Decision on chemical level on nets stayed

Litigant says dosage of alphacypermethrin on Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets fixed without any study

THE Madurai Bench of Madras High Court on Thursday stayed a recent decision made by the Central Insecticide Board and Registration Committee (CIB & RC) fixing the dosage of alphacypermethrin on Long Lasting Insecticidal Nets (LLINs), after a PIL was filed alleging that the level was fixed without conducting any study on it.

The litigant, M Solomon Bernard Shaw of Madurai, submitted that the Registration Committee of CIB & RC held a meeting on September 24, 2021, in which an application had been filed before it to fix the alphacypermethrin level on LLINs (mosquito nets coating with insecticides) at 0.58% w/w. Though the committee rightly rejected the application, it however decided on December 23, 2021, to fix the said chemical level at 0.55% w/w without conducting the mandatory three-year study on its impact, he alleged.

Shaw stated that LLINs are widely used to tackle mosquito menace and, considering the prolonged exposure by users, especially by children and infants, pointed out that the dosage of insecticides used in the nets ought to be decided carefully to avoid any health risk. Moreover, the Registration Committee exceeded the jurisdiction granted to it by the Insecticides Act, 1968 as there was no application before it to fix the alphacypermethrin level at 0.55% w/w composition, Shaw added. Citing the risks the decision could cause, he requested the court to set aside the committee's decision. A Bench comprising Justices Pushpa Sathyanarayana and P Velmurugan, ordered an interim stay against the implementation of the decision. It also issued notice to the CIB&RC Secretary and other related central government departments and adjourned the case for a month.

GOVT LAUDED FOR GIVING AID TO KIN OF CRACKER UNIT BLAST VICTIMS

Madurai: The Madurai Bench of Madras High Court appreciated the State government for paying compensation to the family members of 14 people who died in the cracker unit blast in Vrudhunagar in 2020. Justice CV Karthikeyan made the observation recently in a batch of petitions filed by the kin of the 14 victims over the delay in the payment of the compensation. According to one of the petitioners, M Sivalasubramanyam of Tenkasi, the blast took place in a cracker unit at Sappapara village in Vrudhunagar on March 20, 2020. Nearly 14 people, including his father died in the incident, he added. Since no compensation was paid to the victims even after a year, they approached the court a few months ago. Following the subsequent directions issued by the court, ₹3 lakh was paid to the family members of each of the 14 victims from the Chief Minister's Relief Fund recently and a report to that effect was submitted before the court.

Madurai corporation told to reply on norms followed for leasing out shops

THE Madurai Bench of Madras High Court on Thursday sought a response from the Madurai Corporation Commissioner on the procedure followed by the civic body while leasing out its shops.

A Division Bench comprising Justices Pushpa Sathyanarayana and P Velmurugan wanted to know whether the civic body is following the same procedure in every zone. It also asked whether the licenses are renewed periodically and if there has been any revision in the rents.

The Bench raised the ques-

ries in a petition filed by one SS Kumaran challenging an eviction notice issued to him by the authorities. Kumaran had rented a shop from the civic body and has been running a small restaurant there since 2005.

But misunderstanding that he has sublet the shop to one Mohamed Muthu, who is his employee, the authorities cancelled his license and issued an eviction notice to him last month, Kumaran alleged.

The civic body is acting in a slipshod manner without adhering to the orders passed by the court

Stating that the authorities did not follow due procedure while taking the aforesaid action, he requested the court to forbear them from evicting him.

While hearing the petition, the judges observed that the civic body is acting in a slipshod manner without adhering to the orders passed by the court. Hence, they posed the above queries and directed the corporation commissioner to file an affidavit answering the queries. The Bench also ordered the authorities to maintain a status quo (existing state of affairs) in the matter and adjourned the case for two weeks.

Notice on plea against slippery platforms in Nellai rly station

THE Madurai Bench of Madras High Court on Wednesday issued notice to the Southern Railway on a PIL filed by Nellai Maavatta Potu Jana Potu Nala Sangam against laying slippery tiles on the platforms of the Tirunelveli Junction Railway Station.

The litigant association submitted that there are five platforms in the station. Since the station acts as a connecting point for four other stations, scores of people use the station every day, he added. "Presently, the railway authorities are undertaking works to

renovate the station and are laying granite slabs on the platforms. Use of granite slabs may make the floor slippery and cause people to fall, especially during the rainy season," the association claimed. Stating that the authorities were about to complete the works on one of the platforms, he filed the

petition seeking direction from the authorities to stop the ongoing works, and pave non-slippery platforms in the station.

A Bench of Justices Pushpa Sathyanarayana and P Velmurugan issued notice to the railway authorities and adjourned the case for two weeks.

FIR against two in school wall-collapse case quashed
Madurai: The Madurai Bench quashed the FIR registered against the headmistress and correspondent of an aided school in Tirunelveli, where three children died in a wall collapse in December 2021. Justice GR Swaminathan passed the order in the petitions filed by the headmistress Persis Gnanaselvi and Correspondent K Selvakumar seeking the relief. The judge noted both the petitioners had been appointed in the school only in 2021 and cannot be held responsible for the incident. However, he added that the police may go on with the investigation.

Madurai city police get 21 AC four-wheeler patrol vehicles
Madurai: City police got 21 new four-wheeler patrol vehicles, which are equipped with air conditioner and many more facilities, from the head office. Sources said though the city police already had four patrol vehicles, of funds said that the vehicles were bag and not equipped with facilities. New vehicle has public addressing system, GPS tracking. "The patrol in-charge and driver based on direction of control room or by the senior officials have to rush to spot immediately upon emergency. Vehicles can also be stationed at important junction, and be used to transport suspects," said an officer.

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
