

Two HP judges move SC over HC collegium picks

‘Seniority, Merit, SC Collegium Advice Ignored’

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New Delhi: Questioning the process of selection of judges by the Himachal Pradesh HC collegium, two senior-most district judges have moved Supreme Court alleging that the collegium not only ignored their merit and seniority but also stepped around CJI D Y Chandrachud-led SC collegium’s specific advice for consideration of their names.

Reflecting a larger issue revolving around an oft-repeated grievance that HC collegiums do not scrupulously adhere to SC-devised process for selection of judicial officers and lawyers for appointment as HC judges, district judges of Bilaspur and Solan, Chirag Bhanu Singh and Ar-

vind Malhotra, respectively, in their joint writ petition sought a direction to HC collegium to consider their names as per SC collegium’s Jan 4 resolution.

They said SC collegium’s decision to send their names for reconsideration by HC judges was followed by a communication from Union law minister to HC chief justice requesting that names of Singh and Malhotra be reconsidered by HC collegium.

The judicial officers said HC collegium ignored SC collegium’s advice and the law minister’s letter and without reconsidering their names, began calling for judgments of judicial officers much junior to them in a bid to step around their merit, seniority and “unblemished judicial track record”.

“The facts and circumstances of the present case exhibit that petitioners’ valuable constitutional rights, pertinently their right to be considered, are being violated,”

they said. Earlier, recommended by HC collegium for appointment as judges of Himachal Pradesh HC, names of Singh and Malhotra were placed for SC collegium’s consideration on July 12 last year, which was initially deferred. On Jan 4, the CJI-led collegium remitted their names to HC collegium for reconsideration.

The petitioners said HC collegium last month “deliberately omitted their names”, overlooking their seniority and merit and recommended names of two “ineligible junior officers” to SC collegium for appointment as HC judges.

“The entire process adopted by the HC collegium stands procedurally & substantially vitiated & is contrary to established constitutional convention. Action of the HC chief justice & the collegium is thus liable to be set aside,” they said, and sought a stay on the process of consideration of names of junior judicial officers by the SC collegium till SC addressed their grievances.

This arrest shows the nature of our ongoing investigation to hold responsible those that played a role in the homicide of Hardeep Singh Nijjar,” said superintendent Mandeep Mooker, IHIT officer-in-charge. “IHIT pursued the evidence and gained sufficient information for the British Columbia prosecution service to charge Amandeep Singh with first-degree murder and conspiracy to commit murder,” the police sta-

tement said. IHIT investigators on May 3 arrested three Indian nationals — Karan Brar (22), Kamalpreet Singh (22) and 28-year-old Karanpreet Singh — for the murder of Nijjar. All three live in Edmonton and have been charged with first-degree murder and conspiracy to commit murder. Ties between India and Canada have come under strain following PM Justin Trudeau’s allegations last Sept of the “potential” involvement of Indian agents in the killing of Nijjar.

After ₹37cr haul, ED summons J’khand mantri

Ranchi: ED has issued summons to Jharkhand minister Alamgir Alam in an alleged corruption and money laundering case, and asked him to appear before it on Tuesday reports Sanjay Sahay.

The summons were issued to the rural development minister after the agency seized around Rs 37 crore in raids conducted at several places in Ranchi last week. Around Rs 32 crore was recovered from a flat of Jehangir Alam, aide of the minister’s personal secretary Sajeev Lal.

HC: Judge’s testimony can’t weigh more than peon’s

Ahmedabad: Does the testimony of a judge in a criminal case carry more weight than that of a peon who works in the same court?

It was on this ground that Gujarat High Court quashed an order awarding seven-year jail term to an octogenarian, a former court employee, who was punished after cash and valuables from the court’s “muddamal” went missing.

HC has ordered the lower court to take afresh decision on the case.

The case involves 85-year-old Akbarali Saiyed, who was a nazir (curator) at a civil court in Chhota Udepur. On November 14, 1991, Vadodara’s district judge conducted an unannounced inspection of the “muddamal” at the Chhota Udepur court. Due to paucity of time, the district judge decided to continue the inspection the next day.

The visit was not possible the next day, but he turned up a day later, on November 16, 1991, to resume the inspection. Some envelopes were found torn and cash worth Rs 80,833 was missing along with ornaments and a wristwatch from the “muddamal”. The civil judge and judicial magistrate first class (JMFC) of the court filed a complaint against Saiyed, then the nazir of the court, for misappropriation of cash and valuables.

During the trial, the court’s peon testified that the complainant JMFC himself had opened the strongroom on November 15, 1991, after office hours.
