**India need 58 runs to seal series sweep after WI push game to final day**

**NEW DELHI, OCTOBER 13**  
 India closed in on a comprehensive victory, and a 2-0 series sweep, in the final Test against West Indies on Monday but it was far from a cakewalk as the touring side offered spirited resistance thanks to hundreds by John Campbell and Shai Hope. Chasing 121 for victory, India were 63/1 at stumps and West Indies will draw solace from being able to force a final-day finish after being made to follow on.

B Sai Sudhansan (30) and KL Rahul (25) were in the middle for India, who need 58 more runs to seal the win. They took their chances, and once the field was spread out, they were really sensible with their game. India's spin-bowling all-rounder Washington Sundar told reporters. "The conversation among us was to be really patient and bowl as many good deliveries as possible no matter what."

Beaten inside three days in the series opener in Ahmedabad, West Indies were made to follow on in Delhi after being bowled out for 248 replying to India's 518/5 declared. They produced a much-improved batting display in the second innings, posting 390 before being bowled out in Monday's final session. Leading the fightback were Campbell (115) and Hope (103), who combined in a 177-run partnership for the third wicket to avoid a second successive innings defeat. Campbell survived an anxious moment before reach-

ing his maiden Test hundred after being given out lbw to Ravindra Jadeja. The batter reviewed the decision, which was overturned after replays confirmed he had edged the ball

which included three sixes and 12 fours. Hope's composed knock ended when he chopped a Mohammed Siraj delivery onto his stumps. Spinner Kuldeep Yadav produced a three-wicket burst to rattle West Indies, dismissing Roston Chase (40) and Khary Pierre in the same over. There was still some sting left in the West Indies tail. Justin Greaves, who made 50 not out, and Jayden Seales (32) frustrated India with a 79-run partnership for the final wicket. India's pace spearhead Jasprit Bumrah claimed three lower-order wickets on a pitch

**Washington says Kotla track challenged bowlers**

**NEW DELHI:** The wily Kuldeep Yadav got more purchase from the docile Feroz Shah Kotla track compared to others as he is a wrist spinner, fellow tweaker Washington Sundar said after the Indian bowling unit needed as many as 118.5 overs to dismiss West Indies in their second innings. As many as 13 out of the 20 wickets were picked up by the spin trio and Kuldeep has a match haul of 8/186 in 55.5 overs across two innings. Washington got a wicket bowling 36 overs in the game while veteran Ravindra Jadeja claimed four wickets from a total of 52 overs. "I think Kuldeep bowled really well. He hit those areas really well and being a wrist spinner he probably got a bit of purchase here and there as well and that definitely helped," Washington said. "But yes, I think all the bowlers bowled really well. Even the quicks bowled their hearts out. So, yes, as I said, it's really heartening to have taken 20 wickets on this track," he added. He felt that the wicket was no different to what Kotla has been producing over the years. "This, I would say, is a typical Delhi wicket, where there is not much bounce and obviously, there wasn't a lot of turn on offer also in this game. But yeah, different venues play out quite differently, and that's the beauty about this format in particular. We play in a lot of different conditions, be it home or away, and obviously all those conditions and the opposition challenge our skill sets and that's the beauty of this format. We keep going," he said. PTI



**Aman hopeful WFI will revoke ban**

 Paris Olympics bronze medalist Aman Sehrawat looked happy and content. The reason was simple: he was felicitated by the Indian Olympic Association (IOA) with sports minister Dr Mansukh Mandaviya in attendance. However, one thought has been bothering him for a month now. He has been banned for a year from competition by the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) after he failed to make his weight at the World Championships in Zagreb, Croatia, last month. Sehrawat was 1.7kg overweight during the weigh-in before the start of the com-

petition. He joined the Croatia camp about 15 days before the start of the competition but could not work on his weight as he was taken ill by a stomach bug. "It was not as if I failed the weight knowingly. Everyone in the team knew that I was ill. We tried for two days to shed the weight but I just could not," Sehrawat told *The Tribune* on Monday. "I did not like how things happened after that as nobody wants a tag of being banned but we have to also understand that there are rules, so I am over it," he added. The 22-year-old from Bihari in Haryana is hopeful that the WFI will take back

the ban and he can take part in competitions. "I have spoken to the federation a few times already and I am very hopeful that they will take back this ban. I think the federation has a meeting sometime next week where they will take a decision," he said. However, he made it clear that he is likely to miss the Senior National Wrestling Championships, the venue for which is to be announced soon. "I do not think I will be taking part in the Nationals. The bigger picture is the Asian Games next year and my focus is doing well there and other international events where I will take part," he said.

**De Klerk guides SA to another nery victory**

**VISAKHAPATNAM, OCTOBER 13**  
 Nadine de Klerk demonstrated icy-cool demeanour under pressure and shepherded South Africa to a three-wicket win over Bangladesh in a thrilling Women's World Cup match here on Monday. Set 233, premier all-rounders Marizanne Kapp (56 off 71 balls) and Chloe Tryon (62 off 69 balls) struck vital fifties to help South Africa mount a remarkable fightback after they were tottering at 78/5 in the 23rd over, with an 85-run stand for the sixth wicket. After their dismissals, de Klerk, who was dropped by Shorna Akter at long-off in the penultimate over, finished the job with a four and a six. **Brief scores:** Bangladesh: 232/6 in 50 overs (Shorna 51\*, Sharmin 50; Mlaba 2/42); South Africa: 235/7 in 49.3 overs (Tryon 62, Kapp 56, de Klerk 37\*; Nahida 2/44). — PTI

**SA struggle with spin vs Pak**

**LAHORE, OCTOBER 13**  
 South Africa's Tony de Zorzi scored an unbeaten 81 to take South Africa to 216-6 at stumps against Pakistan on the second day of the first Test on Monday, trailing by 162 runs. De Zorzi survived several reviews in a charmed existence at the crease but provided resistance as the tourists struggled to deal with Pakistan's spin attack on a surface slowing up and

with cracks beginning to show at the Gaddafi Stadium. He will resume with Senuwan Muthusamy, not out on six, at the start of the day three on Tuesday after Muthusamy's bowling caused a sudden collapse in Pakistan's innings earlier on Monday. The home team were in a commanding position at 313/5 overnight, with Mohammad Rizwan 62 not out and Salman Ali Agha

unbeaten on 52, and looked to be heading to an imposing total before the left-arm spinner took three wickets in four balls in the 12th over. Pakistan collapsed from 362/5 to 378 all out as Muthusamy finished with best figures of 6/117. Rizwan (75) began the procession as he was deceived by extra bounce and feathered the ball through to wicketkeeper Kyle Verreynne. — Reuters
