### CITY LAWYER WINS US GOV'T'S IQBAL MASIH AWARD FOR ELIMINATION OF CHILD LABOUR

Chennai: City-based lawyer-activist Lalitha Natarajan has been awarded the Iqbal Masih 2023 Award by the United States department of Labour, for elimination of child labour. The award was presented by US Consul general Judith Ravin recently. Lalitha Natarajan, is a member of the Child Welfare Committee (North Zone) which functions under the social defence department. "She has rescued children from forced labour in various industrial sectors across Tamil Nadu, including food processing factories and handloom mills," a statement from the Bureau of International Labour Affairs of the US government said. Lalitha ensured that the victims received compensations under the Child Labour Act and Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO). The Iqbal Masih Award is a US Congress mandated, non-monetary award established by the secretary of labour in 2008 that honours extraordinary contributions to combat child labour annually. ENS

# Chennai aims to become carbon neutral by 2050

CM Stalin unveils climate action plan; focus on renewable energy, sustainable transport, solid waste management

CHIEF Minister MK Stalin on Tuesday unveiled Chennai's first-ever climate action plan (CAP). The plan will serve as a roadmap for the city to become carbon neutral by 2050, well before the National Commitment of Net Zero by 2070.

The United Nations Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change (IPCC) warns of severe damages from sea-level rise, critically high temperatures and increased risks from climate impacts for coastal cities like Chennai. Chennai's CAP reflects a commitment to address the growing climate crisis through science-based, locally-led actions, a government press release said.

Stalin said, "The climate action plan is an important first step towards a climate resilient and proactive Chennai. Our government has taken strategic measures on priority to protect the environment. The implementation of this plan will facilitate the city to reduce emissions and adapt to climate risks, thereby improving the quality

of life of its residents and also creating green jobs."

Environment Minister Siva V Meyyanathan said as the evidence unfolds, the interlinkage between human actions and climate change is coming to the fore. The launch of the Tamil Nadu State Mission on Strategic Knowledge with components of the Tamil Nadu Climate Change Mission, Wetlands Mission and Green Tamil Nadu Mission would go a long way in promoting preparedness by Tamil Nadu. Environment Secretary Supriya Sahu said the plan was in line with the Tamil Nadu

State Action Plan on Climate Change with a special focus on adaptation to climate change in the context of more explicitly known disasters like cyclones, floods and sea-level rise.

The government said the plan was developed with support from C40 Cities in collaboration with the Urban Management Centre, Ahmedabad. It aligns with the Paris Climate Accords, setting emission reduction targets of 1% increase by 2030, 40% decrease by 2040 and achieving net zero by 2050, compared to 2018-19 emission levels.

It focuses on actions in six pri-

ority areas, which include electrical grid and renewable energy; building energy; sustainable transport; solid waste management; urban flooding and water scarcity; and vulnerable populations and health.

Shruti Narayan, C40 Regional Director for South and West Asia, said, "Chennai has led the way in showcasing how political commitment and leadership can result in an ambitious and implementable climate action plan - which is particularly of importance to the global south, home to cities with the highest climate risk in the world."

# Six private bank employees steal & sell customer's bike, booked after victim uncovers theft

R SIVAKUMAR assumed that his bike was stolen when it went missing in March 2021. However, a few months later he learnt that his bike was stolen by employees from the same bank he had taken the loan for it. Almost 18

months after Sivakumar uncovered the crime, Valasaravakkam police have booked six employees of IDFC First bank.

Sivakumar had purchased the motorbike in May 2019 after paying a down payment of ₹51,890 and took loan from IDFC First bank branch at Teynampet and paid ₹6,027 every month for the

next 1.5 years. "I paid all dues by December 2020. Three months later, on March 3, 2021, my bike was stolen from Alwarthirunagar," said Sivakumar.

On December 20, 2021, nine months after the theft, he traced his vehicle after receiving a traffic violation message. "One Nassar who was driving my bike did

not wear a helmet and the challan came to my number. Nassar also had provided the original RC book to the police, which was shocking because I still have the registration under my name," said Sivakumar. Nassar informed Sivakumar that he had bought the vehicle from Parthiban through an online

portal. Parthiban purchases seized vehicles from banks and sells them after refurbishing the RC. "Turns out, the IDFC First bank staff had taken my vehicle without my knowledge and forged my signature into transferring the ownership. I contacted the RTO and blocked the RC book," said Sivakumar

He also lodged a complaint on the ombudsman portal, which is monitored by RBI. The bank staff contacted Sivakumar and claimed that there was a technical error and they believed that he did not pay the EMI. "They provided me with a compensation of ₹90,000, but I declined the offer since I decided to take the

issue to consumer court. The bank staff called me to a place and threatened me into accepting the compensation," said Sivakumar. Six bank employees have been booked under various IPC sections. *TNIE* reached out to an accused, but he refused to comment. A query has been sent to the bank regarding the same.

### Man alleges harassment by cops, protests at Tiruvallur collectorate

Chennai: A man staged a protest inside Tiruvallur collectorate on Monday night alleging that he was being harassed by Villivakkam police because his friends are suspects in a murder case. Tiruvallur Town police told him to submit a written petition. The man was identified as Karthick alias Neelakantan, a contract worker at the Tiruvallur GH. Around 10:30 pm, Karthick, accompanied by his wife, went to the collectorate and stripped his clothes and staged a protest. He alleged Villivakkam police have been calling him to the station frequently, and were also calling him on his phone. ENS

### Hooch manufacturing unit unearthed in Kallakurichi, 4 held

Kallakurichi: A special team led by Cuddalore SP R Rajaram arrested four individuals — D Mookan, V Kuber, M Veeran, and S Riyaz Ahammed — from a hooch manufacturing facility in Kalvarayan Hills on Monday. Based on an arrested hooch peddler's information, the team initiated a search in the Hills from where raw materials, 454 liquor bottles, and sealing equipment were also seized. The suspects were handed over to the PEW in Kallakurichi for further probe. ENS

# Policeman misbehaves with woman, transferred

A 56-year-old special sub-inspector (SSI) has been transferred to vacancy reserve (VR) for allegedly misbehaving with a woman ministerial staff.

Police sources identified the man as Prabha Shankar. He was attached to the crime wing at Choolaimedu police station. On Monday evening, a woman ministerial staff was working at the station as a data entry operator and Prabha Shankar allegedly kissed her. The woman raised the issue with senior police officers, and when it was confirmed that the incident took place, Prabha Shankar was transferred to the vacancy reserve.

A senior police officer said, "We conducted an investigation and found out that the incident was true. He was then transferred to VR."
