

₹5 lakh relief for kin of deceased players

Expressing deep sorrow over the deaths of two young basketball players at Bahadurgarh in Jhajjar and Lakhna Majra in Rohtak recently, Chief Minister Nayab Singh Saini has announced a financial assistance of Rs 5 lakh each for the families of the deceased players.

Bonanza for village residents to get ownership rights

Government issues Ordinance, to be placed before Assembly

Offering major relief to rural residents, the Haryana Government has decided to grant ownership rights to occupants of land in the 'abadi deh' areas — inhabited parts of villages. The long-awaited benefit has been cleared through the Haryana Abadi Deh (Vesting, Recording and Resolving of Ownership Rights) Ordinance, 2025, issued by Governor Ashim Kumar Ghosh on November 26. The Ordinance will be tabled in the upcoming winter session of the Assembly for conversion into law.

The 'abadi deh' refers to land within a village's 'lal dora' — the boundary encompassing houses, buildings and other structures. Land outside the 'lal dora' is categorised as agricultural or recognised as "extended lal dora" (phirni).

The cut-off date has been fixed as March 8, 2019, coinciding with the signing of an MoU between the Haryana
