Centre 'secretly' helped Rohingyas: Sisodia

Deputy CM claims that police sent proposal to shift Rohingyas after L-G's instruction without informing CM

THE BJP-led Centre was 'secretly' trying to give 'permanent residence' to Rohingya refugees in the national capital, Deputy Chief Minister Manish Sisodia on Wednesday alleged, rejecting the Union home ministry's claim that it was the Delhi government's proposal.

He also said the Centre was in the morning calling the move to shift Rohingyas to EWS category flats in the city as its 'achievement', but later started shifting the blame on the Delhi government after the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) opposed it.

Without taking names, Sisodia alleged that the Delhi police and some officials had taken the decision to provide the Rohingyas permanent residence in the city on the instructions of Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena and at the behest of the Union government.

They were sending the proposal to Saxena for his approval without bringing it to the knowledge of Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal and the city home minister, he added.

Sisodia asserted that the Kejriwal dispensation will not let this "conspiracy" to illegally settle Rohingyas in Delhi succeed.

Amid a row over the issue,

'Police gave permanent residence to them'

Without taking names, Sisodia alleged that the Delhi police and some officials had taken the decision to provide the Rohingyas permanent residence in the city on the instructions of Lieutenant Governor V K Saxena and at the behest of the Union government.

the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) issued a clarification denying any such move and said the Delhi government had proposed to shift the Rohingyas to a new location, but it has been directed to ensure the "illegal foreigners" remain in detention centres pending their extradition.

Reacting to the ministry's statement, Sisodia said, "The central government, which was not tired of describing the news (about shifting of Rohingyas) as its achievement in the morning, has now started putting the responsibility of it on the Delhi government after the Aam Aadmi Party opposed such a step.

He added, "At the behest of the central government, the officers took decision to shift Rohingyas and the proposal was being sent to L-G for his approval, without bringing it to the knowledge of the chief minister."

Rohingyas will be a big threat to us, say residents of Bakkarwala

JUST a few hours after Union Minister for Housing and Urban Affairs Hardeep Puri revealed that Rohingya refugees in the national capital will be shifted to Economically Weaker Section (EWS) apartments in Bakkarwala, the locals of Bakkarwala village in West Delhi gathered outside EWS flats in the evening.

Bitto Balwan, who contested for the councillor on the ticket of Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) from the area in 2017, said "My village is more important for me than my party. The Rohingyas will be a big threat to us as we keep on reading about them on how they are involved in illegal activities, including drug peddling and stealing."

The EWS flats have been constructed by the New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) in the Bakkarwala area near Tikri border.

Pradeep Singh Sehrawat, another resident of the area,



raised the same concern. On Wednesday, leaders from Congress, BJP and AAP joined the protest against the order, claimed Pradeep. Rohit Sehrawat, the BJP local leader, who also joined the protest said, "Rohingyas are involved in all sorts of crimes."

He also claimed that Puri's tweet was misinterpreted by the media.

As per the census, the Bakkarwala has a population of more than 18,000 and is dominated by the Jats.

Meanwhile, the Ministry of Home Affairs clarified in a series of tweets that it has not given any orders to relocate the Rohingya refugees. The Delhi government was further directed by the Union home ministry to keep the Rohingya refugees there until their deportation.

Last year, the Delhi government had directed the NDMC to accommodate the foreign inmates in Baraat Ghar along with all EWS flats at Bakkarwala village.

Won't let refugees settle in capital, says AAP MLA

NEW DELHI: The Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) on Wednesday lashed out at Prime Minister Narendra Modi-led central government after cabinet minister Hardeep Singh Puri said that Rohingya refugees in Delhi will be shifted to economically weaker section (EWS) apartments in Bakkarwala. Speaking to the media, AAP MLA Saurabh Bharadwaj said that his party will not permit Rohingya migrants to settle in the national capital because they will pose a threat to Delhi residents in the future. Taking a jibe at the centre, Bharadwaj told the centre to settle the Rohingyas in BJP-ruled states instead. Bharadwaj condemned Puri's statement and said the rapid penetration of Rohingyas will jeopardize national security. "The BJP is bringing Rohingyas to the country for its own benefit. Why should the Delhi government invest Delhi's taxpayer's money to make a detention centre? The central government should deport them back instead." At the behest of the L-G, the Chief Secretary of Delhi called a meeting and decided to settle Rohingyas in Delhi without the chief minister's knowledge. He bypassed the elected government and sent a note directly to the L-G, said Bharadwaj. He further added, "Hardeep Puri's ministry has jurisdiction over NDMC and they have allotted EWS to the Rohingyas in Bakkarwala area. We will not let the Rohingyas settle here. No matter how hard the central government tries, we will ensure that these flats are not allocated to the Rohingyas."

Kejriwal's 'national mission' focuses on education, health

A day after announcing a 4-point formula for India to become a superpower, AAP's national convener Arvind Kejriwal on Wednesday announced 'Make India No. 1' mission to make the country number one by focussing on health, education, agriculture, employment and equal rights to women.

"Opening of schools, hospitals, providing employment to youth, equal rights to women and fair price to farmers are needed to make India number," he said at a mega event at Talkatora Stadium in Delhi.

He said, "We are on a mission to make India the strongest and the greatest nation in the world. This is a nation-wide mission. This is not limited to any party. People from all parties should come together for the cause. India has wasted 75 years fighting with each other. If we keep on fighting, we can't become the number one country."

Kejriwal also said that many countries became independent after us and overtook us. Giving example, he said, Singapore

got independence 15 years after India. Japan and Germany were destroyed in World War II. "It has been 75 years of independence. In these years, we have achieved a lot, but there's anger among people on how several small nations who attained independence after us, surpassed us. Why did India lag behind? Every citizen is asking this," he added.

Talking about the agenda, he said, "Our first duty is to ensure that every child in India gets educated, regardless of how much money it costs. The second duty is to make sure every citizen gets better and free healthcare. We have to establish schools, hospitals and Mohalla clinics in every corner of the country."

"Thirdly, we must find jobs for our youth. No youth in this country should be unemployed. Fourth, every woman in this country needs to be respected, get equal rights and security," he added.

Fifth, farmers must be paid their dues, he said, adding that if these five goals are achieved no one can stop India from becoming No. 1 in the world.

Yamuna crosses warning level once again

THE Yamuna crossed the warning mark of 204.5 metres in Delhi again on Wednesday with Haryana releasing more water from the Hathnikund barrage amid rains in the upper catchment areas, officials said.

The river breached the danger mark of 205.33 metres on Friday following heavy rains in the upper catchment areas, prompting authorities to evacuate around 7,000 people from low-lying areas. The water level receded below the warning mark on Monday and stood at 203.96 metres on Tuesday.

However, the water level rose again and crossed the warning mark around midnight. It stood at 204.89 metres on Wednesday, the Delhi government's flood control room said.

A forecast issued by the Cen-

tral Water Commission said the river is likely to rise to 205.25 metres by 9 pm and remain stable thereafter.

The India Meteorological Department (IMD) has said widespread rainfall "with isolated heavy falls" is very likely over

Himachal Pradesh and Uttarakhand over the next two-three days. The catchment of the Yamuna river system covers parts of Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand, Himachal Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh and Delhi.

Last week, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal appealed to people to avoid going towards the banks of the river.

A flood alert is declared in Delhi when the discharge rate from the Hathnikund barrage in Haryana's Yamuna Nagar crosses the one lakh-cusecs mark and people living near the floodplains and in flood-prone areas are evacuated.

The Yamuna floodplains and low-lying areas in Delhi near the river are considered vulnerable to flooding.

The overflowing Yamuna had affected low-lying areas near the river in northeast, east and southeast Delhi last week and around 7,000 people were shifted to higher ground. The Delhi flood control room reported a discharge rate of around 14,000 cusecs from the Hathnikund Barrage in Haryana's Yamuna Nagar at 6 am on Wednesday.

Don't mislead public by saying more than what is official: HC to Ramdev

ASSERTING that nobody should be misled against allopathy, the Delhi High Court Wednesday told Ramdev that while he was welcome to have his followers, he should not mislead the public by saying more than what is 'official'.

Justice Anup Jairam Bhambhani, who was hearing a lawsuit against the yoga guru by several doctors' associations for allegedly spreading misinformation concerning the use of Patanjali's Coronil for Covid-19, said that his concern was also to save the good reputation of Ayurveda which is an ancient system of medicine.

"From the very beginning,



my concern is only one. You are welcome to have your followers. But, please, do not mislead the public at large by saying more than what is official," the judge stated.

Several doctors' associations moved to the high court last year, alleging that Ramdev was misleading and misrepresenting to the public at large that allopathy was responsible

for the deaths of many infected by Covid-19 while claiming that Coronil was a cure for the virus. Senior advocate Akhil Sibal, appearing for the plaintiff associations, told the court that even recently, Ramdev made statements in public advertising Coronil as a treatment for Covid-19 and also suggesting the inefficacy of vaccines against the virus.

Sibal submitted that the license granted to Coronil 'does not mention Covid-19 at all' and only speaks about it being an immunity booster and having Ayurvedic ingredients.

The court was informed that in certain statements by Ramdev, reference was also made to a leader of a foreign nation contracting Covid-19 even after being vaccinated.

Cops file FIR in PG molestation case

A day after a video of a woman allegedly being molested surfaced on social media, the Delhi Police on Wednesday registered an FIR after taking suo-moto cognisance in the matter, officials said.

The Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) on Tuesday had issued a notice to the city police after taking note of the video and asked it to file an action taken report by 4 pm on August 18, they said.

Deputy Commissioner of Police (central) Shweta Chauhan said, "Since the complainant is completely against giving a statement, legal opinion was taken." "In accordance with legal opinion and in light of the video footage, an FIR has been registered suo-moto by police in this matter," she said.

A senior police officer said the video posted on Twitter is of an August 13 incident and the alleged victim had refused to file a complaint after the police went to assist her following a PCR call. The police officer said that a PCR call was received at the Karol Bagh police station about a guard of a paying guest accommodation involved in a quarrel. "However, the caller refused to give a complaint. It was learnt that she vacated the said PG on August 14," the DCP said.

On August 16, when the video went viral, the victim and her family were contacted again but they refused to initiate a complaint, the senior police officer said.

A DCW statement read, "The commission has taken suo motu cognisance of a video clip posted on social media platform 'Twitter' regarding molestation."
