CM Saha asks AAI to conduct feasibility study to revive airport in Tripura

AGARTALA : Tripura Chief Minister Manik Saha, on Saturday, chaired a high-level review meeting on reviving the long-closed Kailashahar Airport in Tripura's Unakoti district headquarters, officials said.

An official of the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) said that Chief Minister Saha during the meeting directed the Airports Authority of India (AAI) officials to revive the long closed airport and resume flight operations.

The Chief Minister asked the AAI officials to depute a technical and operational team for an on-ground assessment of the Kailashahar Airport, located nearly 140 km north of Agartala.

He directed for the early submission of a comprehen-

sive feasibility study comparing Kailashahar, Kamalpur and Khawai Airports, including land availability and other constraints.

"The report has been sought to clearly outline commercial, technical and financial pros and cons of each option," the CMO official said.

The review meeting examined the revival roadmap for Kailashahar Airport, which has remained closed for several years.

The Kamalpur and Khawai Airports also remained closed for few decades.

Senior AAI officials, including Gyan Batra, AAI (North Eastern Region) Executive Director; and Krishnamohan Nehra, Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport Director; attended the meet-



ing and discussed steps needed for an early resumption of services.

According to the official, key issues deliberated included runway expansion, modern infrastructure development and capacity creation to

handle larger aircraft such as Airbus types.

Chief Minister Saha said that, based on the feasibility report, the state government would take further steps in consultation with the Union Ministry of Civil Aviation and

other concerned Ministries. AAI officials informed the meeting that a technical team would soon visit Kailashahar to examine detailed operational and engineering aspects.

Both the state government and AAI agreed to work in close coordination to reopen the airport.

Transport Department Secretary Uttam Kumar Chakma and Transport Commissioner Subrata Chowdhury were also present at the meeting.

Agartala's Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport is the second busiest airport in the Northeast, after the Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport in Guwahati.

According to historian and writer Pannalal Roy, the land

for Agartala, Kailashahar, and several other (now defunct) airports in Tripura was donated by the state's erstwhile Royal family.

"During the Second World War, the then Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya Bahadur supported the Allied powers, especially Great Britain, and deployed a contingent of the Tripura Army to assist them. During that time, airports at Agartala, Kailashahar, and other places were built to facilitate the Allied forces," Roy, who has authored several books on Tripura's royal history, told IANS.

He added that in 1943, Japanese fighter planes twice bombed the Agartala airport, just along the India-Bangladesh border in Tripura.

NEW INTEGRATED TERMINAL AT GUWAHATI AIRPORT TO BEGIN OPERATIONS FROM TOMORROW: ASSAM CM

GUWAHATI : Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Saturday announced that the new integrated terminal at Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport in Guwahati will commence commercial operations from Sunday, marking a major addition to the state's aviation infrastructure.

In a post on X, Sarma said the terminal had been constructed with local participation and symbolised Assam's growing role as a key gateway to the northeastern region and beyond.

"The new Integrated Terminal at Guwahati Airport begins commercial operations from tomorrow. Proudly built by the hands of Assam and powered by the sons and daughters of our state, this gateway is ready to welcome the world," the Chief Minister said. Earlier, Sarma had shared visuals of the new terminal, highlighting its modern facilities and passenger amenities. Officials said the integrated terminal is expected to significantly enhance passenger handling capacity and improve overall operational efficiency, in view of increasing air traffic in the region.

The terminal has been designed to accommodate both domestic and international passengers, with upgraded security systems, improved passenger movement flow, and modern infrastructure. Authorities said the facility is aimed at strengthening Guwahati's position as a key aviation hub for the northeastern region and enhancing direct connectivity. The terminal also incorporates design elements reflecting Assam's cultural heritage while adhering to global airport infrastructure and sustainability standards. It is equipped with advanced baggage handling systems, energy-efficient features, and improved accessibility provisions for passengers.

Insisted Bhupen Borah to stay, but he had already made up his mind: Congress MP

GUWAHATI : Congress MP Pradyut Bordoloi on Saturday said there was no bitterness within the party during Priyanka Gandhi Vadra's recent visit to Assam, even as senior leader Bhupen Kumar Borah resigned from the Congress and is set to join the BJP.

"Priyanka Gandhi spoke to everyone during her Assam visit. There is no kind of bitterness among us. I tried to persuade Bhupen Borah to stay, but it seems he had already made up his mind," Bordoloi told reporters.

Bordoloi's remarks came in the backdrop of Borah's resignation from the Congress, a move that has triggered fresh political spec-

ulation in the state ahead of the Assembly elections.

Bhupen Borah, who served as the Assam Pradesh Congress Committee (APCC) president, formally quit the party earlier this week and is expected to join the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party on Sunday.

Priyanka Gandhi Vadra was in Assam recently as part of the party's organisational outreach and review of political preparedness in the state. During her visit, she held meetings with senior leaders, MPs, MLAs and party workers to assess ground-level issues and strengthen coordination within the party.

The exit of Bhupen Borah is being seen as a significant



setback for the Congress in Assam, where the party has been attempting to revive its organisational structure after successive electoral defeats. Borah had led the state unit through a difficult political phase marked by defections and internal challenges.

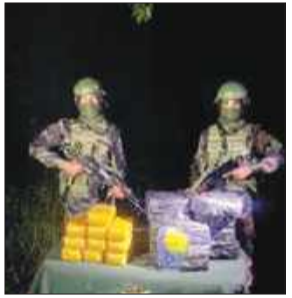
While the Congress leadership has maintained that organisational changes are part of an ongoing restructuring exercise, the BJP has claimed that Borah's resignation reflects growing dissatisfaction within the Congress ranks.

Rejecting such assertions, Bordoloi said the Congress remains united and focused on its political objectives in Assam. "This is a democratic party, and differences of opinion can exist. Our priority is to strengthen the organisation and raise issues concerning unemployment, price rise and the overall failure of the BJP government in Assam," he said.

Political analysts believe that Priyanka Gandhi's Assam visit indicated a renewed attempt by the Congress to recalibrate its strategy in the state amid an increasingly competitive political landscape.

Four held with methamphetamine tablets worth Rs 11.85 crore in Mizoram

AIZAWL : Assam Rifles have seized highly addictive methamphetamine tablets valued at over Rs 11.85 crore by arresting four drug peddlers, including three Myanmar nationals, in Mizoram, officials said on Saturday.

ment, Assam Rifles said it remains steadfast in its efforts to curb illegal narcotics trafficking along the Indo-Myanmar border and to ensure peace and security in the region. The methamphetamine tablets, also known as Yaba or party tablets, contain a mixture of methamphetamine and caffeine. The drugs, also called the 'crazy drug', are banned in India. Mizoram shares a 510-km-long unfenced international border with Myanmar and a 318-km-long porous mountainous border with Bangladesh, making the state particularly vulnerable to cross-border smuggling.

Myanmar's Chin state is considered a major hub for the smuggling of narcotics, exotic wildlife, foreign-made cigarettes, Myanmarese area nuts (betel nuts) and other contraband through six districts of Mizoram -- Champhai, Siaha, Lawngtlai, Hnahthial, Saitual and Serchhip.

The arrested persons have been identified as Lairamlaina (40), a resident of Lawngtlai district, and three Myanmar nationals -- Chaimoungthein (17), Thanlaing (17) and Thanlaingwon (15). The seized methamphetamine tablets, along with the apprehended individuals, have been handed over to Bungleng Police Station in Lawngtlai district for further legal proceedings. SIR snapshot: Gujarat records deletion of over 68 lakh voters, Lakshadweep lowest at 206

NEW DELHI : The Election Commission of India (ECI) on Saturday released snapshots of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) exercise, showing that Gujarat recorded the highest deletion of over 68 lakh electors, while Lakshadweep registered the lowest deletion at 206 names.

The snapshots were issued after publication of the final electoral rolls for Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, and Rajasthan, detailing the extent of deletions and revisions undertaken to ensure accurate and updated voter lists. According to the ECI, Gujarat's total electorate stood at 5,08,43,436 before the SIR exercise and declined to 4,40,30,725 after revision, resulting in deletion of 68,12,711 names -- a net change of 13.40 per cent.

Atishi video: Delhi Privileges panel summons Punjab Police chief, 2 others on Feb 27

NEW DELHI : In Delhi's Leader of Opposition Atishi's video row, the Delhi Assembly Secretariat on Saturday issued summons to Punjab Police chief, Jalandhar Police commissioner and a senior Punjab Home Department official to appear before it on February 27.

Earlier, the Punjab government justified the registration of an FIR in Jalandhar over the Atishi video row and told the Delhi Assembly that a video clip, which is created/modified/altere

In a letter addressed to the Secretary of the Assembly, the Punjab government's Home Affairs department asserted that the FIR registered by Jalandhar Police did not amount to breach of privilege. The letter written by Punjab's Under Secretary, Home, Kailash Gautam, said that

"privilege provided to the member of the House under Article 194(3) of the Constitution of India cannot be extended for an act whereby a video clip has been created/modified/altere

The Registration of an FIR for a cognizable offence committed outside the House and the ongoing investigation of a cognizable offence under the BNSO does not constitute breach of privilege," said the Punjab official.

"A video clip which is created/modified/altere

treated as the property of the House or anything said in the House. Registration of such an FIR is not on publication of the proceedings of the House and operates on a different plane under the watchful supervision of courts and is subject to judicial review," said the letter sent by the Punjab's Under Secretary, Home.

"The Secretariat of the Legislature of a State does not possess authority to request for the documents which are subject matters of the investigation of an FIR which is registered in another state on the issue which has no connection to the proceedings of the House," said the letter.

Meanwhile, the Delhi Assembly's Committee of Privileges on Saturday took on record the replies filed by Punjab's senior officials. The Committee took note of the letter sent by Punjab's Under Secretary, Home, Kailash Gautam, and advised him to take the opinion of the Advocate General, Government of Punjab, on record on the issue.

A letter sent to Gautam from the Delhi Assembly Secretariat said, "The Committee of Privileges, Chairperson, has directed to

take the opinion of the Advocate General, Government of Punjab, on record and inform that it does not appear to correctly appreciate the concerns of the Legislature in this matter."

"It is requested that a copy of the complete opinion as received from the Advocate General may be sent to this Secretariat on or before February 27, 2026, for the appraisal of the Committee," said the letter.

The FIR was registered by the Jalandhar Police on January 9 over a complaint that alleged circulation of a "doctored" version of a video clip related to Atishi's statement in the Delhi Assembly, which was perceived as objectionable and disrespectful towards Sikh Gurus.

The matter pertains to complaints of breach of privilege and contempt arising from statements made on the floor of the House and the subsequent action initiated by the Punjab Police.

The Committee of Privileges is presently examining the matter, including the conduct of the authorities and the handling of communications and information sought by the Delhi Assembly Secretariat.

CM Saha asks AAI to conduct feasibility study to revive airport in Tripura

AGARTALA : Tripura Chief Minister Manik Saha, on Saturday, chaired a high-level review meeting on reviving the long-closed Kailashahar Airport in Tripura's Unakoti district headquarters, officials said.

An official of the Chief Minister's Office (CMO) said that Chief Minister Saha during the meeting directed the Airports Authority of India (AAI) officials to revive the long closed airport and resume flight operations.

The Chief Minister asked the AAI officials to depute a technical and operational team for an on-ground assessment of the Kailashahar Airport, located nearly 140 km north of Agartala.

He directed for the early submission of a comprehen-

sive feasibility study comparing Kailashahar, Kamalpur and Khawai Airports, including land availability and other constraints.

"The report has been sought to clearly outline commercial, technical and financial pros and cons of each option," the CMO official said.

The review meeting examined the revival roadmap for Kailashahar Airport, which has remained closed for several years.

The Kamalpur and Khawai Airports also remained closed for few decades.

Senior AAI officials, including Gyan Batra, AAI (North Eastern Region) Executive Director; and Krishnamohan Nehra, Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport Director; attended the meet-



ing and discussed steps needed for an early resumption of services.

According to the official, key issues deliberated included runway expansion, modern infrastructure development and capacity creation to handle larger aircraft such as Airbus types.

Chief Minister Saha said that, based on the feasibility report, the state government would take further steps in consultation with the Union Ministry of Civil Aviation and

other concerned Ministries.

AAI officials informed the meeting that a technical team would soon visit Kailashahar to examine detailed operational and engineering aspects.

Both the state government and AAI agreed to work in close coordination to reopen the airport.

Transport Department Secretary Uttam Kumar Chakma and Transport Commissioner Subrata Chowdhury were also present at the meeting.

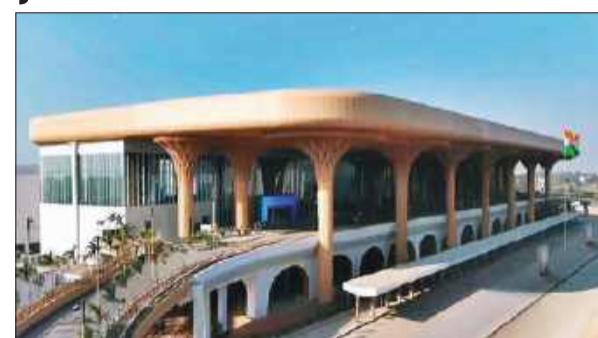
Agartala's Maharaja Bir Bikram Airport is the second busiest airport in the Northeast, after the Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport in Guwahati.

According to historian and writer Pannalal Roy, the land for Agartala, Kailashahar, and several other (now defunct) airports in Tripura was donated by the state's erstwhile Royal Family.

"During the Second World War, the then Maharaja Bir Bikram Kishore Manikya Bahadur supported the Allied powers, especially Great Britain, and deployed a contingent of the Tripura Army to assist them. During that time, airports at Agartala, Kailashahar, and other places were built to facilitate the Allied forces," Roy, who has authored several books on Tripura's royal history, told IANS.

He added that in 1943, Japanese fighter planes twice bombed the Agartala airport, just along the India-Bangladesh border in Tripura.

New integrated terminal at Guwahati airport to begin operations from tomorrow: Assam CM



GUWAHATI : Assam Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma on Saturday announced that the new integrated terminal at Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport in Guwahati will commence commercial operations from Sunday, marking a major addition to the state's aviation infrastructure.

In a post on X, Sarma said the terminal had been constructed with local participation and symbolised Assam's growing role as a key gateway to the northeastern region and beyond.

"The new Integrated Terminal at Guwahati Airport begins commercial operations from tomorrow. Proudly built by the hands of Assam and powered by the sons and daughters of our state, this gateway is ready to welcome the world," the Chief Minister said.

Earlier, Sarma had shared visuals of the new terminal, highlighting its modern facilities and passenger amenities. Officials said the integrated terminal is expected to significantly enhance passenger handling capacity and improve overall operational efficiency, in view of increasing air traffic in the region.

The terminal has been designed to accommodate both domestic and international passengers, with upgraded security systems, improved passenger movement flow, and modern infrastructure.

Authorities said the facility is aimed at strengthening Guwahati's position as a key aviation hub for the northeastern region and enhancing direct connectivity.

The terminal also incorporates design elements reflecting Assam's cultural heritage while adhering to global airport infrastructure and sustainability standards.

It is equipped with advanced baggage handling systems, energy-efficient features, and improved accessibility provisions for passengers.

Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport serves as the primary aviation gateway to the northeastern region, connecting Guwahati with major cities across India and select international destinations.

With the commissioning of the new integrated terminal, airport authorities expect an increase in passenger traffic, flight operations, and cargo movement.

Insisted Bhupen Borah to stay, but he had already made up his mind: Congress MP

GUWAHATI : Congress MP Pradyut Bordoloi on Saturday said there was no bitterness within the party during Priyanka Gandhi Vadra's recent visit to Assam, even as senior leader Bhupen Kumar Borah resigned from the Congress and is set to join the BJP.

"Priyanka Gandhi spoke to everyone during her Assam visit. There is no kind of bitterness among us. I tried to persuade Bhupen Borah to stay, but it seems he had already made up his mind," Bordoloi told reporters.

Bordoloi's remarks came in the backdrop of Borah's resignation from the Congress, a move that has triggered fresh political spec-

ulation in the state ahead of the Assembly elections.

Bhupen Borah, who served as the Assam Pradesh Congress Committee (APCC) president, formally quit the party earlier this week and is expected to join the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party on Sunday.

Priyanka Gandhi Vadra was in Assam recently as part of the party's organisational outreach and review of political preparedness in the state. During her visit, she held meetings with senior leaders, MPs, MLAs and party workers to assess ground-level issues and strengthen coordination within the party.

The exit of Bhupen Borah is being seen as a significant



setback for the Congress in Assam, where the party has been attempting to revive its organisational structure after successive electoral defeats. Borah had led the state unit through a difficult political phase marked by defections and internal challenges.

While the Congress leadership has maintained that organisational changes are part of an ongoing restructuring exercise, the BJP has claimed that Borah's resignation reflects growing dissatis-

faction within the Congress ranks.

Rejecting such assertions, Bordoloi said the Congress remains united and focused on its political objectives in Assam. "This is a democratic party, and differences of opinion can exist. Our priority is to strengthen the organisation and raise issues concerning unemployment, price rise and the overall failure of the BJP government in Assam," he said.

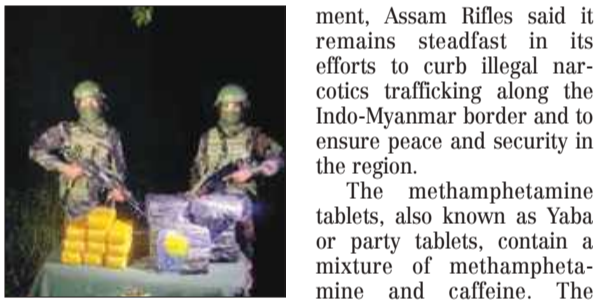
Political analysts believe that Priyanka Gandhi's Assam visit indicated a renewed attempt by the Congress to recalibrate its strategy in the state amid an increasingly competitive political landscape.

Four held with methamphetamine tablets worth Rs 11.85 crore in Mizoram

AIZAWL : Assam Rifles have seized highly addictive methamphetamine tablets valued at over Rs 11.85 crore by arresting four drug peddlers, including three Myanmar nationals, in Mizoram, officials said on Saturday.

A defence spokesman said that, acting on specific intelligence inputs regarding the movement of banned methamphetamine tablets, Assam Rifles launched an operation on Friday night and established a Mobile Vehicle Check Post (MVCP) at Kachichuha village in Lawngtlai district. During the operation, troops intercepted four suspects travelling from Myanmar to India via a boat through the Koladyne River, the spokesman said.

Following a thorough search, approximately 80,000 methamphetamine tablets weighing 3.952 kg and valued at around Rs 11.85 crore were recovered from the drug peddlers and seized. Four individuals --



three Myanmar nationals and one Indian national -- involved in the illegal transportation of the contraband were apprehended on the spot.

The arrested persons have been identified as Lairamlaina (40), a resident of Lawngtlai district, and three Myanmar nationals -- Chaimoungthein (17), Thanlaing (17) and Thanlaingwon (15). The seized methamphetamine tablets, along with the apprehended individuals, have been handed over to Bungtlai Police Station in Lawngtlai district for further legal proceedings.

Reiterating its commitment, Assam Rifles said it remains steadfast in its efforts to curb illegal narcotics trafficking along the Indo-Myanmar border and to ensure peace and security in the region.

The methamphetamine tablets, also known as Yaba or party tablets, contain a mixture of methamphetamine and caffeine. The drugs, also called the 'crazy drug', are banned in India.

Mizoram shares a 510-km-long unfenced international border with Myanmar and a 318-km-long porous mountainous border with Bangladesh, making the state particularly vulnerable to cross-border smuggling.

Myanmar's Chin state is considered a major hub for the smuggling of narcotics, exotic wildlife, foreign-made cigarettes, Myanmarese area nuts (betel nuts) and other contraband through six districts of Mizoram -- Champhai, Siaha, Lawngtlai, Hnahthial, Saitual and Serchhip.

SIR snapshot: Gujarat records deletion of over 68 lakh voters, Lakshadweep lowest at 206

NEW DELHI : The Election Commission of India (ECI) on Saturday released snapshots of the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) exercise, showing that Gujarat recorded the highest deletion of over 68 lakh electors, while Lakshadweep registered the lowest deletion at 206 names.

The snapshots were issued after publication of the final electoral rolls for Andaman and Nicobar Islands, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Kerala, Madhya Pradesh, and Rajasthan, detailing the extent of deletions and revisions undertaken to ensure accurate and updated voter lists.

According to the ECI, Gujarat's total electorate stood at 5,08,43,436 before the SIR exercise and declined to 4,40,30,725 after revision, resulting in deletion of 68,12,711 names -- a net change of 13.40 per cent.

The Commission said the deletions were carried out following field verification and were attributed to reasons such as death, perma-



nent migration, duplicate or multiple enrolments, and other statutory grounds.

The percentage of net change in the number of electors during the SIR exercise was highest in Andaman and Nicobar Islands at 16.87 per cent, followed by Gujarat at 13.40 per cent.

In Andaman and Nicobar Islands, the number of electors declined from 3,10,404 to 2,58,040, reflecting dele-

tion of 52,364 names.

In Madhya Pradesh, the electorate declined from 5,74,06,143 before revision to 5,39,81,065 after the exercise, resulting in deletion of 34,25,078 names -- a net change of 5.97 per cent.

In Rajasthan, the number of electors declined from 5,46,56,215 to 5,15,19,929, reflecting a net change of 5.74 per cent. In Chhattisgarh, the electorate declined from 2,12,30,737 to 1,87,30,914, marking a net change of 11.77 per cent.

In Kerala, the number of electors reduced from 2,78,50,855 prior to the revision to 2,69,53,644 after the SIR exercise, reflecting a net change of 3.22 per cent.

In Goa, the electorate declined from 11,85,034 to 10,57,566, resulting in deletion of 1,27,468 names -- a net change of 10.75 per cent.

In Puducherry, the number of electors declined from 10,21,578 to 9,44,211, reflecting a net change of 7.57 per cent.

In Lakshadweep, the electorate declined marginally from 57,813 to 57,607, reflecting deletion of 206 names -- a net change of 0.36 per cent, the lowest among the regions covered under the revision exercise.

The Commission said the revision exercise was conducted to maintain accuracy and integrity of electoral rolls through systematic verification and removal of ineligible entries.

and contempt in the matter of alleged remarks of LoP Atishi against Sikh Gurus.

The summons sent to Punjab officials said, "It may be noted that non-compliance of this summons could lead to initiation of proceedings for breach of privilege/contempt of the Assembly."

Staging half-naked protest at India AI Summit shows Congress' 'anti-India' mentality: VHP

NEW DELHI : Reacting to the protest by Youth Congress workers during the India AI Summit, the Vishva Hindu Parishad (VHP), on Saturday, criticised the demonstration, saying that holding a half-naked protest at such an event exposes what it called the Congress' 'anti-India mentality'.

Speaking to IANS, VHP National Spokesperson Vinod Bansal said, "By staging a half-naked protest at the summit, Congress workers have completely exposed the party. Their anti-India mentality has come out in front of

everyone."

He also expressed surprise over some Congress leaders allegedly describing the protest as revolutionary and comparing it to the actions of freedom fighter Bhagat Singh.

"I am very surprised that some Congress leaders are calling this a revolutionary step and comparing it to Bhagat Singh. They should feel ashamed. There is a limit to shamelessness. In opposing the Union government, one should not become so blinded that it turns into opposition against the nation itself," he said.

Bansal also raised concerns about security, alleging that such protests challenge law enforcement arrangements at high-profile events.

"You cannot breach security and create disruption. This is not acceptable. Congress should seek an apology to ensure that such incidents do not happen in the future," he added.

Drawing a parallel with past incidents, the VHP Spokesperson referred to protests during the visit of the US President Donald Trump to India in 2020.
