Roundabout, level road prior to flyover works

Officials are planning to remove the existing traffic signals, level irregular gradient of Kurichi Pirivu-Podanur Road

THE State Highways Department, as part of the Ukkadam Flyover project, has planned to build a roundabout at the Kurichi Pirivu-Podanur Road junction, removing the existing traffic signals and levelling the irregular gradient of the road. The work is set to begin in about a month.

The Ukkadam flyover was inaugurated by Chief Minister M K Stalin on August 9 in Coimbatore this year. The flyover work was carried out at an estimated cost of ₹481.95 crore for a length of 3.8 km which included seven up and down ramps.

As part of the project, roundabouts are constructed at Ukkadam Police Station-Perur Bypass Road Junction, Ukkadam Bus Stand-Valankulam Road Junction, Vincent Road-Val-

ankulam Road Junction and Aathupalam Junction. While the officials have completed constructing the concrete structures of the roundabout, soil filling, sapling planting, painting, and other improve-

ment works, the roundabouts are pending.

Vehicles coming from Aathupalam, Pollachi Road, and Podanur Road meet at the Kurichi Pirivu-Podanur junction. Owing to this, the traffic

congestion was quite high at the junction. Even though the junction is equipped with an automatic traffic control signal, frequent accidents were reported at the spot. Also, vehicles proceeding from Pollachi Road do not wait at the signal. So, considering these factors, the State Highways Department officials have decided to construct another roundabout at the Kurichi Pirivu-Podanur Road junction near the Ukkadam Flyover's Pollachi Road Ramp. It was decided to construct the roundabout during the paving of the four-lane road from Kurichi Pirivu to Podanur Railway Station by the highways officials. Given this, a fund of ₹1.8 crore was allocated and the tender for the works was also finalised.

A senior official from the State Highways Department,

Coimbatore division, told TNIE, "The final stage of roundabout works that were taken up as part of the Ukkadam flyover is being carried out in full swing. Apart from the four roundabouts that are already in progress, a new roundabout is set to be built at the Kurichi Pirivu-Podanur Road junction at a cost of ₹1.8 crore. Apart from the roundabout's construction work, the uneven road height will be adjusted for about 500 metres from the junction including 300 metres towards the Aathupalam junction, 100 metres towards the Podanur Road, and the remaining 100 metres towards the Pollachi Road. The irregular gradient will be levelled and a roundabout of 26 m in diameter will be built at the junction. The work will begin in about a month."

People expressing views against state govt getting arrested not new: Vanathi

COIMBATORE South constituency MLA and BJP Mahila Morcha national president Vanathi Srinivasan inaugurated two purified drinking water ATMs funded by her area development fund at VOC Park and Highways Colony in Coimbatore on Sunday.

Speaking to the media during the event, she said that she has installed 13 water ATMs in Coimbatore South constituency to provide safe drinking water to the public. People can collect up to 20 litres of water using the access cards that are distributed to them.

When asked about the participation of college students in the Indu Makkal Katchi protest in response to the arrest of their functionary, she said that student protests are not new in the state. Anyone who reaches 18 years of age has the right to participate in political events.

She added, "There is nothing new about people expressing their opinions against the state

government getting arrested. There is no freedom of speech for those who criticise the DMK government. While people opposing the DMK government are being arrested, criminals are roaming around freely. This is a clear example of fascism. Does the government truly allow freedom of speech as guaranteed by the constitution?" she questioned. Srinivasan also said that the state government might be taking a natural stance by acting against those who criticize the Prime Minister. She also questioned the political maturity of CPI state secretary R Mutharasan for his comments against Governor R N Ravi. Commenting on the entry of actors in politics, Srinivasan said that politics and cinema have a close relationship in Tamil Nadu.

"When an actor enters politics, there is usually public anticipation, as cinema and politics have been intertwined for many years here. However, we will have to see if they can sustain their political career," she further said.

Police detain IMK founder, 141 supporters

Indu Makkal Katchi (IMK) founder Arjun Sampath and 141 supporters were detained for staging a protest in Coimbatore without obtaining prior permission.

Sources said that though the police had denied permission for a protest planned by IMK to condemn the recent arrest of its youth wing leader Omkar Balaji, IMK members led by Sampath took out a procession from the roundabout near the district collectorate and were heading towards the Red Cross junction to stage a protest when the police stopped them and detained them.

Balaji was arrested by the Chennai Race Course police on November 13 for his controversial remark on journalist Nakkheeran Gopal.

FROM NOV 20 Proposal to release water to new Ayacut region sent

OFFICIALS of the Public Works Department have sent a proposal to the state government seeking water release to the New Ayacut region from the Aliyar Dam under the Parambikulam Aliyar Project (PAP) from November 20.

After the consultation meeting with farmers under the New Ayacut region presided by M Karthikeyan, superintendent engineer of PAP, a consensus was made to release water from the dam starting November 20. Earlier, the Aliyar Project Committee which consists of a total of 44,380 acres demanded the release of 2,863 mcf for 135 days. However, due to objections from the Thirumurthy Project Committee farmers, officials from PWD announced that they could re-

lease water for 120 days instead of the usual 135 days for the New Ayacut region under the Aliyar river basin. However, farmers in the New Ayacut region opposed the decision and demanded water for 135 days. Following that a talk was held at the PAP office at Pollachi on Friday and the officials agreed to release water for 135 days.

M Senthil, Aliyar project committee chairman, said, "It has been agreed to get up to 2,709 mcf water instead of 2,863 mcf which was demanded by us earlier. The water would be provided to 22,200 zone A under the new Ayacut region through four canals such as Pollachi, Vettaikaranpudur, Sethumadai, and Feeder canals by 35 mcf each day."

He said that as per the agreement, the proposal has been sent to the state government by the PWD department.

4 demolish MDMK party office, booked

THE Peelamedu police on Saturday registered cases against four persons for demolishing the MDMK party branch office in the city.

Sources said a resident of Sundarajan in Avarampalayam allegedly hired an excavator and demolished the MDMK party branch office named Muthamil Padipagam, located on Murugan Kovil street in the same area, on Friday night along with his supporters. He claimed that the party office was constructed on his land.

"Learning about this, MDMK functionaries rushed to the spot on Sunday morning and claimed that the land belongs to a late Narayansamy and the property had not been transferred to anyone. Seeking action, they filed a complaint. After inquiry, police have registered cases against Sundarajan, Gokulraj, Senthilkumar and Gopalakrishnan under sections 304(4) BNS and 3 of TNPPDL Act 1992, 427 IPC and 3 of TNPPDL Act," sources added.

White-feathered peacock rescued from Nallampalayam Sanganoor road

THE district forest range staff rescued a white-feathered peacock from Nallampalayam Sanganoor road and took it to the avian recuperation centre at the DFO campus on Saturday. The team received information from volunteers of the Trust for Environment and Ecosystem (TREE) about the injured peacock, which was struggling to move on the road, and rescued it. The white feathers are caused by leucism, a genetic condition. An official said that the peacock will be properly taken care and the treatment will commence after the veterinary officer A Sukumar checks the animal's health on Monday.

13 KG SEIZED

Man arrested for possession of banned tobacco

THE Rathinapuri police on Saturday, arrested a 61-year-old man for possession of banned tobacco.

The arrested person was identified as P Muthukrishnan of Tatabad in the city. Sources said that based on a secret tip-off, police searched his home on Saturday evening.

They found that he had 131kg of banned tobacco items such as Cool Lip, Hans, etc.

During inquiry, it was revealed that he had been selling these to north Indian labourers, sources added.

"After seizing the contraband, police arrested him under various sections of BNS and later lodged him in prison," sources further said.
