BU violated norms in giving approval for new courses?

BHARATHIAR University (BU) has violated the deadline for colleges to file applications to offer new courses, allege academicians. This came to light after the agenda for the next meeting, to be held on Friday, was circulated to members.

State president of the Association of University Teachers (AUT) and senate former member P Thirunavukkarasu, who flagged the violation, explained, "University Act states that if a college wants to start new courses from the next academic year, it should get approval from the university in present academic year. It should apply by October and pay penalty if it applies March. But BU has given approval to 25 private colleges, 17 of which applied after March, to start new courses."

The university has given permission to 25 colleges to offer new courses such as B, Sc Beauty Wellness, BBA Aviation Management, B, Sc Data Science, etc. "The university violated norms and favoured private colleges in connivance with higher education secretary. Because, we raised the issue with the Secretary, but he failed to stop the violation," he alleged.

Convener of the Joint Action Council of College Teachers M Nagarajan told TNIE, "Some private college management decides to start new courses based on trend in order to increase student strength and make more money. If the university gives approval to new courses instantly, there will be a lack of teaching staff, amenities such as labs, class room, etc in the college. It would affect education of students who join the courses with high hopes. The higher education minister must put an end to such violations."

When asked about it, Bharathiar University Vice Chancellor P Kaliraj clarified, "Due to the pandemic situation, it took some time in giving approval to the new courses. Besides, some colleges represented with the higher education department to give approval for new courses."

Further, he said the university has decided to extend the deadline to receive applications from October to December and it will be finalised in the senate meeting.

Attempts to contact higher education secretary D Karthikeyan for a comment went in vain.

According to sources, a consultant will be appointed through international bidding to prepare a Comprehensive Shoreline Development Plan. Multiple consultants will be appointed for executing individual beach projects, the order said.

Despite having a shoreline that extends between Ennore Creek in the north to Kovalam in the south, access to the beaches is not continuous or uniform and the need to conserve the coastline from a climate perspective too remains unattended. The project would also factor in a National Centre

for Coastal Research report that highlighted sea erosion and accretion.

The project, announced in the State Assembly recently, is likely to be implemented in phases. It will be funded by the CMDA, which will also explore the possibility of extending the project beyond Kovalam.

Hyd gangrape: 5 juveniles get bail

FIVE juveniles accused in the sensational Jubilee Hills gang rape case were granted bail while the bail plea of key accused Saduddin Malik was rejected by the Telangana High Court.

Four of the five minors were granted conditional bail and released from the juvenile home on Tuesday on provision of a ₹5,000 surety each.

The fifth juvenile, who is the son of a legislator, was also granted a conditional bail by the High Court on Wednesday.

Five minors connected with Jubilee Hills minor rape case

were granted conditional bail by the Telangana State High Court and were released from Juvenile Home while one more accused Saduddin Malik is still in Chanchalguda Jail followed by his bail rejection by the High Court.

Six accused including Saduddin Malik and five minors were taken into custody by Jubilee Hills police after a complaint was registered by minor victim's father on May 28 this year.

Five accused persons were placed in Juvenile Welfare and Correctional Centre in Saidabad.

Another accused who is a major, Saduddin Malik was placed

in Chanchalguda Jail.

All the six accused were interrogated during the two month jail period and the police wrapped their probe, they are yet to file a chargesheet soon. While the police are processing for chargesheet,

All five were asked to cooperate with the police as and when they are summoned and also assigned to drop their signatures every weekend at the DPO.

Another minor accused who is the son of a legislator was granted conditional bail on Wednesday.

Accused's plea was heard by the High Court and a decision was out on Wednesday while Saduddin also approached the High Court.

Steps being taken for ferry service in Tamil Nadu: Minister

Chennai: Union Minister for Shipping and Waterways, Sarbananda Sonowal, has told the parliament that the Centre is taking steps to introduce Ro-Ro ferry service in Tamil Nadu. He was replying to a question by DMK Rajya Sabha member P Wilson. Sonowal added that the ministry is supporting 45 projects, worth ₹1,900 crore. "The ministry is supporting four projects in Andhra Pradesh, two in Odisha and 1 each in Tamil Nadu and Goa, he added.

Ramanathapuram: Two families, including three children and four adults, reached Dhanushkodi from Sri Lanka around 9.45 pm on Tuesday, seeking refuge. They had allegedly left the island nation around 6 pm, paying around Sri Lankan rupees 3 lakh. The persons were identified as R Rajarethinamut-haiyakumar (49), his wife U Roja (38) and their children U Vithusa (12), U Dhanushan (10), U Karisan (7) from Kilincholi along with Batricnewton Nimalraj (47) from Yazhpanam.

NIA picks up two more 'terror suspects' from Erode

Erode: Following the arrest of a terror suspect in Salem, Salem city police, National Investigation Agency (NIA) and Bengaluru crime branch arrested two more youth from Erode on Wednesday. Bengaluru police arrested 20-year-old Abdul Alim Mulla for allegedly having links with terror organisation. The recent arrest follows questioning of five persons from WB at a house in Manikkampalayam in Erode on Tuesday night. The raid was conducted following Mulla's confessions.
