# Target on digital transactions irks Tasmac outlet staff

EMPLOYEES of the Tamil Nadu State Marketing Corporation (Tasmac) say they are in agony as the administration is mandating them to achieve up to 50% of the total collection every day through digital transactions. Tasmac administration has started issuing memos to employees working in outlets, seeking an explanation for not achieving the target.

In a memo issued to two supervisors and two salesmen working at Tasmac outlet (5467) in Madurai, dated June 25, the administration asked why departmental disciplinary action should not be initiated against the four staff for not achieving the 25% target of digital transactions daily in their outlet. The memo, issued by a Tasmac manager, pointed that they were not discharging their duties in a diligent manner.

Dhanasekaran, general secretary of Tamil Nadu Tasmac Employees Union, affiliated to AITUC, said, "It is up to the customers to pay by cash, card or UPI. The salesperson cannot compel the customer to pay digitally. Memos have been issued to employees in several districts, seeking explanation for not achieving a particular percentage of digital transactions. It is not right to push the

employees to a corner."

A supervisor at a Tasmac outlet in Coimbatore said, "Tasmac has split up the target area-wise. In Coimbatore city limits, employees are given up to 50% target. In rural areas, it is around 25%. This practice started since two weeks. Earlier, there was no compulsion over digital transactions. To achieve the targets, salespersons are carrying out such transactions on their own or through their friends. Bar contractors are taking cash from the outlet and paying through debit cards. Every morning, the management sends the percentage details shop-wise and points out to those shops where the targets are not achieved, leaving the employees stressed."

Speaking to TNIE, R Govindharasu, Senior Regional Manager (SRM), Coimbatore said, "On a pilot basis, the administration has initiated the practice to promote digital transactions. Accordingly, 30% target has been set for shops under corporation limits, 25% in municipal and town panchayats and 10% in rural areas."

He denied the 50% target for shops in city limits. Despite repeated attempts, Prohibition and Excise Minister S Muthusamy was not available for a comment.

# Neglected CCMC school playgrounds leave kids dejected

THE poor upkeep of playgrounds of civic schools in the city has upset students, teachers and parents alike. Regular sports participants who returned to their schools with great joy this academic year were disappointed seeing the condition of their school's playground.

Numerous schools operated by the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation's (CCMC) in the five zones of the city are in a poor condition without any kind of maintenance work.

The playgrounds pose a grim picture, with grass and other vegetation encroaching the spot which were once bustling with sports activities. At the playground of the Siddhapudur

CCMC Higher Secondary School civic body personnel have left numerous concrete slabs for curing. Despite concerns raised by many, so far no action was taken by CCMC.

"The condition of our school's playground is bad. Although the schools have been reopened for the current academic year

about a month ago, the condition of the grounds remains the same. With grounds being left in this condition, how will we train students?", questioned a PT master, working in a CCMC school.

A parent whose ward is studying at the Vadavalli CCMC Middle school revealed that the

school's ground and entrance are impossible to navigate after rains, putting the lives of the children in danger.

CCMC Education, parks and playgrounds standing committee chairperson N Malathi told TNIE, "The schools reopened just recently. We will start the ground maintenance works

soon. The concrete slabs left in the Siddhapudur school's ground might be used for the school's infrastructure improvement works. I didn't receive any complaints regarding the non-maintenance of the school playgrounds."

Speaking to TNIE, CCMC Commissioner M Sivaguru Prabhakaran acknowledged the issue and said that necessary action will be taken to clean the school playgrounds at the earliest.

"Regarding waterlogging, I have instructed the officials to identify the school grounds which are affected the most and make a list. With that list, we shall be sending a proposal to the government to set up regular rainwater harvesting structures," he added.

# When Pillur Dam opens, taps run dry in Kovai

IF poor roads and solid waste mismanagement weren't enough, the people of Coimbatore city have to put up with irregular drinking water supply too. The supply to the city had to be suspended for nearly three days in June during heavy rains due to constraints in drawing water from the Bhavani River under the Pillur 3 Water Supply Improvement Scheme after the shutters were opened and the water flowed out.

Under the Pillur Scheme 3, water is drawn from the Bhavani Barrage-1 near the Pillur Dam in Mettupalayam. The project aims to supply 178.30 MLD of water to the newly incorporated areas under the Coimbatore City Municipal Corporation (CCMC) limits as well.

During the rainy season, when the Pillur Dam is about to reach its full storage level of 100 feet, the surplus water is released from the dam. When over 10,000 cusecs of water is released from the dam, all the

eight shutters of the Bhavani Barrage-1 are opened to prevent floods.

When the shutters are open, the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage (TWAD) Board can't draw water from the barrage for the Pillur Scheme 3, forcing the suspension of water supply for over three days.

This issue was identified only recently by the TWAD Board and the CCMC which had executed the project

"The recent rains have thrown the spotlight on a major water supply issue in Pillur

Scheme 3. Water from Pillur Scheme 1 is no longer supplied to Coimbatore and has been diverted completely to Tiruppur; ever since the Pillur Scheme 3 has been implemented. With officials unable to draw water from the river during the rainy season, water supply has been severely affected," said V Kathirvel, CCMC North Zonal Chairperson.

With all 20 wards in the North Zone of the city dependent on the Pillur Scheme 3, the recent issue has raised concerns over water supply during the mon-

soon season. "Despite a huge amount of water running through the river, we are unable to trap it for drinking water supply."

Speaking to TNIE, CCMC Commissioner M Sivaguru Prabhakaran said, "Only during the time of floods the shutters of the barrage are opened to release the surplus water flown from the dam. Pillur Scheme 3 was designed in a way to trap and draw water from the river when the shutters of the barrage are closed. However, during a disaster, we can't do much. Meanwhile, we have asked the TWAD Board officials to conduct a study and identify an alternate method to draw water for the project during the rainy season."

A senior official from the TWAD Board (Pillur Division) explained that only if water is at the minimum well level of 6 metres, water can be drawn from the barrage and opening the shutters during the flood times will make the water flow faster to the river bed, which makes it impossible to pump water.

# Food safety officer under scrutiny over bribe demand

THE food safety department has launched an investigation against a food safety officer (FSO) of Saravanampatti in the city for allegedly demanding bribe from a grocer to avoid inspections. Following complaints, the designated officer of FSSAI, Coimbatore has initiated a probe.

On Monday, the Tamil Nadu Vanigar Sangagalin Peravai petitioned the district collector, seeking stringent action against the FSO.

According to S Lingam, the union's president for the district, the FSO demanded a ₹5,000 bribe from a retail trader in Janatha Nagar, Sivanandhapuram. He had made the demand through a tout two weeks ago. The officer allegedly claimed that he would refrain from conducting raids and collecting samples if the bribe was paid. However, the trader refused to pay the bribe.

An audio clip of a phone conversation between the tout and the trader, discussing this issue, has gone viral

on social media. The trader is heard threatening suicide if the officer continued to disrupt his business.

"After the audio leaked, the officer conducted an inspection at the shop and imposed a fine of ₹2,200, accusing the trader of possessing banned single-use plastic bags and expired food products. Although the FSO collected a fine of ₹2,200, he only provided a challan for ₹2,000. The trader now fears further threats from the FSO. Similarly, other traders in parts of the district are also facing issues."
