CM is protecting Tamil language: MP Saminathan

THE union government is trying to impose Hindi as third language on Tamil Nadu, Minister for Tamil Development Department, MP Saminathan said on Friday.

Speaking in a programme organised by the department at a private college to mark International Mother Language Day, he said Chief Minister MK Stalin is taking efforts to protect Tamil language just like former CM and DMK president M Karunanidhi did earlier.

"Former chief ministers CN Annadurai and M Karunanidhi strongly opposed imposition of Hindi. Tamil Nadu already lost

many lives to save the language of the land. DMK cadres burnt copies of the law and several cadres including myself were arrested. I spent 45 days in prison," he recalled.

Former CM Karunanidhi took steps to get Semmozhi (classical) status for Tamil language and conducted a World Tamil conference in Coimbatore, he added.

The minister further said currently other languages including English dominate, particularly on name boards of commercial establishments, and steps are being taken to correct the situation. Collector K Pavankumar G Giriappanavar was among those who were present.

421 kg smuggled beefwood seized, search on for three

THE Ariyalur police are on a lookout for three persons for allegedly smuggling beefwood logs in Vellore on Friday. The police conducted a vehicle inspection leading to the seizure of 421 kg of smuggled beefwood logs in Vellore.

During the inspection, a vehicle transporting goods from Tirunelveli approached the checkpoint. In a bid to escape from police custody, all the three suspects left the vehicle and fled to a bus station opposite the petrol station.

According to police sources, a closer examination of the vehicle revealed that the back seats had been removed, exposing a hidden compartment containing a significant quantity of smuggled beefwood. Inspector Nagaraj was immediately informed, following which the vehicle was seized and taken to the Ariyalur police station.

A detailed inspection uncovered 13 concealed boxes containing a total of 421 kg of smuggled beefwood. The police subsequently alerted forest department officials, who visited the station to assess the seized materials.

Kodanad case: CB-CID SIT approaches Interpol again to trace suspect's caller

THE Special Investigation Team (SIT) of Crime Branch CID (CB-CID) has sent a reminder to Interpol seeking details of international phone calls received by prime suspect C Kanagaraj in the Kodanad heist-cum-murder case.

Speaking to reporters at the Nilgiris district sessions court on Friday, special public prosecutor Shajahan said the CB-CID had first approached Interpol to trace the VoIP calls received by Kanagaraj last year. Interpol did not share any information. So, the SIT has re-

cently sent a reminder to Interpol through Salem district court and CBI.

Police said Kanagaraj and Sayan received calls through Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) five times between April 27 and 28. This came to light during analysis of Sayan's Call Detail Records. The SIT wrote to a US-based telecommunication service provider through Central Bureau of Investiga-

tion and Interpol, seeking details of the person who used the number. But there has been no response so far. This was conveyed to the judge on Friday during the hearing. Prime suspects Walayar Manoj and KV Sayan were present. The next hearing has been posted to March 19.

A gang of eleven people, including the prime suspects C Kanagaraj and KV Sayan, allegedly committed the crime in the wee hours of April 24, 2017 at the Kodanad estate bungalow belonging to former CM J Jayalalithaa.

So far 245 people have been questioned.

31 bootleggers arrested in 12 days

Mayiladuthurai: A total of 31 people have been arrested in the district on charges of smuggling liquor from Puducherry, the police said. The arrests were made during raids and vehicle checks conducted over 12 days from February 9.

The police seized 380 bottles of Indian Made Foreign Liquor (IMFL) and 150 bottles of Puducherry arrack, smuggled from Karaikal for illegal sale. A total of 31 cases were registered under the Prohibition Act, including 17 at the Mayiladuthurai PEW station and 14 at Sirkazhi PEW station. The arrested individuals were remanded in judicial custody. ENS

Two held for hurling petrol bomb

Tirunelveli: The Koodankulam police arrested two persons for allegedly hurling a petrol bomb at a tea shop owner's house in Soundaralingapuram. Sources said, Mani from Soundaralingapuram was running a tea shop. On Thursday, unidentified persons hurled a petrol bomb on the roof of his house in Soundaralingapuram, while Mani was sleeping. In this connection, the Koodankulam police conducted an inspection and launched an investigation. It was found that a friend Samithurai from the locality, along with his friend Hariharan, had allegedly hurled the petrol bomb over previous enmity. The police arrested the duo, and further probe is on. ENS

Nilgiris DEO arrested by DVAC sleuths

THE District Educational Officer (DEO) for primary schools in Nilgiris district was arrested by sleuths of Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption (DVAC) rehandoned on Friday night when he was receiving ₹2 lakh from an aided school teacher, allegedly to confirm his job.

Sources said John Sibin, works as temporary teacher at a government-aided school near Coonoor. In 2021, he obtained an order from Madras HC confirming his job and benefits with retrospective effect from 2018 when he joined the work. However, school education department officials delayed the process. In December 2024, he won the appeal and approached DEO G Santhosh seeking the order. But he allegedly demanded ₹5 lakh to issue the job confirmation order. After several meetings and negotiations, Santhosh finally settled for ₹2 lakh on February 5. However, Sibin lodged a complaint with DVAC. They set a trap and handed chemical laced currency notes to him. On Friday, when Santhosh received the money, DVAC officers arrested him. Further investigation is on.
