

Most vulnerable availed fewer benefits of PMJAY

A detailed analysis of the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY), the government's flagship health insurance scheme, shows those most vulnerable — whether in terms of states, communities or gender — haven't been able to use it as well as therelatively better off.

For instance, though Scheduled Castes and Schedules Tribes constitute about 28% of the population, their share in private hospital admissions at the national level since the scheme's inception was just 5% and 2%, respectively. States with low poverty and disease burden, such as Kerala and HP, were found to be using services under the scheme much more than poorer states with high needs such as Bihar, MP, Assam and UP.

An analysis of the government's Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY) scheme shows that in terms of gender, though enrolment is almost equal for men and women, the total number and value of claims were higher for males. And though private hospitals constituted 56% of empanelled hospitals, they accounted for 75% of the money spent on reimbursing claims under the scheme.

The analysis was published in The Lancet Regional Health —

Southeast Asia and done by researchers from Association for Socially Applicable Research (ASAR), Pune and Duke University School of Medicine in the US. The study looked at the 2018-2022 period.

Vulnerable population groups like SCs, Other Backward Classes, Muslims, and families with children and elderly have higher cases of catastrophic health expenditure (CHE) — a situation where health spending exceeds 10% of a household's consumption expenditure — the paper noted. Also, impoverishment due to health expenditure is

higher in rural areas and poorer states. PMJAY, launched in September 2018, was meant to protect the most vulnerable, about 50 crore belonging to the bottom 40% of the population, from financial hardships.

The study cited a 2021 national household survey that showed that awareness and enrolment levels were the lowest among households in the poorest 40% of the population. "Thus, overall, the scheme is failing to target the most vulnerable population," it stated.

According to the authors, the discrepancy in utilisation between states was due to poor supply-side factors, including a low number of empanelled hospitals, an inefficient beneficiary identification system, and weak health governance in states with greater poverty and disease burdens.

"A similar pattern is seen at the district level, where socio-economically backward districts (also known as aspirational districts) have lower beneficiary identification rates, total number of claims and total claim amounts than non-aspirational districts. The majority of aspirational districts are located in Jharkhand, Orissa and Chhattisgarh," noted the paper.

Mandaviya urges states to stock up on essential meds as Covid cases rise

New Delhi: Thirteen fresh Covid fatalities were reported in the last 24 hours, the highest single-day toll from the virus since November last year. With this, 59 deaths have been recorded in the last seven days, up from 38 in the preceding seven-day period. While deaths remain low during the current surge, the toll has been inching as active cases swell, reports

Durgesh S Nandan Jha . The count of active cases is expected to cross 30,000 by Friday night, up from 16,300 a week ago.

According to data shared by the Union health ministry, 1.78 lakh Covid-19 tests were conducted across states/UTS in the last 24 hours and the positivity rate was recorded at 3.39%.

India has been witnessing a steady increase in Covid-19 cases, with average daily cases rising to 4,188 in the week ending April 7, from 571 in the week ending March 17.

Eight states are reporting high number of Covid cases in India with 10 or more districts reporting more than 10% positivity in Kerala, Maharashtra and Delhi and over 5 districts reporting more than 5% positivity in the states of Karnataka, Kerala, Maharashtra, Delhi, Himachal Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Haryana, the health ministry said.

The Union health ministry, in a review meeting with states on Friday, stressed on the im-

portance of enhancing public awareness campaigns regarding adherence to Covid appropriate behaviour.

Health minister Mansukh Mandaviya requested all state health ministers to personally monitor and review the preparedness of all logistics and infrastructure including availability of sufficient designated hospital beds and ensure that there is adequate stock of essential medicines. States were also asked to regularly update their Covid data on the Covid India Portal. Next week, on Monday and Tuesday, a nationwide mock drill is planned to assess emergency preparedness of both public and private hospitals.

The states were informed in the review meeting that WHO was closely tracking one sub-variant of interest (VOI), XBB.1.5, while six other sub-variants are being monitored (BQ.1, BA.2.75, CH.1.1, XBB, XBF and XBB.1.16).

Celebs, gaming co get notices for 'misleading' ad

New Delhi: The consumer protection watchdog has slapped notices on gaming company Lotus 365 and three celebrities, including actors Nawazuddin Siddique and Urvashi Rautela, for endorsing the company's "misleading" advertisement, reports Dipak Dash. The Central Consumer Protection Authority (CCPA) has sought response of the firm and celebrities before initiating action against them.

3 arrested for duping over 100 in job scam

New Delhi: Delhi Police has busted a fake job agency and arrested three men for cheating more than 100 people by promising them high-paying jobs abroad.

The accused were identified as Sohail Nijam, a BTech graduate, Afroj Alam and Parvej Alam. They are residents of Govindpuri, Jasola and Jamia Nagar, respectively.

Police recovered six mobile phones, two laptops, 68 Indian passports, fake job offer letters from a Chinese company and forged air tickets to Turkey and Ethiopia.

An investigation was started after a man named Dilawar Singh

filed a complaint on April 3, DCP (southeast) Rajesh Deo said.

"Singh alleged that he was cheated by the owner of a company which promised him a job in leading overseas firms. He made a payment of Rs one lakh to the accused and, in return, he was given a fake e-visa, a fake offer letter and an air ticket. After receiving the amount, the accused fled with the money," the DCP said.

The gang would send fake job offer letters through WhatsApp to potential targets and take them from money. They would also keep their passports as a part of the job process. The statement of the agency's account revealed transactions of over Rs 50 lakh, cops said.

'Messages show sender wanted to save trees in society's larger interest'

It then follows that if anybody is booked for criminal offences such as those as have been registered against the present petitioner, it may amount to an invasion upon the rights of the citizens of this country. Such an effort by any complainant, howsoever high he or she may be in position, cannot be countenanced and must be stopped," said Justices Sunil Shukre and Milind Sathaye on April 5.

On a complaint by Sanjay Dani (67), the police had on January 18, 2018 lodged the FIR against Benga-

luru resident Avijit Michael (34) of Jhatkaa.org under IPC Section 186 (obstructing public servant in discharge of public functions) and the Information Technology Act.

In December 2017, a campaign was started on Jhatkaa's website to save Aarey. The FIR said misleading messages were circulated to raise voice and ask Bhide and then CM Devendra Fadnavis to look for alternatives to save around 3,500 trees. Bhide received messages on her official phone. On May 7, 2018, Avijit was arrested and released on bail.

The judges said that the allega-

tions prima facie do not constitute the offences alleged. Also, under Section 186, it is "for that public servant to come forward and allege obstruction". But Bhide did not come forward, nor did Dani say she informed him about it.

The judges said messages do not show that the sender intended to obstruct Bhide from discharging her public functions. "These messages show at their face value that sender of the messages was the person who had intention to make efforts for preservation of the trees in larger interest of society," they added.
