# 'Misconceptions about RSS due to false narratives'

**KOLKATA:** Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh chief Mohan Bhagwat on Sunday said there are some misconceptions about the organisation among a section of people, owing to "misleading campaigns". Speaking at a programme at the Science City auditorium here to mark the centenary celebrations of the RSS, Bhagwat said the Sangh has no enemy, but there were some "whose shops of narrow interest will shut down if the organisation grows".

Sangh to prepare society for the purpose". The RSS has been holding such sessions as part of the centenary celebrations in Kolkata, Delhi, Mumbai and Bengaluru. "The strength

of Hindus is awakening and will certainly happen," he said. Asserting that Bharat's rise is a certainty, Bhagwat said the rise of Hinduism is also imminent and as such the bad people are wor-

ried about it. "That is why propaganda against India and organisations like the Sangh is happening with more tempo," the RSS chief said. He said the RSS will discuss ways to bring to the people the truth so that they are not swayed by such propaganda.

"If everything remains fine in our neighbouring countries, which were part of Bharat earlier, our position will also be fine," he added. "The government will decide its policies on such matters, but at the society-to-society level, wishing well for each other is something we would like to discuss," he said.

## 'Don't buy from a foreign country which can be made at home'

"One should not buy anything from a foreign country which can be made at home," he said, advocating Swadeshi for the interest of the nation. The RSS leader said one should use mother tongue instead of a foreign language. "When you are Bengali-speaking people, write 'Swagatam' instead of 'Welcome' at the entrance

and historical sites. "There are so many places across Bharat which are worthy to be visited," he said, adding, "whether one sees other parts of the world or not, one should see his own country." The RSS chief said one should read the basic tenets of the Constitution, including the Preamble and the fundamental duties of citizens.

## Deaf and mute woman breaks 16-year silence

**MUMBAI:** A deaf and mute woman's complaint about a sexual assault that took place 16 years ago in Mumbai has unmasked a serial predator, revealing a disturbing pattern of abuse and blackmail he perpetrated on several women from the community. The accused was arrested on December 13 after the survivor broke her silence recently following the suicide attempt by one of the women he allegedly sexually harassed.

Disturbed by the suicide attempt, she confided in her friends during a video call about the assault that occurred in 2009. According to the police, the survivor, a resident of the western suburbs, communicated in sign language during a video call with her friends and colleagues, who were part of a WhatsApp group, that she had been drugged and raped when she was a minor.

She also took her husband into confidence, and with the support from Thane Deaf Association president Vaibhav Ghaisi, activist Mohammed Farhan Khan, sign language interpreter Madhu Keni, and a retired officer from the Ali Yavar Jung National Institute of Speech and Hear-

ing Disabilities Divyangjan, the survivor approached the police. ## 'Meat, alcohol banned in 3 holy cities'



The sale of meat, tobacco, alcohol, other intoxicants are now prohibited in Amritsar Walled City, Talwandi Sabo and Sri Anandpur Sahib after a notification was issued by the Punjab government, according to Chief Minister Bhagwant Singh Mann, in a video message on Sunday, said the decision to grant holy city status to the three places revered among Sikhs has now come into effect after a Punjab government notification. Last month a resolution was passed unanimously during a special session of the Punjab Assembly held in Sri Anandpur Sahib, which was convened to mark the 350th martyrdom anniversary of Guru Tegh Bahadur.

## Cyber-fraud racket busted

**BAGHPAT:** An interstate cyber-fraud racket involved in duping people on the pretext of providing bank jobs was busted by police in this Uttar Pradesh district on Sunday with the arrest of seven people, including two women, officials said. Police said the accused were running a fake call centre and luring job seekers from several states by issuing forged appointment letters and fabricated agreements in the name of bank recruitment, collecting large sums of money in return.

Twelve mobile phones, two laptops, two SIM cards on fake names, several forged appointment letters and agreements, 15 bank passbooks, two cheque-books, UPI QR codes, ATM cards and 11 other cards were seized from the possession of the accused, police said, adding that the data of around 6,450 people from different states was found stored in the laptops. According to the officials, the gang misused information obtained from online platforms, such as OLX and job-related websites, to target unsuspecting victims.

The racket was uncovered following complaints received on the Union home ministry's "Pratibimb" portal and subsequent technical surveillance. Investigations revealed at least 20 complaints from various states, including Madhya Pradesh, West Bengal, Maharashtra, Chhattisgarh, Assam and Meghalaya.

# Kerala HC sets aside Sabarimala airport land acquisition process

**KOCHI, DEC 21:** The Kerala High Court has set aside crucial stages of the land acquisition process for the proposed Sabarimala greenfield airport, holding that the state failed to properly assess the minimum land actually required for the project. On December 30, 2022, the state government issued an order granting sanction for the acquisition of 2,570 acres of land, comprising the Cheruvally Estate and an additional 307 acres located outside it. Justice C Jayachandran, delivering the judgment on a writ petition filed by Ayana Charitable Trust (formerly Gospel for Asia) and its managing trustee Dr Siny Punnoose, ruled the decision-making process under the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013, was legally flawed.

The court, in its December 19 order, directed the state to restart the process by conducting a

fresh social impact assessment limited to examining the minimum land requirement, followed by a fresh appraisal by the expert group and reconsideration by the government. The petitioners had challenged several government actions, including the Social Impact Assessment (SIA) report, the expert committee appraisal, the state government order approving the acquisition, and the subsequent notification under Section 11 of the 2013 Act. The land in question, mainly the Cheruvally Estate in Pathanamthitta district, is proposed to be acquired for building a new airport intended to serve Sabarimala pilgrims. The court found that while the state is entitled to acquire land for public purposes, the law clearly mandates that only the "absolute bare minimum" extent of land required for a project can be acquired. According to the court, this mandatory requirement under Sections 4(4)(d), 7(5)(b), and 8(1)(c) of the 2013 Act was not

properly complied with. Justice Jayachandran observed that the authorities had shown "manifest non-application of mind" in assessing how much land was genuinely necessary. As a result, the SIA report, the Expert Committee report and the government order were declared invalid to the extent they failed to address this crucial requirement.

Since the Section 11 notification could only be issued after a valid completion of these steps, it too was quashed. On the petitioners' allegation of fraud on power and colourable exercise of authority, the court did not give a final finding. It held that this issue is closely linked to determining the minimum land required and can only be examined after that exercise is properly completed. Before concluding, the court suggested that for technically complex projects like airports, the state should include technical experts in the SIA team to ensure informed and lawful decision-making.

## 'Resolve shortage': Par Panel after Railways admits crew crisis biggest issue

**NEW DELHI, DEC 21:** The vision of fully electrified dedicated freight corridors with exclusive high-capacity tracks, aimed at significantly boosting freight movement efficiency, could face setbacks if operational bottlenecks, such as crew availability, are not addressed promptly, a parliamentary committee has warned.

The committee's comments came after the Ministry of Railways acknowledged that "the biggest challenge faced by the Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India (DFCCIL) in running trains is the availability of crew." In a submission to the committee, the Ministry provided details regarding the number of employees in various categories involved in train operations on Indian Railways as of June 1, 2025. According to the Ministry, out of a sanctioned strength of 1,42,814 loco pilots, the actual strength stands at 1,07,928.

Similarly, for goods train managers (guards), out of 22,082 sanctioned posts, only 12,345 are currently filled. The total sanctioned strength for all categories, including station masters and station superintendents, is 2,06,495, but the actual number of working employees is

1,59,219. "The committee emphasises that the shortage of crew must be resolved urgently to minimise delays, improve throughput, and ensure uninterrupted freight movement across the DFC network," the report stated. The committee further urged Indian Railways to take effective measures to ensure the availability of adequate crew required for the smooth operation of trains on the DFC network. The Standing Committee on Railways, in its Sixth Report on "Increasing Freight-Related Earnings of Indian Railways and Development of Dedicated Freight Corridors," presented to the Lok Sabha for 2025-26, examined several aspects of freight operations, including challenges and proposed measures for improvement. Freight services contribute around 65 per cent of Indian Railways' total earnings, while the remaining 35 per cent comes from passenger services, parcel services, and non-fare revenue streams, the committee noted.

"It is primarily due to freight income that the Railways can keep passenger fares affordable for the general public," the report added. It also pointed out that structural constraints within rail

logistics, such as the lack of first- and last-mile connectivity, high costs for short-distance freight

movement, and terminal and mobility limitations, hinder the potential for increasing freight revenue.

# Data collected at Kodaikanal observatory helps researchers piece together one of Sun's mysteries

**CHENNAI, DEC 21:** Daily solar observations gathered for years at the century-old Kodaikanal Solar Observatory have led to a breakthrough understanding of how the Sun's magnetic activity varies across its latitudes -- a discovery that could deepen insights into the solar dynamo, impact space-weather forecasting, and even help climate models.

The study, led by researchers from the Indian Institute of Astrophysics (IIA), an autonomous body

under the Department of Science and Technology (DST), analysed 11 years (2015-2025) of spectroscopic data captured in the calcium-K line of sunlight -- a spectral signature that forms high in the Sun's chromosphere and serves as a sensitive marker of magnetic activity. "All the studies on the Sun are ultimately essential to understand the space weather, which has direct consequences on the Earth. So, the more we understand, the better prepared we can be for

possible disruptions to catastrophes," Apoorva Srinivasa, one of the authors of the study, told PTI. The Kodaikanal Solar Observatory, which recently celebrated 125 years of continuous observation, maintains one of the world's longest solar datasets, he added. According to him, the research team used this rich archive to track how the Sun's magnetic intensity changes across latitudes -- revealing consistent zones of heightened activity that correspond with the Sun's well-known 11-year cycle of sunspot peaks.

"The Sun is not a static ball of fire, but a magnetically active star that follows large-scale

cycles of activity," said K P Raju, lead author of the study.

"By slicing the Sun into latitude bands and analysing integrated light from each, we can reveal patterns invisible when studying isolated features like sunspots," added the former professor at IIA. The team found that most magnetic activity clusters between 40 degrees north and south latitude, with pronounced peaks around 15 degrees to 20 degrees, matching zones where sunspots are most frequent. "These spectral variations directly mirror how the Sun's magnetic field evolves," said co-author K Nagaraju. "We verified this correlation using data from

NASA's Solar Dynamics Observatory," added the associate professor at IIA, whose focus area of research is solar magnetism. They also observed hemispheric asymmetries -- with the southern hemisphere generally showing stronger or faster variations in activity -- providing new hints about how the internal magnetic field reorganises itself over each solar cycle. The findings were published in the journal, 'Monthly Notices of the Royal Astronomical Society' and represent a step toward refining solar dynamo models, which explain how magnetic energy is generated and cycles through the Sun's surface layers.
