Modi mocks Cong protest: 'Black magic won't help earn trust'

THOSE WHO think that by wearing black clothes, their period of despair will end are unaware that irrespective of the black magic and their belief in superstition, the public's trust will never be restored in them, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said Wednesday.

"On August 5, there was an attempt to spread black magic mentality. Those who think that by wearing black clothes, their period of despair will end are unaware that irrespective of the black magic and their belief in superstition, the public's trust will never be restored in them," Modi said on the occasion of World Biofuel Day when he dedicated the second generation

(2G) ethanol plant in Panipat, Haryana, to the nation via video conferencing. He was apparently referring to the Congress leaders who, dressed in black clothes, held a protest against price rise and unemployment last Friday. "During the Amrit Mahotsav when the entire country is painted in the colour of the Tricolour, I would like to draw the attention of the country to something that has happened.

An attempt has been made to defame this holy occasion, to humiliate our brave freedom fighters. It is important to understand the mentality of such people," Modi said. "There are some people in our country too who are trapped in the vortex of negativity, immersed in despair. Even after lying against the government, the public is not ready to trust such people. In such desperation, these people are also seen turning towards black magic."

In an apparent reference to protests against the rising prices of fuel, the PM said, "If there is selfishness in politics, then anyone can come and announce free petrol and diesel. Such steps will take away the rights of our children and prevent the country from becoming self-reliant. Due to such selfish policies, the burden on honest taxpayers of the

country will also increase. To deal with the challenges that the country is facing, it needs clear intentions and commitment. It requires extreme hard work, policy and huge investments."

Further attacking his opponents, Modi said, "People who have a tendency to avoid problems by adopting shortcuts for political selfishness can never solve the problems permanently. Those adopting short cuts may get applause for some time and may gain political advantage, but that does not solve the problem. Adopting a short cut will definitely result in a short circuit. Instead of following short cuts, our government is engaged in permanent solutions to the problems. A lot has been said about the problems of stubble over the years. But those with a short-cut mentality could not solve it."

Mexico's President proposes peace panel: Modi, Pope, UN chief

MEXICAN PRESIDENT Andres Manuel Lopez Obrador has said that he will propose to the UN for setting up a commission, comprising Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Pope Francis and UN Secretary General Antonio Guterres, aimed at stopping war and seeking a truce of at least five years to ensure world peace.

At a press meet Monday, Obrador said he feels that the governments of three great powers, Russia, China and the US, will hopefully listen to it and accept an intermediation like the one he is proposing. He proposed that the panel will comprise Modi, Guterres and Pope Francis and they will meet and present a proposal soon to end war everywhere.

According to information on his official website, the Mexican President said the commission's aim will be to stop war everywhere and reach an agreement to seek a truce of at least five years so that the governments of the whole world dedicate themselves to supporting their people, especially those who are suffering the most from the war and from its effects. He said he agrees with what the Secretary General of the UN has raised that countries must stop military confrontation, must opt for dialogue and not the use of force.

Justice UU Lalit is 49th CJI, will take charge on August 27

PRESIDENT DROUPADI Murmu Wednesday appointed Justice Uday Umesh Lalit as the 49th Chief Justice of India. Justice Lalit will succeed Justice NV Ramana who is due to retire on 26 August.

"In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (2) of Article 124 of the Constitution of India, the President is pleased to appoint Shri Justice Uday Umesh Lalit, Judge of the Supreme Court, to be the Chief Justice of India with effect from August 27, 2022," a government notification said.

Justice Lalit, who will assume charge on August 27, will have a relatively short tenure of over three months and is due to retire on November 8. He will also only be the second CJI to have been appointed directly from the Bar without serving as a judge of a high court. Justice SM Sikri, who was CJI from January 1971 to April 1973, is the only other CJI who was directly appointed from the Bar. Justice Lalit enrolled as an advocate in June 1983 and worked in the chambers of former Attorney General Soli Sorabjee. He was one of the country's top criminal

lawyers before being appointed a judge of the Supreme Court in August 2014. His father, U R Lalit, was an Additional Judge of the Nagpur Bench of the Bombay High Court from 1974 to 1976.

Justice Lalit has been part of several important rulings in the SC and headed the bench that last month sentenced Vijay Mallya, who was found guilty of contempt of court in 2017, to four months' imprisonment and fine of Rs 2,000. He also headed the bench that convicted the fugitive businessman for contempt in May 2017. A bench presided by him underscored the importance of mitigating circumstances while dealing with death penalty convicts. In a Madhya Pradesh case involving a man sentenced to death for the gang rape of a child, the bench gave credence to the role of a "mitigation investigator" in going into the background of the convict. The court also initiated a suo motu case to streamline the process of consideration of mitigating circumstances in such matters.

'Nitish aides came to BJP with his wish to be V-P'

What was the trigger for Nitish to break up with BJP?

We are stunned at what he did and the manner in which he broke up with us. When he had done so in June 2013, he had apprised the state and Central BJP leaders about his stand well in advance. So even if it was still betrayal of mandate for NDA, we could still say that we knew it. But this time, it was complete betrayal of mandate for PM Narendra Modi. The 2020 Assembly elections was not a mandate for Nitish Kumar as JD(U) had got only 43 seats and finished third after RJD and BJP.

Did the BJP try to placate Nitish or stop him, or just decided to move on?

Nitish Kumar should remember that we made him the chief minister five times since 2000. Even when JD(U) came third in 2020 polls, we kept our word and made him CM. Even after our recent two-day party meet, we said Nitish would continue to be CM till 2025. We also talked about going to the 2024 (Lok Sabha) and 2025 (Assembly) polls with JD(U). We had not sensed much discomfort in JD(U). Even when Union home minister Amit Shah talked to Nitish Kumar on phone Monday and asked if there was any problem, Nitish ji did not say anything and said "just as you have Giriraj Singh in your party, we have Lalan Singh".

What did he expect from BJP?

Some Nitish Kumar aides had approached the state BJP leadership with the message that he wanted to become the Vice-President. This shows Nitish did

nurse national ambition.

Do you think Nitish did not have smooth communication line with the BJP leadership as he used to have with you as his deputy and the late Arun Jaitley?

It is not fair to say that, as only recently Dharmendra Pradhan held one-on-one meeting with him. Yet, Nitish did not complain much except making a passing reference to some grudges against Speaker Vijay Kumar Sinha. Besides, PM Modi and Amit Shah and our national president JP Nadda would speak to him at regular intervals. But it is true that he used to share a very good rapport with Arun ji and me. He would often say in recent times that he had become CM this time on the PM's request and was not very comfortable in the present set-up. But there was no communication gap.

Kishor: CM's 6th experiment in 10 yrs; state's slide is a constant

ON A day Nitish Kumar took oath as Bihar Chief Minister for a record eighth time, election strategist Prashant Kishor took a swipe at his former party leader and said the current political developments in Bihar should not surprise anyone, as this is the "sixth experiment" by Nitish in government formation since 2012. The only constants in this period have been Nitish as CM and Bihar doing poorly on most development indices, he said.

Kishor, who is likely to enter the electoral fray in 2025 through his outfit, Jan Suraj, called it a "state-specific development" and said not much should be read into it with 2024 General Election in mind.

Since 2012-13, Kishor told *The Indian Express*, the "only constant" has been Nitish Kumar as CM and the poor state of healthcare and education in the state, which has only gone worse since 2014-15. We must wait and

watch how this government performs, and how the coalition endures." "At the moment, this is a state-specific development for governance and not a political development for the future. It would be premature to project it as the Opposition's formula for 2024," the former JD(U) top leader said. On why Nitish broke the alliance with BJP, and whether the latter overplayed its hand in cornering him, Kishor said, "Nitish-ji was never comfortable in this NDA coalition as he was in the NDA coalition before 2015. Similarly, he is not as comfortable today in the Mahagathbandhan as he was in his last alliance with RJD. The 2015 alliance had the people's mandate behind it. This is a post-poll alliance. So there are additional challenges that this al-

liance will face."

On Nitish being projected as the Opposition's face for 2024 Lok Sabha polls, Kishor said, "He had made that attempt in 2014 also, and had got some support. But it is one thing to have intent, and another to convert that into reality." Playing down speculation over the Opposition's strength based on Nitish and Lalu being a formidable social coalition, Kishor said: "Whenever a coalition is formed, it looks formidable at the time.... Once a coalition is formed, and the government begins functioning, only then its challenges and problems or strengths emerge." Kishor said these developments should not be read as weakening of BJP in Bihar, and that the saffron party remains a formidable force.

Pointing out that JD(U)'s fortunes have slid consistently in the last few years — from 117 Assembly seats in 2015 to 43 now — Kishor said they will decline further if the Grand Alliance government fails to deliver on governance.

Form your own party, Pawar tells CM Shinde

Mumbai: NCP chief Sharad Pawar on Wednesday advised Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, who is engaged in a legal battle with the Uddhav Thackeray-led Shiv Sena for the party's election symbol, to set up his own party and select a new symbol.

"The ongoing battle over the election symbol of the party is sad. Bow and arrow was a symbol decided by the late Balasaheb Thackeray. It belongs to Shiv Sena. If Eknath Shinde has a different opinion then he should form his own party and select a new symbol," Pawar told media persons in Baramati. Pawar said he did this when he left Congress and formed NCP. ENS

BJP moves party's UP ace to Bengal, Odisha, Telangana to recoup likely Bihar losses

THE BJP on Wednesday appointed Sunil Bansal, who played a key role in the party's victories in Uttar Pradesh since 2014, as national secretary in charge of West Bengal, Odisha and Telangana — three Opposition-governed states the party is paying special focus on for 2024.

The development comes a day after key NDA ally JD(U) parted ways, leaving BJP's electoral calculations jittery in politically crucial Bihar. Bansal, general secretary (organisation) in UP since 2014, will be replaced by Dharampal, who has been party's secretary (organisation) in Jharkhand, according to a statement by BJP general secretary Arun Singh. Incidentally, both Dharampal and Bansal have ABVP backgrounds. Belonging to Bijpur district of western UP, Dharampal had joined the Sangh's students' front in 1990 as a full-time worker and

was ABVP joint zonal organisation secretary for UP and Uttarakhand.

The party stated that Karamveer has been appointed as BJP's Jharkhand unit general secretary. He was BJP joint-general secretary (organisation) in UP earlier. In West Bengal, Bansal replaced Kailash Vijayvargiya as BJP general secretary in charge of the state — he replaced Tarun Chugh in Telangana and D Purandeswari in Odisha. Born in Rajasthan, Bansal, 52, has been with RSS since his student days. He was handpicked by Home Minister Amit Shah while preparing the 2014 Lok Sabha poll strategy for UP. Before that, Bansal was an RSS pracharak. Known to be close to Shah, his elevation in BJP is expected to make him a significant power centre in the organisation.

Sources in BJP said that appointing Bansal in states where the party is eyeing to increase its tally in 2024 is an "acknowledgment" of the top leadership's trust in him. Equally, they averred, it is a "big challenge" for him.
