such a

large and sturdy house. An investigation should determine whether the explosion was caused by a gas leak or by some other explosive material," the Union Minister emphasised. She urged the government to immediately provide compensation to the deceased's family and ensure free medical treatment for the injured. She noted that nearby houses were also affected by the blast and that some neighbours have been hospitalized. "Glass panes have shattered up to a considerable height," she remarked with concern. She appreciated the efforts of police officers, fire personnel, and local residents who rushed to help.

The Minister also appealed to the government to compensate those whose houses were damaged due to the incident. She mentioned that the cylinder involved reportedly belonged to Bharat Petroleum and urged the company to conduct its own investigation as well.

Former Minister and BJP MLA Byrathi Basavaraj, representing the K.R. Puram Assembly constituency, said he was shocked after visiting the site of the massive explosion that occurred in Triveninagar in Bengaluru.

According to preliminary investigations, the building is owned by a person named Ramesh. Shekhar was residing in the house. Shekhar's family had moved into the house on rent about nine months ago. He was living there with his two children, Chandana and Kiran Kumar, and the elderly woman Akkayamma.

Delhi riots: Court orders on Minister Kapil Mishra's revision plea likely on Nov 10

NEW DELHI : A Special Court in Delhi has fixed November 10 for issuing orders on city Law and Justice Minister Kapil Mishra's plea seeking a revision of another court's direction to register an FIR against him in connection with the 2020 Delhi riots which claimed 53 lives. Special Judge Dig Vinay Singh, who had earlier put curbs on the lower court's direction for registration of FIR against the Minister, said, "Put up this matter along with connected file for orders on November 10."

During the hearing on Saturday, the Special Court heard the arguments on behalf of Mohammad Ilyas, a resident of Yamuna Vihar, whose complaint against Mishra had resulted in a court ordering filing of an FIR against the Delhi Minister in April.

Soon after the registration of an FIR was ordered against the Delhi Minister, AAP leader and former Delhi Chief Minister Atishi had trained her guns on both the BJP government and the Delhi Police, questioning the delay in action against Mishra.

"The Rouse Avenue Court has ordered an FIR against Kapil Mishra, whose inflammatory speeches in 2020 resulted in the death of 53 people. The entire country witnessed his role in the riots. Why is the Delhi Police not arresting him? Why is Chief Minister Rekha Gupta not removing him from the

Cabinet?" she asked. The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) also stepped up its demand for the resignation of Mishra by protesting in the Delhi Assembly. The earlier court order to book Mishra in the 2020 Delhi riots case was delivered by an Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate on the complaint of Mohammad Ilyas. Ilyas had alleged the involvement of Mishra in the riots and also named Mustafabad MLA and Delhi Assembly's Deputy Speaker Mohan Singh Bisht and former BJP legislator Jagdish Pradhan as those responsible for fuelling the riots. In 2020, Mishra was also accused of making inflammatory remarks in the electronic media, claiming that there were "several mini-Pakistans.

मैक्लुस्कीगंज : छठ पूजा भारत की सबसे प्राचीन और पवित्र लोक परंपराओं में से एक है। यह वह पर्व है जिसमें समाज के हर वर्ग की स्त्रियाँ और पुरुष समान रूप से भाग लेते हैं। पहले यह पूजा पूर्णतः लोक आस्था, सादगी और आत्मनियंत्रण का प्रतीक हुआ करती थी, लेकिन अब इसमें धीरे-धीरे ब्राह्मणवाद का प्रवेश देखा जा रहा है। जिससे लोक आस्था के इस महा पर्व का स्वरूप बदल रहा है। छठ पूजा मूल लोक देवी-देवताओं की आराधना का पर्व रहा है, जिसमें किसी ब्राह्मण या पंडित की आवश्यकता नहीं होती। भक्त सीधे ब्रती महिलाएँ अपने पारंपरिक गीतों के माध्यम से ही संकल्प, आवाहन, पूजन और क्षमा याचन करती हैं। भक्त सीधे सूर्य देव की उपासना करते हैं, यही गीत इस पर्व के मंत्र हैं। लेकिन अब



कई स्थानों पर छठ पूजा में ब्राह्मणों को बुलाया जाने लगा है, पूजा स्थलों पर वैदिक मंत्रोच्चारण और यज्ञ जैसी परंपराएँ जोड़ी जा रही हैं। यह प्रवृत्ति इस पर्व की मौलिक लोक परंपरा को धीरे-धीरे बदल रही है। छठ पूजा के गीतों में वह केवल भवनाओं का प्रकटीकरण

धार्मिक ग्रंथ से कहीं अधिक सजीव और प्रभावशाली है। जैसे केलावा जे फरेला घवद से ओ पिया... या उग हो सुरुज देव भइल अरघ के बेर... जैसे गीतों में भक्ति, प्रकृति और कृतज्ञता का अद्भुत संगम दिखाई देता है। ये गीत न केवल भवनाओं का प्रकटीकरण

हैं, बल्कि यही इस पूजा की आध्यात्मिक साधना हैं। छठ पूजा में सूर्य की उपासना के माध्यम से प्रकृति के तत्वों — जल, वायु, प्रकाश और अन्न — का सम्मान किया जाता है। वैज्ञानिक दृष्टि से सूर्य की किरणों शरीर में विटामिन डी का निर्माण

करती हैं और जल में खड़े होकर सूर्य अर्घ्य देना एक प्रकार की प्राकृतिक चिकित्सा है। यह पर्व मनुष्य और प्रकृति के बीच संतुलन की भावना जगाता है, जो आज के युग की सबसे बड़ी आवश्यकता है। इस पूजा में न तो आडंबर की आवश्यकता है, न कर्मकांड की। यह लोक की स्त्रियों का, मातृत्व का और प्रकृति के प्रति आभार व्यक्त करने का पर्व है। छठ की सबसे बड़ी विशेषता यही है कि यहाँ आस्था ही प्रधान है — न जाति, न धर्म, न पंडिताई। छठ पूजा किसी धर्म विशेष का अनुष्ठान नहीं, बल्कि भारत की संपूर्ण संस्कृति और सभ्यता की पहचान है। यह वह पर्व है जहाँ गीत ही मंत्र हैं, सादगी ही भक्ति है, और आस्था ही पूजा है। ब्राह्मणवाद का बढ़ता प्रभाव इस लोक पर्व को आत्मा को कमजोर कर सकता है।

छठ पूजा को लेकर खलारी के बाजारों में रौनक मंहगाई ने बढ़ाई चिंता

खलारी : लोक आस्था के महापर्व छठ पूजा को लेकर खलारी सहित आसपास के क्षेत्रों के बाजारों में रौनक लौट आई है। शुक्रवार को नहाय-खाय के साथ ही ब्रतियों द्वारा पूजा-सामग्री की खरीदारी शुरू होते ही बाजारों में भीड़ उमड़ पड़ी। सुप-दौरा, कलश, फल-फूल, बांस की टोकरी, कपड़ा, दिया, ढक्कन, फूल-माला से लेकर राशन-सामग्री की दुकानों पर ग्राहकों की आवाजाही दिनभर बनी रही। हर ओर श्रद्धा और उत्साह का वातावरण नजर आ रहा है। हालांकि बढ़ती मंहगाई ने लोगों की जेब पर अरस डाला है। परंतु आस्था के आगे मंहगाई भी बेअसर साबित हो रही है। घर-घर में पूजा की तैयारियां जोरों पर हैं और बाजारों में छठ गीतों की गुंज माहौल को और अधिक भक्ति-मय बना रही है। बांस के सुप और दौरा की कीमतें 150 से 250 रुपये तक पहुंच गई हैं, जो पिछले वर्ष 100 से 150 रुपये तक थीं। नारियल 35 से बढ़कर 50 रुपये, केला 60 से बढ़कर 100 रुपये दर्जन तक बिक रहा है। गुड़ और चावल में भी 10 से 15 रुपये प्रति किलो तक की बढ़ोतरी दर्ज की गई है। ब्रतियों का कहना है कि मंहगाई जरूर बढ़ी है, लेकिन छठ मइया का पर्व भावनाओं से जुड़ा है। जो भी करना है, श्रद्धा से ही करना है। परिवार की सुख-समृद्धि और संतान की मंगलकामना के लिए वे किसी भी कीमत पर सामग्रियों की खरीदारी करने से पीछे नहीं हट रही हैं। महिलाएं पूरे जोश और समर्पण के साथ तैयारियों में जुटी हैं। यह पर्व केवल पूजा नहीं बल्कि लोकसंस्कृति का जीवंत प्रतीक बन चुका है, जिसमें हर वर्ग अपनी भूमिका निभा रहा है।
