

Apologise for 'false claim' on Nehru and RSS, Sudhakaran tells governor

Replying to an RTI query, defence ministry said records on R-Day parade 1963 not available

SHEDDING its silence over the governor's controversial claim that Jawaharlal Nehru had invited RSS workers to be part of the Republic Day parade in 1963, the state Congress on Tuesday demanded that Arif Mohammed Khan should apologise for "the statement based on false history".

"The governor should not endorse the blatant lie spread by the RSS. It is not fit for a governor to come out with such false claims. The governor who holds top constitutional post should not stoop to such level," state Congress president K Sudhakaran told TNDIE.

When contacted, Leader of Opposition V D Sathesnan chose not to comment on the issue saying he was not aware of what had transpired in 1963.

The governor's claim during Monday's press conference has



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put the spotlight once again on the veracity of RSS claim that it participated in the 1963 Republic Day parade on an invitation by Nehru, who was impressed with the services of the outfit's volunteers during the 1962 Indo-China war. The RSS raises this claim whenever its antecedents are questioned. After a controversy erupted over former president Pranab Mukherjee's visit to its headquarters in 2018, RSS once again recalled its participation in the 1963 Republic Day parade. However, the defence ministry's reply to an RTI filed by a publishing house offers no credence to the claims of the

Singh. The ministry said, "It is informed that records relating to the composition of the Republic Day parade 1963 are not available."

Countering the RTI report, senior RSS leader J Nandakumar told TNDIE that RSS' participation in the parade was a well-documented one and it was published by the newspaper Hindustan at that time. The photographs of the volunteers were also published, he added.

"RTI gives information based on available documents in archives. Even Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose's documents are not available. This proof also

might have been destroyed, though I am not sure about it. The ruling dispensation, during that time, might have chosen not to preserve some inconvenient truths," Nandakumar said.

However, senior Congress leader Veeppa Moily told TNDIE that RSS is instrumental in polarising the country on communal lines and no claims can give them credibility. "Nehru hasn't mentioned such a thing in his autobiography. RSS may have participated, but it wouldn't give them credibility. Maybe at that time, Nehru must have appreciated social work. I am not aware though," he said.

Ramesh Chennithala, senior Congress leader from Kerala, supports the view. "It's an old story. The situation was different in 1963. Today, RSS is hell-bent on dividing the country along communal lines," he said.

CM: Campaign on to malign state's image

FOR the past three years, Kerala has been ranked first in the list of startup-friendly states in the country, Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan has said. He was speaking after inaugurating the Thozhil Sabha at Pinarayi Convention Centre on Tuesday.

QUICK READ Inquiry into leak of DGP's 'top secret' communication

Kochi: The Kerala High Court has directed the state police chief to investigate how Fasalu Rahman, an accused in a gold smuggling case, obtained a 'top secret' communication sent by the former to the Malappuram district police chief. The court issued the order on a petition filed by Malappuram native Fasalu Rahman seeking to quash the detention order passed against him by the joint secretary (COFEPOSS), Central Economic Intelligence Bureau, New Delhi. "Based on the inquiry report, appropriate action should be taken against the police officers who are responsible for not maintaining absolute secrecy of that communication. The state police chief's action-taken report shall be filed before the court on or before November 28," said a division bench comprising Justice Anil K Narendran and Justice P G Ajithkumar.

Central probe agency quizzes Abdullakutty in rape case

Thiruvananthapuram: The CBI on Tuesday quizzed BJP national vice president A P Abdullakutty in connection with the probe of a rape complaint filed by a controversial woman entrepreneur, who is an accused in the sensational social scam. The BJP leader was grilled by the sleuths at the CBI office in Thiruvananthapuram for about three hours, a source said. The questioning started from 9 am and went on till 12 pm, the source added. The woman entrepreneur had alleged that she was raped by Abdullakutty, while he was a Congress legislator, in 2013. She had alleged that the episode took place in a reputed hotel in the capital city.

Ex-SP seeks directive to regulate Bharat Jodo Yatra

Kochi: A former district superintendent of police (SP) on Tuesday approached the Kerala High Court against Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's Bharat Jodo Yatra, saying it was preventing the free flow of traffic and movement of commuters. The petition, filed by K Vijayan of Kollam, sought a directive to the state police chief to regulate the yatra by permitting the participants to occupy only half of the road and leaving the rest for the free movement of the vehicles and the public. The petitioner sent a request to the state police chief to take immediate steps to alleviate the hardships suffered by the public due to the yatra. The petitioner also sought to take necessary steps to realise the entire expenses incurred in every district for the deployment of the police force as part of the yatra.

Lankan Navy arrests eight fishermen for 'poaching'

Pudukkottai: A total of eight fishermen who ventured into the sea from Jagathattam in the district were arrested by the Sri Lankan Navy on Monday night for alleged poaching. According to sources, the fishermen were fishing 23 nautical miles off Jagathattam fish landing centre on Monday night when they were caught. A release by the Sri Lankan Navy said the eight were held for allegedly fishing in foreign waters.

Muslim man donates ₹1.2 cr to Tirumala

A Muslim man from Chennai, an ardent devotee of Lord Venkateswara, donated ₹1.2 crore to the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD) on Tuesday.

Abdul Ghani and his wife Subeena Bhanu handed over the donation to the Executive Officer AV Dharma Reddy in Ranganayakula mandapam. The couple along with his children later visited the hill shrine.

He had donated 106 golden flowers to the temple decades back and the TTD introduced the golden flowers in Astadala Pada Padma Radhama seva. The seva performs in Tirumala temple every Tuesday. He had conducted pooja to a 'lakshmi tree' in SMC area in Tirumala in a traditional way when he was in debts, TTD sources said.

The donation includes 787 lakh worth furniture and utensils for the newly constructed Sri Padmanabhi Rest House and ₹15 lakh towards SV Annaprasadam Trust.

Depressed over cousin's death, bank notice, 19-year-old ends life at home

A 19-YEAR-OLD girl from Sooranad in Kollam district was found dead at her home around 4:30 pm on Tuesday. The deceased, Abhirami, was reportedly depressed following the death of her cousin and a revenue recovery notice served on her father by the Kerala Bank.

A police official said the girl, a second-year student at Sree Ayyappa College, Chengannur, had found it hard to cope with the loss of her cousin Arun, who died of heart attack a few days ago. He was her well-wisher and mentor. To add to her woes, Kerala Bank's officials handed over the recovery

notice on Monday.

Abhirami's father had availed ₹10 lakh as loan from the Kerala Bank's Patharam branch four years ago. He had been working with a company in West Asia for two decades, but lost his job following the pandemic. Subsequently he was forced to default on repayment of the housing loan.

"Despite his financial constraints, he started paying the instalments again, but defaulted again for a few months," said Sheela, the member of ward no 5 of Sooranad panchayat.

"Her cousin used to guide her in her studies. Moreover, he used to motivate her in every important step of hers. His sudden death left her shocked. In addition, the bank notice may have shattered her. She would have found it hard to handle the pressure," said Sooranad SHO Joseph Leone.

"The bank officials arrived on Monday to hand over the notice. None of the family members were present at that time. The neighbours tried to convince the bank officers by saying that the interest would be paid soon. Abhirami was a bright student and such an unkind act by the bank officials was too much for her," said the ward member.

The police official, however, said the bank officials were only performing their duty.

"However, we are looking at every possible angle," said Sooranad SHO.

Former Congress MLA Mohammed Ali no more

FORMER Congress leader and six-time Aluva MLA K Mohammed Ali, 76, passed away in Kochi on Tuesday morning. He had been undergoing treatment for kidney-related ailments at a private hospital in Kochi.

Mohammed Ali had won assembly polls for six consecutive times from Aluva since 1980. He was a member of the All India Congress Committee (AICC) and Kerala Pradesh Congress Committee (KPCC) executive for several years. However, he had not been active in mainstream politics after he lost the 2006 election. He had served as a member of Cochin University of Science and Technology Syndicate and MG University Senate.

Son of A Kochunny and Nabesha of Patturamadam, Chithira Lane, Aluva, Mohammed Ali entered politics through Congress' students wing Kerala Students Union (KSU). He served as the president of KSU Ernakulam district in 1986 and Youth Congress in 1968.

In the 2021 assembly polls, Mohammed Ali's daughter-in-law Sheela Nishad contested as LDF candidate in the Aluva constituency against UDF candidate and sitting MLA Anwar Sadat, drawing criticism from Congress circles. Mohammed Ali, a known loyalist of AK Antony and Ommen Chandy, stayed away from the UDF campaign during the election. However, he did not come out openly against the party. He is survived by wife P M Naseem Beevi and two sons.
