

After 8 yrs on the run, man held for journo's murder

Mohali: After an eight-year hunt, Mohali police have arrested Gaurav Kumar, wanted for the double murder of senior journalist KJ Singh and his mother, Gurcharan Kaur. Kumar was arrested in Noida Thursday.

Kumar frequently changed cities and jobs to avoid detection and had managed to build a new identity for himself, say police. His employers were stunned to learn that he was an absconder in a high-profile murder case.

The "model worker" had been promoted from security guard to manager at a construction firm in the last few years and had married. But police stayed on his trail. The chase turned into a sprint in the last 10 days when tips from elders in his village turned the cold trail hot. Kumar was taken completely by surprise when a team from Mohali police's "Proclaimed Offenders Staff" surrounded him. He has been brought to Mohali and will be produced in court.

The Singhs were found murdered at their home in Mohali during the intervening night of Sept 22-23, 2017. The killings sent shockwaves across Punjab.

SSP Harmandeep Singh Hans said sustained surveil-

lance and intelligence inputs finally led to the accused. "The motive of murder was spontaneous. KJ Singh saw this man sitting near the boundary wall of his house and asked him to go away. The other man got offended and entered his house to kill him and his mother," Hans said.

Police identified Kumar as the suspect and registered a case at Mataur police sta-

tion on Sept 23, 2017. But Kumar was nowhere to be found. He was declared a proclaimed offender in 2022.

DSP Naveen Pal Singh said that when the case was handed to him, he and his team began "connecting evidence" and went to Kumar's native village. With the help of sarpanches and panches, police traced him to Noida, where he was caught. Singh said, "He was traced to a construction site in Noida. He joined the firm as a security guard and was elevated to supervisor before being made manager of the project. According to his employer, his conduct was very good... They were shocked to know that he is a double-murder accused."

Centre retracts order to replace Panjab Univ's senate, syndicate

New Delhi: The Union ministry of education announced on Friday that the order changing the constitution and composition of Panjab University's senate and syndicate stands rescinded.

Panjab University's decision to replace 59-year-old senate and syndicate with a smaller, largely nominated structure, triggered sharp political reactions in Punjab, with chief minister Bhagwant Mann calling it "unconstitutional."

"It has been decided by the ministry of education that the order changing the constitution and composition of the senate and syndicate shall stand rescinded," the ministry said in a statement.

On the basis of recommendation of a high-level committee constituted in March 2021 by the chancellor of the university and consultations with various stakeholders, the Centre had issued a notification to modify the constitution and composition of the senate and syndicate of the university.

"After the issue of the order, various feedback were received from stakeholders like students, teachers, former VCs and the current VC of the Panjab University. The govt also considered the inputs received in meeting with various student organisations," the ministry added. TNN

Teen rape survivor can terminate 27-wk pregnancy, says HC

Mumbai: Bombay high court has allowed a 15-year-old rape survivor who is going to take her Class 10 SSC board exams in March to undergo medical termination of an over-27 weeks pregnancy.

Justices Revati Mohite Dere and Sandesh Patil on Thursday passed the direction on the girl's petition, filed through her father, seeking HC's permission as she is beyond the 24-week permissible limit under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971.

On Oct 31, the vacation court directed the JJ Hospital dean to constitute a medical board to examine her and submit a report. Other directions included necessary medical facilities in the event the child is born alive and state govt to process compensation under Manoharaya Scheme. The board's report said she was "27 weeks and four days" pregnant and there was "no gross lethal congenital anomaly".

The judge opined that "the continuation of pregnancy would result in grave anguish to the girl while continuing the unwanted pregnancy".

The judges were informed by advocate Swapna Kode that the girl wanted to appear for her exams in March 2026. They also took note of the psychiatrist's opinion that she was subjected to non-consensual sexual intercourse by her neighbour, and that she would not be able to take care of the baby emotionally, financially and socially. It stated that she was borderline intellectual functioning and continuation of pregnancy would pose great risk of depression, anxiety, post-traumatic stress and disruption of psychological development.

The judges were informed that the girl's parents were labourers.

The high court directed JJ Hospital authorities to "conduct the necessary medical procedure expeditiously, keeping in mind the petitioner's health and safety".

Mom, 25, with ant phobia dies by suicide

Hyderabad: A 25-year-old woman being treated since childhood for her psychopathological fear of ants died by suspected suicide in Telangana's Sangareddy on Friday, purportedly leaving behind a note suggesting the phobia had taken its toll on her, reports Siddhant Nair. Police said the

deceased, who has a three-year-old daughter, dropped the child at a relative's place saying she needed to clean the house. Her husband found her unresponsive when he returned home. "It appears she noticed ants while cleaning and, out of fear, took the extreme step," an officer said.

Courts mustn't add to mental pain: HC

Conviction In Suicide Bid Case Set Aside

Dehradun: The Uttarakhand HC has overturned conviction of a govt employee from Haridwar district in an attempted suicide case, observing "although his sentence was minor, the stigma of conviction had caused significant prejudice, impacting both his career and mental health".

A single bench of Justice Pankaj Purohit, while emphasising that "the criminal justice system must not add to the suffering of those already under mental distress", quashed the lower court's judgment against Kiran Kumar (name changed), a Nagar Palika Parishad employee in Mangla. He had been convicted under IPC Section 309 after two police con-

stable restrained him on Feb 21, 2011, at his workplace when he had poured kerosene on himself while holding a matchbox.

The high court noted legislative intent of Section 115 of Mental Health Care Act, 2017, which presumes anyone attempting suicide is under severe stress and should not be tried or punished under Section 309 unless proven otherwise.

"This reflects a shift from punitive measures to a more compassionate approach recognising suicide attempts as expressions of mental distress. The lower courts were duty bound to consider this legal position but failed to do so," the bench said. According to the court, both trial and ap-

pellate courts had "mechanically" proceeded without distinguishing between preparation and attempt or considering the incident's context.

"(The man) consistently claimed he had been subjected to workplace harassment and severe stress due to pressure from superiors over his complaints against them. These circumstances lend credibility to his defence and, at minimum, raise reasonable doubt regarding the necessary 'mens rea' (guilty mind); refers to the defendant's state of mind for section 309. The trial courts overlooked this crucial aspect, committing a manifest error in convicting the revisionist," the high court said.

Facing boycott, family of 'blue drum' murder accused to leave home

Bareilly: After facing months of social boycott, the family of Muskan Rastogi, the prime accused in Meerut's 'blue drum murder case' that hit national headlines in March, has purportedly pasted a 'for sale' notice on their house and plans to leave the city where they have lived for years.

Muskan's father Pramod said, "We no longer wish to stay in Meerut. We have got painful memories here... People have boycotted us. This was the first Diwali when no one visited our home. My daughter (Muskan's sister) used to tutor kids, but now no parents want to send their children to our place. People don't want to talk to us anymore."

After the murder of former merchant navy officer Saurabh Rajput, the family's jewellery business collapsed and Muskan's sister lost her job.

On March 3, Muskan, 28, was accused of killing her husband and hiding the remains. Her lover Sahil Shukla helped her in the crime. On March 19, Sau-

rabh's body — in a dismembered state — was found inside a sealed, cement-filled blue drum at his Meerut home. The accused was arrested after they returned from a trip to HP. Both are lodged in Meerut jail.

Locals claimed "Muskan's family started behaving weirdly after the March incident". Himanshu Kumar, a resident of Brahmuri, said, "I've seen Pramod beating stray dogs. I confronted him a few times, but he continues to do so..." Another resident, Vijay Singh, said, "Almost everyone has stopped talking to them out of fear that police might include them in the investigation, if they do so."

2 UP cops denied bribe, steal shoes; suspended

Agra: Two constables of UP police were suspended for allegedly stealing shoes from a store in Agra when the shopkeeper refused to bribe them, reports Sudeep Lavania.

Constables Kaushal and Vishwanath, posted at the office of ACP Kotwali, were assigned to probe a complaint filed by the shoe trader. Their role was to record his statement and present it before the ACP. The two contacted the complainant and allegedly demanded money to file a report in his favour. When the trader refused to pay, the duo took four pairs of shoes.

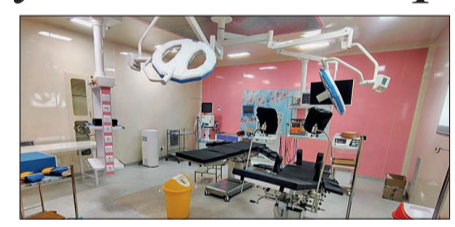
The trader later submitted a complaint with evidence on Agra police's anti-graft helpline, leading to a probe that "prima facie confirmed the allegations". The constables were thereafter suspended, and a departmental probe was launched against them.

Agra commissioner of police Deepak Kumar said investigation orders have been issued against nine police personnel, and further action will be initiated after the probe.

A former Red bastion gets its first women's hosp

Nagpur: Maharashtra CM Devendra Fadnis will inaugurate Saturday a 100-bed women's and child hospital at Aheri in southern Gadchiroli, marking a major milestone in public health infrastructure for the tribal-dominated pocket that was once a Maoist stronghold, reports Abhishek Choudhari.

The inauguration of Women's Hospital and Newborn Baby Centre, built at a cost of Rs 83 crore, is aimed at strengthening maternal and child healthcare in one of the most remote regions of Maharashtra.

The opening comes amid intensified crackdown that led to the surrender of several rebels, including that of Maoist top gun Malloju Venugopal Rao alias Bhupathi along with several cadres in Gadchiroli.

Collector Avishyant Panda said the hospital project represents a coordinated effort between the state govt and district administration. "Civil construction was funded by the state govt, while the district administration financed the equipment and furniture," Panda said.

The hospital will serve as a lifeline for five southern talukas of Gadchiroli — Aheri, Etapalli, Bhamragad, Sironcha, and Dhanora — where patients earlier had to travel long distances to Chandrapur or Nagpur for advanced maternity care.

"With specialised services like C-sections and neonatal critical care now available locally, we expect a significant reduction in maternal and infant mortality rates," Panda said.

Spread across 13,460 sqm, the hospital is expected to handle hundreds of deliveries each month and offer 24-hour emergency obstetric and paediatric services. It will also function as a training and referral centre for local health-care workers, enabling faster diagnosis and intervention in complicated cases.
