

# CM lays stress on women empowerment

PANIPAT, AUGUST 19 Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar here today participated in the Hariyali Teej programme and honoured 101 women achievers in various fields on the occasion.

The festival was celebrated at a state-level function at Guru Teg Bahadur/HUDA ground here, in which over 50,000 women from across the state participated, setting a world record, which would be entered in the Limca Book of Records. This is the second such big event after "Panipat Pinkathon" which was organised on International Women's Day on March 8, 2019, and was recorded in the World Book of Records.

With the aim to empowering women through economic avenues and financial security, Khattar announced the setting up of 50-100 portable cabins at the district headquarters. The cabins would operate as "Sanjha Bazar" exclusively featuring

products meticulously crafted by self-help groups (SHGs). The aim is to furnish these groups with a platform to exhibit and sell their creations to a wider audience.

Khattar announced to increase the amount under the Mukhyamantri Vivah Shagun Yojna to Rs 41,000 from Rs

31,000 and for similar schemes. He also announced that the government and private polytechnic colleges with under-utilised infrastructure would be upgraded into women degree colleges based on demands and requirements received from such colleges.

Khattar said like Sudama,

he had brought a 'kothli' (a traditional gift), for his sisters and urged them to accept it as a token of his blessing. He emphasised the pivotal role of mothers, sisters and daughters in making festivals whole, expressing his commitment to their well-being and peace.

He said the state was earlier known for its poor gender ratio, which was earlier 871 girls against 1000 boys. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had launched the Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) mission from the same ground on December 22, 2015. The state government with the support of society worked to erase the stigma linked with gender-based atrocities and now the gender ratio has risen to 927 girls per 1000 boys.

He applauded the schemes launched by the state government to boost the financial aids to the SHGs. "Their contributions to national pride and community welfare are also evident through their creation of Tricolour for the Amrit Mahotsav," he added.

## Farmer welfare schemes on anvil

Calling farmers the backbone of Indian economy, Haryana Chief Minister Manohar Lal Khattar said his government is focused on rolling out welfare schemes for them.

Khattar held a special meeting with beneficiaries of Bhavantar Bharpayee Yojana in Gurugram on Saturday as part of the ongoing "CM ki Vishesh Charcha" initiative. Khattar said a substantial amount of Rs 33.26 crore has already been disbursed to over 12,000 farmers engaged in fruit and vegetable cultivation.

The CM said farmers have inspired others to break away from the conventional wheat and paddy cycle by boldly venturing into farming experiments. "To ensure farmers are not forced to sell their produce at lower prices, the state government introduced Bhavantar Bharpayee Yojana," he added. — TNS

# Interpol issues red corner notice against fugitive criminal Himanshu

A red corner notice has been issued by the Interpol against fugitive criminal Himanshu, alias Bhuu, who is wanted in 18 cases of heinous crime like murder, attempt to murder, extortion, criminal intimidation, forgery etc booked in various police stations of Rohtak, Jhajjar and Delhi. The Haryana Police have announced a reward of Rs 1.55 lakh on his arrest.

"Bhuu has been absconding and hiding in some foreign country from where he has been operating his illegal activities. His name is in the list of most wanted criminals of Rohtak, Jhajjar and Delhi police and arrest warrants have also been issued by the Rohtak and Delhi courts against him. A look-out circular has also been issued to locate this fugitive criminal," said Himanshu Garg, Superintendent of



BHUU WANTED IN 18 HEINOUS CRIME CASES

■ SP says runs extortion racket from abroad  
■ Carries reward of ₹1.55L, wanted in 18 cases booked in Rohtak, Jhajjar and Delhi

Police (SP), Rohtak. Garg said Bhuu was still running an extortion racket from abroad and continuously contacting targeted persons in India through WhatsApp messages and calls. He had threatened many people with dire consequences and also got an attack carried out

through his accomplices on them when the latter refused to pay him extortion money, the SP claimed.

"Bhuu is associated with the notorious Neeraj Bawana and Naveen Bali gangs. He fraudulently obtained a passport using a fake name, fake address and forged documents. During the process, he deliberately concealed criminal cases booked against him to get clearance from the authorities concerned for getting passport. He also took the help of two witnesses for false deposition when the passport authorities got his identity particulars verified from the police," he said.

"A total 60 mobile phones, 44 SIM cards, Rs 7 lakh, two motorcycles, 16 live cartridges, 13 boxes of country liquor, foreign currency, ATM cards, passports, bank documents, diary/notebooks and other items were seized during the raids conducted in April and June this year," he added.

## Gurugram waterlogged; Delhi-Jaipur eway worst hit

GURUGRAM, AUGUST 19

Early morning rain led to waterlogging in many parts of Gurugram with the Delhi-Jaipur Expressway being the worst hit. The vehicles got stuck and many people were seen climbing the roof of a car at the Narsinghpur cut.

Visuals went viral on social media which showed commuters stuck on inundated roads and pedestrians wading through knee-deep water. Due to the weekend, there were no reports of major traffic congestions, though the vehicular movement was slow on the highway.

In addition to the usual

spots on arterial roads that get waterlogged, some internal roads were inundated too on Saturday. According to the district administration, the city received 66 mm of rainfall between 5.10

am and 6.30 am. The areas affected included Narsinghpur, Golf Course Road Extension, Pataudi Chowk, Udyog Vihar, AIT Chowk, Sohna Road, Subhash Chowk, Vatika Chowk,

sectors four, nine, 10, 14, 38, 45, 54 and 100 to 104 and Basai Road but no major traffic congestion was reported, the traffic police said.

"The traffic movement was not affected anywhere and traffic personnel are stationed across the city to deal with any situation," Deputy Commissioner of Police (Traffic) Virender Vij said.

Parts of Delhi, Noida and Gurugram received heavy rainfall today after an extended humid spell.

Visuals from Delhi's Dwarka and Badarpur also showed vehicles passing through waterlogged streets. — TNS

As per the letter issued by the department, the sports fund of every child needs to be deposited, while only a few students participate in the games. Besides, in some districts, the department has told the schools to deposit the funds for the past five years, while there had been no games during the Covid period."
